WINFLIKE RAV552 ZW44660 Replacement Remote Control User Manual

For Yamaha AV Receivers

1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides instructions for the WINFLIKE RAV552 ZW44660 Replacement Remote Control, designed for use with various Yamaha AV Receiver models. This remote offers a direct replacement solution, providing full functionality without the need for programming.

2. SETUP

2.1 Battery Installation

The remote control requires two AAA alkaline batteries (not included). Follow these steps to install the batteries:

1. Locate the battery compartment on the back of the remote control.
2. Slide the battery compartment cover downwards or outwards to open it.
3. Insert two AAA batteries, ensuring the positive (+) and negative (-) terminals align correctly with the markings inside the compartment.
4. Slide the battery compartment cover back into place until it clicks securely.

Note: No programming is required. The remote is ready for use once batteries are installed.

3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

This replacement remote control provides full functionality for compatible Yamaha AV Receiver models. Simply point the remote at your receiver and press the desired function button.

3.1 Compatible Yamaha AV Receiver Models

The RAV552 ZW44660 remote control is compatible with the following Yamaha AV Receiver models:

- RX-V379, RX-V479, RX-V579
- RX-V381, RX-V383, RX-V385
- HTR-3068, HTR-3069, HTR-3071, HTR-3072, HTR-4068
- TSR-5790, TSR-5790BL
- RAV549
- HTR-2071, RX-V283, RX-V283BL

3.2 Key Functions

The remote features standard AV receiver controls. Common functions include:

- **Power Button:** Turns the receiver on or off.
- **Input Selection:** Buttons for BD/DVD, TV, CD, Radio, etc., to select audio/video sources.
- **Volume Control:** Adjusts the master volume level.
- **Mute:** Silences the audio output.
- **Navigation Pad (ENTER, Arrows):** For menu navigation and selection.
- **Setup:** Accesses the receiver's setup menu.
- **Scene:** Pre-programmed scene selection buttons.
- **Program:** Selects sound programs.
- **Tuning:** For radio station tuning.
- **Memory:** For storing and recalling settings.

4. MAINTENANCE

4.1 Cleaning

To clean the remote control, wipe it gently with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use liquid cleaners or abrasive materials, as these may damage the surface or internal components.

4.2 Battery Replacement

Replace batteries when the remote's response becomes sluggish or stops working. Always replace both batteries at the same time with new AAA alkaline batteries. Do not mix old and new batteries, or different types of batteries.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

5.1 Remote Not Responding

- **Check Batteries:** Ensure batteries are inserted correctly with the correct polarity (+/-). Replace with fresh AAA alkaline batteries if necessary.
- **Line of Sight:** Make sure there are no obstructions between the remote control and the AV receiver's infrared sensor.
- **Distance:** Ensure you are within the effective operating range (up to 33 feet).
- **Receiver Power:** Confirm that your Yamaha AV receiver is powered on.
- **Compatibility:** Verify that your AV receiver model is listed in the "Compatible Yamaha AV Receiver Models" section.
