1. INTRODUCTION

- Unpack and Inspect:** Carefully unpack all components and verify against the package contents list. Inspect each part for any damage.
- Prepare Workspace:** Clear a spacious area and lay down a soft cloth or blanket to protect the furniture parts and your floor during assembly.
- Follow Diagrammatic Instructions:** Refer to the detailed diagrammatic instructions provided in the included assembly manual. Each step will illustrate which parts to connect and how.
- Assemble Base Units:** Begin by assembling the main base units, ensuring all connections are secure but not overtightened.
- Attach Shelves and Drawers:** Install any internal shelves and drawer mechanisms as indicated in the manual.
- Connect Extendable Sections:** If applicable, connect the extendable sections, ensuring they slide smoothly. The top half of the extendable section is designed to balance on the lower half, allowing for modular adjustment.
- Final Check:** Once assembled, gently lift and move the cabinet to its desired location. Ensure all screws are snug and the cabinet is stable.

- **TV Placement:** It is perfectly suited for TV screens up to 109 cm (43 inches). Ensure the television's base fits securely on the top surface and does not exceed the maximum load capacity.
- **Storage:** Utilize the drawers for storing DVDs, CDs, remote controls, or other media accessories. The open niches are ideal for media players, game consoles, or decorative items.
