INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the PawHut Large Dog Kennel. This heavy-duty outdoor enclosure is designed to provide a spacious and secure environment for your pets, featuring a galvanized chain link fence and a waterproof cover for protection against the elements. This manual provides essential information for the safe assembly, operation, and maintenance of your new dog kennel.

Please read these instructions thoroughly before beginning assembly and retain this manual for future reference.

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Always ensure the kennel is assembled on a flat, stable surface to prevent tipping.
- Regularly inspect all components for wear, damage, or loose connections. Tighten or replace parts as necessary.
- Ensure the secure lock mechanism is properly engaged when pets are inside the kennel to prevent escape.
- Do not allow children to play unsupervised near or inside the kennel.
- In extreme weather conditions (heavy winds, snow, ice), consider temporarily removing the waterproof cover to prevent damage to the kennel structure.
- Provide adequate water, food, and shelter within the kennel, especially during hot or cold weather.
- This kennel is intended for animal containment only. Do not use for purposes other than its intended design.

PACKAGE CONTENTS

Before beginning assembly, verify that all parts are present and undamaged. If any parts are missing or damaged, please contact customer support.

- Galvanized Steel Frame Components
- Chain Link Mesh Roll
- Waterproof Canopy/Cover
- Gate Assembly with Secure Lock

- All necessary hardware (bolts, nuts, clamps, ties)
- Assembly Tools (typically wrenches, pliers - not always included, but required)

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Assembly requires at least two people. Wear appropriate safety gear, such as gloves, during assembly. Refer to the included diagrams for visual guidance.

Step 1: Assemble the Base Frame

Connect the horizontal and vertical galvanized steel pipes to form the rectangular base of the kennel. Ensure all connections are secure using the provided bolts and nuts.

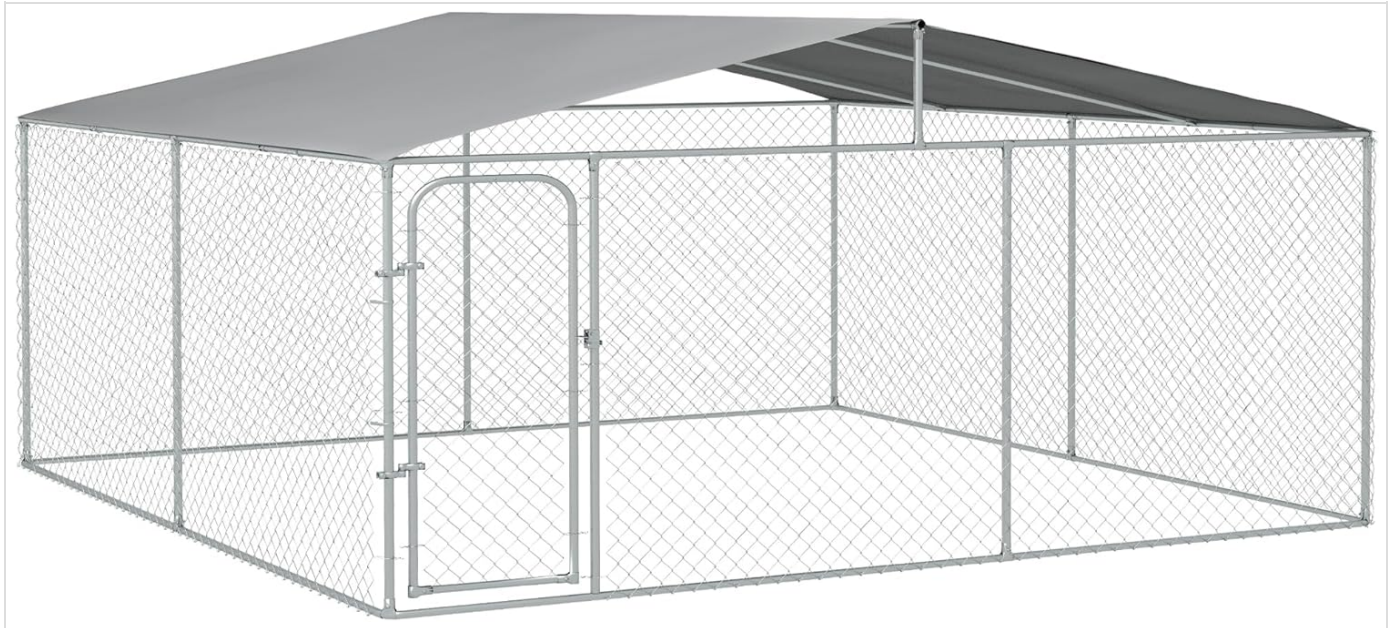
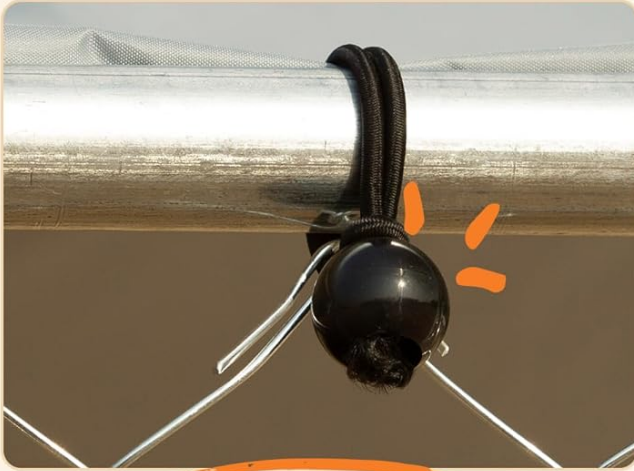


Image: Overview of the fully assembled kennel, showing the frame, chain link, and roof.

Step 2: Install the Chain Link Mesh

Unroll the chain link mesh carefully. Attach it to the assembled frame using the provided ties or clamps. Start from one corner and work your way around, ensuring the mesh is taut and evenly distributed. Pay close attention to securing the mesh at the top, bottom, and along all vertical posts to prevent gaps.

Step 3: Attach the Gate Assembly

Integrate the gate assembly into the designated opening in the frame. Ensure the hinges are properly aligned and the gate swings freely. Install the secure lock mechanism, testing it to confirm it latches firmly.

Step 4: Install the Roof Structure and Waterproof Cover

Assemble the roof support pipes and attach them to the top of the main frame. Drape the waterproof canopy over the roof structure, securing it firmly using the elastic cords or grommets provided. Ensure the cover is taut to prevent water pooling.

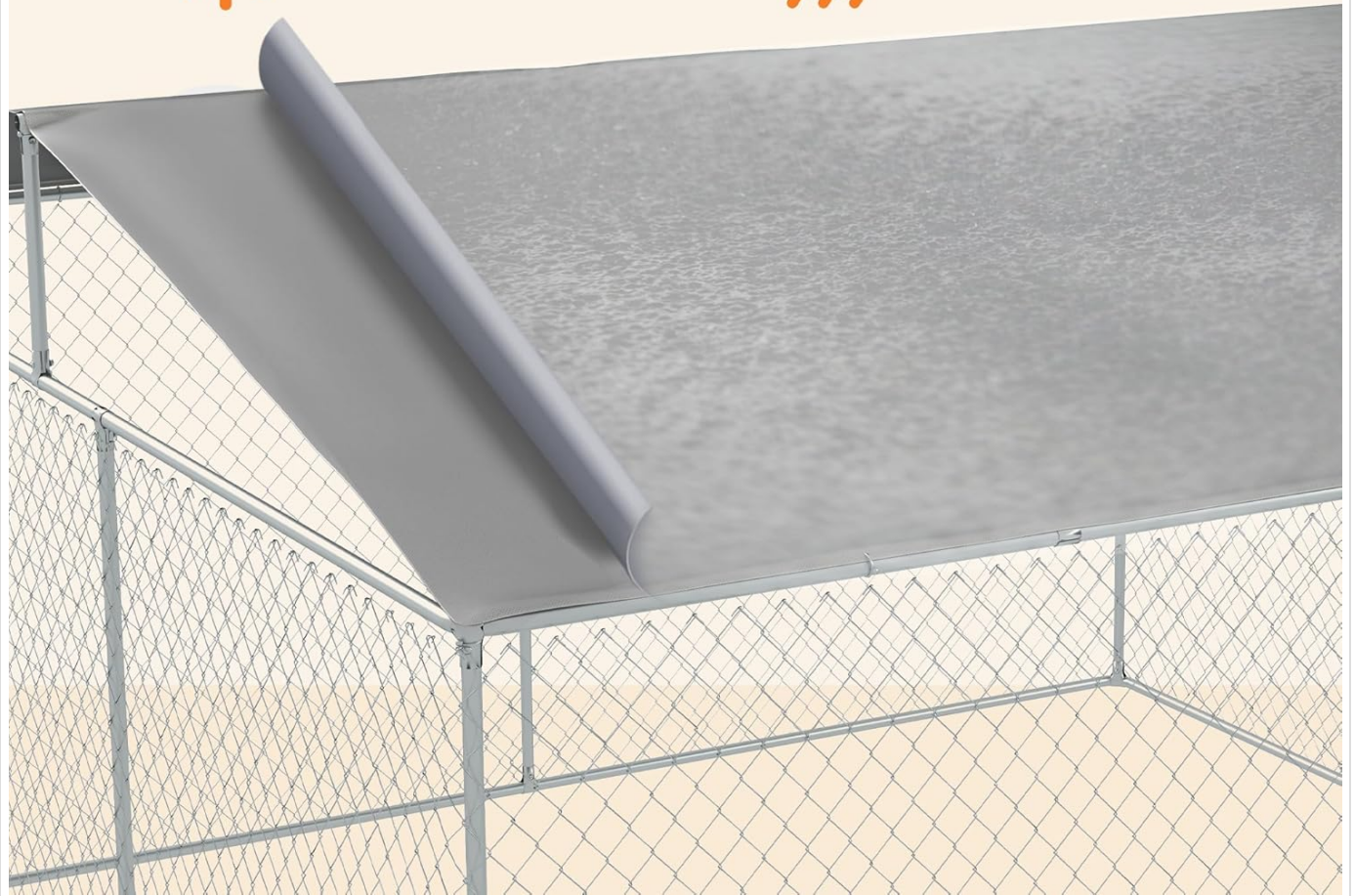


Image: Close-up view of the double-layer Oxford fabric roof, highlighting its UV protection and water resistance features.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

- **Placement:** Choose a level, well-drained area for the kennel. Consider proximity to shade and shelter from prevailing winds.
- **Securing Pets:** Always ensure the gate is fully closed and the secure lock is engaged when your pet is inside the kennel.
- **Comfort:** Provide appropriate bedding, water, and food bowls within the kennel. Ensure adequate space for your pet

to move comfortably.

- **Supervision:** While the kennel provides a secure enclosure, regular supervision of your pet is recommended.

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Regularly clean the kennel area to maintain hygiene. The galvanized surfaces can be wiped down with a damp cloth and mild detergent. Rinse thoroughly.
- **Inspection:** Periodically check all frame connections, chain link integrity, and the gate latch for any signs of wear, rust, or damage. Tighten loose bolts and replace damaged parts promptly.
- **Roof Cover Care:** Clean the waterproof cover with mild soap and water. Ensure it is dry before storing if removed. In heavy snow, remove snow accumulation from the roof to prevent structural stress.
- **Ground Condition:** Monitor the ground beneath the kennel for erosion or unevenness that could compromise stability.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Chain link is tangled or has gaps.	Improper unrolling or insufficient tension during installation.	Carefully untangle the mesh. Re-secure with additional ties or clamps to ensure proper tension and eliminate gaps.
Roof cover sags or collects water.	Cover not taut enough, improper installation of roof supports, or heavy precipitation.	Ensure roof support pipes are correctly installed and the cover is stretched tightly and secured at all attachment points. Clear any accumulated water or snow promptly.
Kennel feels unstable or wobbly.	Uneven ground, loose frame connections, or missing hardware.	Relocate to a level surface or use shims to stabilize. Check and tighten all bolts and connections. Verify all frame components are present and correctly assembled.
Gate does not close or lock properly.	Misaligned hinges, bent gate frame, or damaged latch mechanism.	Inspect hinges for alignment and adjust if necessary. Check the gate frame for any deformation. Ensure the latch mechanism is clear of obstructions and functions smoothly.

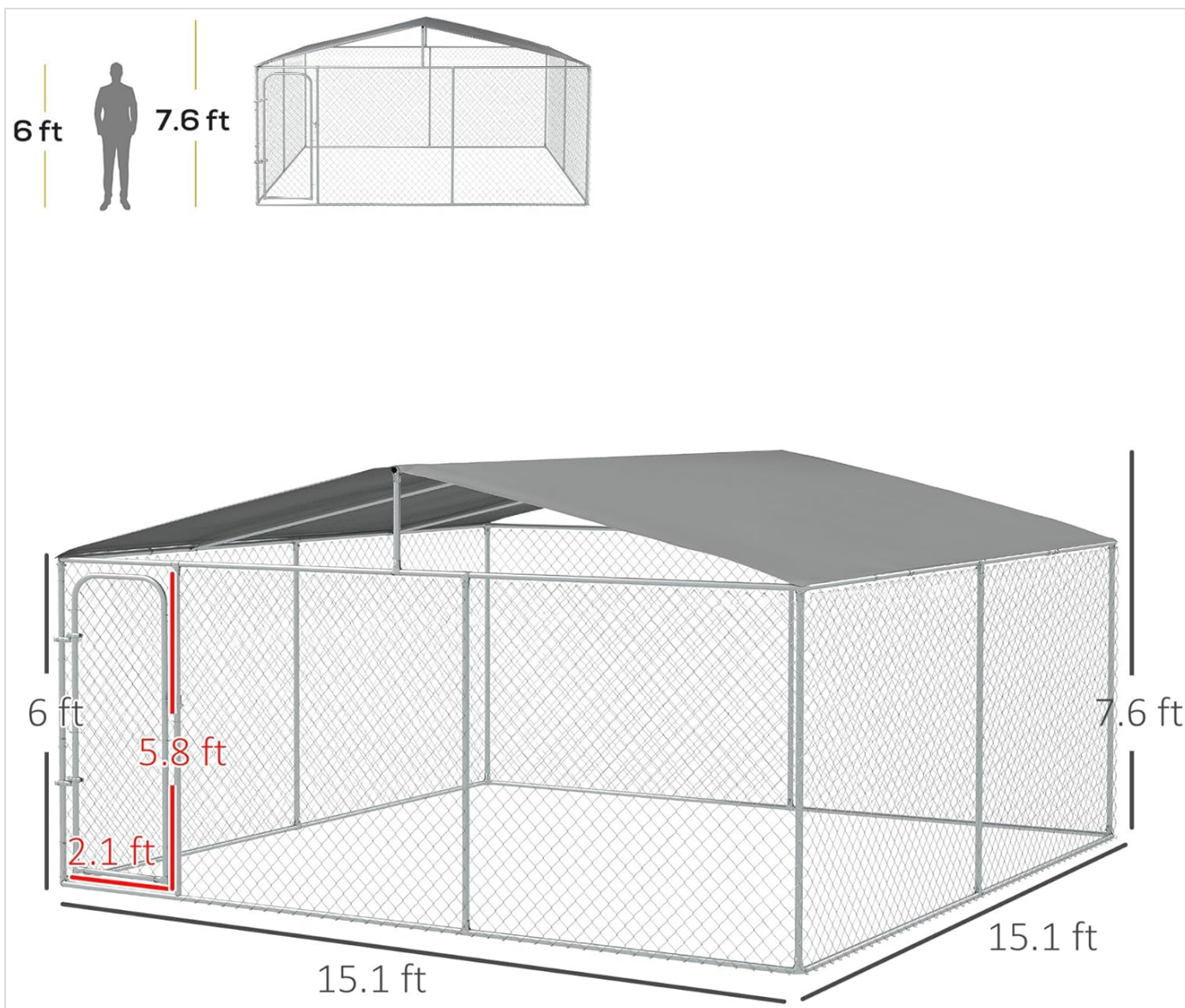


Image: Technical diagram illustrating the length, width, and height dimensions of the kennel.
