1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the safe and efficient operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your Philips Senseo Original Plus CSA210/10 Coffee Machine. Please read this manual thoroughly before first use and keep it for future reference.

The Philips Senseo Original Plus CSA210/10 allows you to enjoy delicious black coffee, whether you prefer a long, mild cup or a short, intense one. This iconic SENSEO coffee machine features an intuitive intensity selector and Aroma Boost technology for an enhanced coffee experience.

2. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Always observe the following basic safety precautions when using electrical appliances:

- Read all instructions carefully.
- Do not immerse the appliance, power cord, or plug in water or other liquids.
- This appliance is intended for household use only.
- Supervise children to ensure they do not play with the appliance.
- Unplug from the outlet when not in use and before cleaning.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug, or after the appliance malfunctions or has been damaged in any manner.
- Use only Philips-recommended accessories.
- Do not place on or near a hot gas or electric burner, or in a heated oven.
- Always attach the plug to the appliance first, then plug the cord into the wall outlet. To disconnect, turn any control to "off", then remove the plug from the wall outlet.

- Do not use the appliance for other than intended use.

3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW AND COMPONENTS

Familiarize yourself with the different parts of your Senseo coffee machine.

- **Water Reservoir:** Located on the side, for filling with fresh water.
- **Pod Holder:** Where the coffee pod is placed.
- **Lid:** Covers the pod holder.
- **Coffee Spout:** Where the brewed coffee dispenses.
- **Drip Tray & Grid:** Collects any drips and supports your cup.
- **Control Panel:** Includes power button, 1-cup button, 2-cup button, and intensity selector.

4. SETUP

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove all packaging materials from the coffee machine.
2. **First Rinse:** Before first use, rinse the water reservoir, pod holder, and drip tray with warm water and a mild detergent.
3. **Positioning:** Place the machine on a stable, flat surface. Ensure there is enough space around the machine for proper ventilation.
4. **Fill Water Reservoir:** Fill the water reservoir with fresh, cold tap water up to the MAX indication. Do not exceed the MAX level.
5. **Power Connection:** Plug the power cord into a grounded wall outlet.
6. **First Brew Cycle (without coffee):**
 - Place a bowl under the coffee spout.
 - Press the 1-cup button to start a brewing cycle without a coffee pod.
 - Repeat this process at least twice to clean the internal system.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Brewing Coffee

1. **Fill Water Reservoir:** Ensure the water reservoir is filled with fresh, cold water.
2. **Place Pod:** Open the lid and place one or two Senseo coffee pods into the appropriate pod holder. For one cup, use the single pod holder. For two cups, use the double pod holder. Ensure the pod is centered.
3. **Close Lid:** Close the lid firmly until it clicks into place.
4. **Select Intensity:** Use the intensity selector to choose your preferred coffee strength:
 - **Mild/Long:** For a softer, longer coffee.
 - **Strong/Short:** For a more intense, shorter coffee.

5. **Place Cup(s):** Place one or two cups on the drip tray under the coffee spout.
6. **Start Brewing:** Press the 1-cup button or the 2-cup button, depending on your selection. The machine will start brewing.
7. **Enjoy:** Your coffee is ready when the machine stops dispensing. The machine will automatically shut off after a period of inactivity.

5.2 Key Features

- **Coffee Intensity Selection:** Easily switch between a mild, long coffee and a strong, short coffee to suit your preference.
- **Aroma Boost Technology:** This technology utilizes 45 aroma nozzles to ensure optimal water distribution over the coffee pod, extracting the fullest flavor and aroma.
- **Crema Plus System:** Enjoy a consistently fine and velvety crema layer on every cup of Senseo coffee, enhancing the taste experience.
- **Automatic Shut-off:** For energy saving and safety, the machine automatically turns off after a period of inactivity.

6. MAINTENANCE

6.1 Daily Cleaning

- **Drip Tray and Grid:** Empty and rinse the drip tray and grid after each use.
- **Pod Holder:** Remove and rinse the pod holder after each use.
- **Water Reservoir:** Rinse the water reservoir daily and refill with fresh water.
- **Exterior:** Wipe the exterior of the machine with a damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaning agents.

6.2 Descaling

Regular descaling is crucial to maintain optimal performance and extend the lifespan of your coffee machine. The frequency depends on water hardness and usage.

1. **Prepare Descaling Solution:** Use a Senseo-approved descaling agent. Follow the instructions on the descaling agent packaging for proper dilution.
2. **Fill Reservoir:** Pour the descaling solution into the water reservoir.
3. **Start Descaling Cycle:** Place a used coffee pod (to filter scale particles) in the pod holder and close the lid. Place a large bowl under the coffee spout. Press both the 1-cup and 2-cup buttons simultaneously until the descaling indicator lights up.
4. **Rinse Cycles:** After the descaling cycle is complete, rinse the water reservoir thoroughly and fill it with fresh water. Run two full brewing cycles with fresh water (without coffee pods) to rinse the machine.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Machine does not turn on.	Not plugged in; power outage.	Check power connection; check household fuse.
Coffee is not hot enough.	Machine needs descaling; cups are cold.	Descal the machine; pre-heat cups with hot water.
Coffee flow is slow or blocked.	Machine needs descaling; pod holder is clogged.	Descal the machine; clean the pod holder.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Water leaks from the machine.	Water reservoir not properly seated; lid not closed correctly.	Ensure water reservoir is correctly placed; close the lid firmly.
No coffee is dispensed.	No water in reservoir; pod not placed correctly.	Fill water reservoir; ensure pod is centered in the holder.
