Setup and Installation

Operating Guidelines

The Valberg 36051207 outer glass panel is designed for durability and safety. To ensure its proper function and longevity:

- Avoid Impact: Do not strike the glass panel with hard objects, as this can cause cracks or breakage.
- **Temperature Changes:** While the glass is designed to withstand high temperatures, avoid sudden extreme temperature changes, such as pouring cold water on a hot glass panel.
- **Proper Closure:** Always ensure the oven door is fully closed during operation to maintain proper insulation and cooking performance.

Maintenance and Cleaning

Apply the cleaner according to its instructions, allow it to sit, and then wipe clean. Avoid using abrasive pads, scouring powders, or harsh chemicals that can scratch or damage the glass surface.
- Avoid Sharp Objects: Do not use razor blades or sharp metal objects to scrape off residue, as this can permanently scratch the glass.
- Cool Surface: Always clean the glass panel when it is cool to the touch to prevent burns and ensure cleaning
 product effectiveness.

Troubleshooting

If you encounter issues with your Valberg outer glass panel, consider the following common solutions:

- Glass Appears Loose: If the glass panel feels loose, it may indicate that the securing screws or clips are not tightened sufficiently. Refer to the "Setup and Installation" section to re-secure the panel. Ensure not to overtighten.
- Condensation Between Panels: If condensation appears between the outer and inner glass panels, it might indicate a seal issue or that the door was not properly reassembled. Review the installation steps or consult a technician.
- Scratches on Glass: Minor scratches can sometimes be polished out with specialized glass scratch removal kits, but deep scratches may require panel replacement. Prevent scratches by avoiding abrasive cleaners and tools.
- Cracked or Shattered Glass: A cracked or shattered glass panel requires immediate replacement. Do not use the oven until the panel is replaced to ensure safety and proper insulation.
