# PHILIPS SHB1603/10 Bluetooth Mono Headset User Manual

Model: SHB1603/10

## 1. INTRODUCTION

---

This manual provides instructions for the PHILIPS SHB1603/10 Bluetooth Mono Headset. This device is designed for clear, echo-free calls and A2DP music streaming, offering a comfortable and secure fit with soft gel earplugs. It supports wireless hands-free communication and can connect to two Bluetooth devices simultaneously. Please read this manual carefully before using your headset to ensure proper operation and to maximize its lifespan.

## 2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

---

The PHILIPS SHB1603/10 is a compact and lightweight mono Bluetooth headset. It features Bluetooth v5.0 for stable wireless connectivity and supports both Handset Profile (HSP), Hands-Free Profile (HFP) for calls, and Advanced Audio Distribution Profile (A2DP) for music streaming.

## 2.1 Package Contents

- PHILIPS SHB1603/10 Bluetooth Mono Headset
- USB Charging Cable
- Quick Start Guide (refer to this manual for detailed instructions)

## 3. SETUP

---

### 3.1 Initial Charging

Before first use, fully charge the headset.

1. Connect the small end of the supplied USB charging cable to the charging port on the headset.
2. Connect the other end of the USB cable to a powered USB port (e.g., computer, USB wall adapter).
3. The indicator light on the headset will show charging status (e.g., red for charging, blue/off for fully charged).
4. Once fully charged, disconnect the charging cable.

**Note:** A full charge typically takes approximately 1-2 hours.

## 4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

### 4.1 Power On/Off

- **To Power On:** Press and hold the Multi-function button until the indicator light flashes blue.
- **To Power Off:** Press and hold the Multi-function button until the indicator light flashes red and then turns off.

### 4.2 Pairing with Bluetooth Devices

The headset can be paired with mobile phones, tablets, and other Bluetooth-enabled devices.

1. Ensure the headset is powered off.
2. Press and hold the Multi-function button for approximately 5-7 seconds until the indicator light flashes blue and red alternately. This indicates the headset is in pairing mode.
3. On your Bluetooth device, enable Bluetooth and search for available devices.
4. Select "PHILIPS SHB1603/10" from the list of found devices.
5. If prompted for a password, enter "0000".
6. Once paired, the indicator light on the headset will flash blue periodically.

### 4.3 Dual Device Pairing

The PHILIPS SHB1603/10 supports connecting to two Bluetooth devices simultaneously.

1. Pair the headset with the first device as described in section 4.2.
2. Disable Bluetooth on the first device.
3. Put the headset back into pairing mode (power off, then press and hold Multi-function button until blue/red flashes).
4. Pair the headset with the second device.
5. Enable Bluetooth on the first device. The headset should automatically reconnect to both devices.

**Note:** While connected to two devices, only one device can actively stream audio or handle calls at a time.

### 4.4 Call Management

- **Answer/End Call:** Press the Multi-function button once.
- **Reject Call:** Press and hold the Multi-function button for approximately 2 seconds.
- **Redial Last Number:** Double-press the Multi-function button.
- **Switch between Call and Music:** During a call, press the Multi-function button to switch audio source if music is playing.

### 4.5 Music Streaming (A2DP)

Once paired, the headset can stream audio from your device.

- **Play/Pause:** Press the Multi-function button once.
- **Volume Control:** Use the volume buttons on your connected device.

## 5. MAINTENANCE

---

## 5.1 Cleaning

- Wipe the headset with a soft, dry cloth.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- Ensure the charging port is free of dust and debris.

## 5.2 Storage

- Store the headset in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- Avoid storing with heavy objects that could damage the headset.

## 5.3 Water Resistance

The headset is rated as waterproof. However, avoid prolonged submersion or exposure to high-pressure water jets. Always ensure the charging port cover is securely closed to maintain water resistance.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Solution
Headset does not power on.	Ensure the headset is charged. Connect it to a power source using the USB cable.
Cannot pair with a device.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Ensure the headset is in pairing mode (flashing blue and red alternately).</li><li>• Ensure Bluetooth is enabled on your device.</li><li>• Move the headset closer to your device.</li><li>• Try restarting both the headset and your device.</li><li>• Clear previous Bluetooth connections on your device.</li></ul>
No audio or poor audio quality.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Ensure the headset is properly connected to your device.</li><li>• Adjust the volume on both the headset and your device.</li><li>• Move closer to your device to avoid interference.</li><li>• Check if another device is connected (if using dual pairing).</li></ul>
Microphone not working.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Ensure the headset is properly connected and selected as the audio input device on your phone.</li><li>• Check for any obstructions near the microphone.</li></ul>
