1. SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read all safety instructions before operating the Smart Air Sqair Air Purifier. Failure to follow these instructions may result in electric shock, fire, or injury.

- Always unplug the air purifier before moving it, cleaning it, or performing any maintenance.
- Do not operate the unit with a damaged cord or plug. If the cord or plug is damaged, contact customer support.
- Keep the power cord away from heated surfaces.
- Do not use the air purifier in wet or damp environments, such as bathrooms or laundry rooms.
- Do not insert fingers or foreign objects into any openings of the air purifier.
- Ensure the air inlet and outlet are not blocked.
- This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
- Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.

2. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Carefully unpack your Smart Air Sqair Air Purifier and ensure all items are present:

- Smart Air Sqair Air Purifier Unit
- H13 HEPA Filter
- Activated Carbon (VOC) Filter
- Power Cord
- Smart Air Handbook (this manual)

3. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps to set up your Smart Air Sqair Air Purifier:

1. **Attach the Wooden Legs:** Turn the air purifier upside down. Screw the four wooden legs into the designated holes on the base in a clockwise direction until secure.
2. **Open the Unit:** Press the side buttons on both sides of the unit to lift the top body.
3. **Remove Filters from Packaging:** Take out the HEPA and Activated Carbon (VOC) filters. Remove all plastic packaging from both filters.
4. **Insert Filters:** First, insert the Activated Carbon (VOC) filter into the base. Ensure the handle is facing up. Then, place the H13 HEPA filter on top of the VOC filter, making sure the "UP" arrow is facing upwards.
5. **Close the Unit:** Carefully place the top body back onto the purifier base, ensuring it clicks securely into place.
6. **Connect Power:** Plug the short end of the power cable into the port on the back of the air purifier.

Then, plug the other end into a standard wall socket.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Smart Air Sqair Air Purifier features a simple analog dial for operation:

- **Power On/Off:** Rotate the dial clockwise to turn the unit on. Rotate it counter-clockwise to turn it off.
- **Speed Settings:** The dial offers three fan speed settings:
 - **Speed 1 (Low):** Ideal for quiet operation, such as in bedrooms or during sleep. Produces approximately 23 dB(A) of noise.
 - **Speed 2 (Medium):** Suitable for continuous purification in most living spaces. Produces approximately 43 dB(A) of noise.
 - **Speed 3 (High):** Provides maximum airflow for rapid air cleaning, useful for larger areas or when air quality is poor. Produces approximately 52 dB(A) of noise.
- **Placement:** For optimal performance, place the air purifier in a central location within the room, away from walls or furniture that might obstruct airflow.

Sleep peacefully and wake up to a fresh room with our quiet 26dB low mode.




Image: The air purifier operating quietly in a bedroom setting.

5. MAINTENANCE (FILTER REPLACEMENT)

Regular filter replacement is crucial for maintaining the efficiency and performance of your Smart Air Sqair Air Purifier. It is recommended to change your filters every 9-12 months, depending on usage and air quality.

Filter Replacement Steps:

1. **Power Off and Unplug:** Turn off the air purifier and unplug it from the wall outlet.
2. **Lift Off Top Body:** Press the side buttons on both sides of the unit and lift the top body.
3. **Remove Old Filters:** Carefully remove the old HEPA and Activated Carbon (VOC) filters. Dispose of them responsibly.
4. **Clean Base (Optional):** While the filters are out, you may gently wipe the inside of the purifier base with a dry cloth to remove any accumulated dust.
5. **Insert New Filters:** Place the new Activated Carbon (VOC) filter into the base first, ensuring its handle is facing up. Then, place the new H13 HEPA filter on top, with the "UP" arrow facing upwards.

6. **Reassemble:** Place the top body back onto the purifier base, ensuring it is securely closed.
7. **Plug In and Resume Operation:** Plug the air purifier back into the wall outlet and turn it on.




Image: The HEPA and Activated Carbon filters, emphasizing their role in air purification.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your Smart Air Sqair Air Purifier, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Unit does not turn on	Power cord not properly connected; No power from outlet.	Ensure power cord is securely plugged into both the unit and a working wall outlet. Test the outlet with another device.
Low airflow	Filters are dirty or clogged; Air inlet/outlet blocked.	Check and replace filters if necessary. Ensure nothing is obstructing the air intake or exhaust vents.
Unusual noise	Foreign object inside; Unit not placed on a flat surface; Filters not installed correctly.	Unplug the unit and check for any foreign objects. Place the unit on a stable, flat surface. Reinstall filters to ensure they are seated properly.
Odor persists	Activated Carbon filter is saturated.	Replace the Activated Carbon (VOC) filter.
