1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the assembly, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your Hot Wheels Mario Kart Bowser's Castle Chaos Modular Track. Please read this manual thoroughly before use to ensure proper setup and safe operation.

The Bowser's Castle Chaos track set allows for side-by-side racing with Hot Wheels Mario Kart replica vehicles. It features a Bowser figure obstacle, lap flags, and modular design for connection with other Hot Wheels Mario Kart track sets (sold separately).

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- **Age Recommendation:** This product is recommended for ages 3 years and older.
- **Small Parts:** The set may contain small parts which could pose a choking hazard for young children. Adult supervision is recommended.
- **Assembly:** Adult assembly may be required. Follow all assembly instructions carefully.
- **Usage:** Use only with official Hot Wheels Mario Kart vehicles. Do not use with other vehicles that may not be compatible or could cause damage.
- **Placement:** Set up the track on a flat, stable surface to prevent tipping or collapse during play.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all components are present before beginning assembly. The package should contain:

- Track pieces (various shapes and sizes)
- Bowser figure and castle base
- Lap flag mechanisms
- One Hot Wheels Mario Kart replica vehicle (Yoshi included)
- Connectors

4. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps to assemble your track set:

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully remove all track pieces, the Bowser figure, lap flags, and the vehicle from the packaging.
2. **Assemble Base:** Connect the main base sections that form the starting line and the Bowser's Castle area. Ensure connections are secure.
3. **Attach Track Loops:** Securely attach the yellow loop track pieces to the Bowser's Castle section.
4. **Connect Outer Tracks:** Attach the long red track pieces to form the outer racing lanes, connecting them back to the starting/finish line area.

5. **Install Lap Flags:** Insert the lap flag mechanisms into their designated slots at the finish line.
6. **Position Bowser:** Place the Bowser figure onto its designated spot within the castle structure.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once assembled, you are ready to race:

1. **Place Vehicles:** Position one Hot Wheels Mario Kart vehicle on each starting launcher.
2. **Launch:** Simultaneously press the launchers to send the vehicles speeding down the track.
3. **Navigate Obstacles:** The vehicles will race through the loops and attempt to pass Bowser, who may swing his fists to impede progress.
4. **Lap Counting:** As vehicles complete laps, they will trigger the lap flags. The first vehicle to complete the set number of laps (typically 5, as indicated by the flags) wins.




Image 5.1: Side-by-side racing action on the track.

The track can be reconfigured and connected to other Hot Wheels Mario Kart track sets (Piranha Plant, Thwomp Ruins, Mario Kart Circuit) for expanded play options.

6. MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Wipe down track pieces and figures with a soft, dry cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- **Storage:** When not in use, store the track set in a clean, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Disassemble if necessary for compact storage.
- **Inspection:** Periodically inspect all track connections and moving parts for wear or damage. Replace any damaged components immediately.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Vehicles do not complete the track or lose momentum.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Insufficient launch force. ◦ Track not assembled correctly (gaps or misalignments). ◦ Incompatible vehicle used. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Ensure launchers are pressed firmly and simultaneously. ◦ Check all track connections for secure fit. ◦ Use only official Hot Wheels Mario Kart vehicles.
Bowser's arms do not swing or move correctly.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Bowser figure not seated properly. ◦ Internal mechanism obstruction or defect. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Ensure Bowser is correctly positioned in its slot. ◦ Inspect for any visible obstructions. If the issue persists, contact customer support.
Lap flags do not register correctly.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Flags not installed correctly. ◦ Vehicle not hitting the trigger mechanism. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Re-install lap flags, ensuring they are fully seated. ◦ Verify track alignment leading to the flags.
