INTRODUCTION

Key Components:

- Antenna: For 4G/LTE signal reception.
- Power/Volume Knob: To turn the device on/off and adjust volume.
- Channel/Function Knob: For selecting channels or functions.
- PTT (Push-to-Talk) Button: For initiating voice transmissions.
- Speaker/Microphone: Integrated for audio input and output.
- Battery Compartment: Houses the removable battery.
- Belt Clip: For convenient carrying.
- Charging Contacts: Located at the bottom for cradle charging.

SETUP

1. Battery Installation:

- 4. Secure the battery cover if applicable.

2. Charging the Battery:

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Power On/Off:

- To power on, rotate the Power/Volume knob clockwise until you hear a click.
- To power off, rotate the Power/Volume knob counter-clockwise until you hear a click.

Adjusting Volume:

• Rotate the Power/Volume knob clockwise to increase volume and counter-clockwise to decrease volume.

Using Zello/ZelloWork:

The Inrico T522A is optimized for Zello and ZelloWork applications.

- 1. Ensure the Zello or ZelloWork application is installed and configured on the device.
- 2. Log in to your Zello/ZelloWork account.
- 3. Select the desired channel or contact.
- 4. Press and hold the PTT button to transmit your voice. Release the PTT button to listen.

MAINTENANCE

• Cleaning: Use a soft, damp cloth to clean the exterior of the radio. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.

- **Battery Care:** To prolong battery life, avoid fully discharging the battery frequently. Store the radio and battery in a cool, dry place when not in use for extended periods.
- **Environmental Protection:** While the radio is waterproof and dustproof (IP66), avoid prolonged exposure to extreme temperatures or direct sunlight.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Radio does not power on.	Battery is low or not installed correctly.	Charge the battery or re-install it securely.
No audio from speaker.	Volume is too low; speaker is blocked; network issue.	Increase volume; check for obstructions; verify network connection.
Cannot transmit/receive.	No network signal; Zello/ZelloWork not logged in; incorrect channel.	Check network signal strength; log into Zello/ZelloWork; select correct channel.
Poor audio quality.	Weak network signal; interference.	Move to an area with better signal; avoid sources of interference.
