INTRODUCTION

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The AIWA ESTM-101 earphones are designed for clear audio and convenient communication. Familiarize yourself with the main components and included accessories:

Main Components:

- **Earphone Units:** Each unit contains a 10mm Neodymium speaker driver for audio output.
- **In-line Remote with Microphone:** Located on the cable, this unit allows for call control and includes a microphone for hands-free communication.
- **3.5mm Audio Jack:** The standard connector for audio devices.
- **Braided Cable:** A 1.2-meter long, tangle-free cable connecting the components.

Included Accessories:

- **Silicone Ear-tips (S, M, L):** Three pairs of different sizes to ensure a comfortable and secure fit.
- **Velcro Belt:** For cable management and tidy storage.
- **Cable Clip:** To secure the cable to clothing.
- **Cloth Pouch:** For convenient and protective storage of your earphones.

SETUP

Follow these steps to set up your AIWA ESTM-101 earphones:

1. **Choose the Right Ear-tips:** Select the silicone ear-tips (S, M, or L) that provide the most comfortable

and secure fit for your ears. A good seal is crucial for optimal sound quality and bass response. Gently pull off the pre-installed ear-tips and push on the desired size.

2. **Connect to Your Device:** Insert the 3.5mm audio jack firmly into the headphone port of your smartphone, tablet, laptop, or any compatible audio device. Ensure the connection is secure.
3. **Proper Ear Placement:** Gently insert the earphone units into your ear canals. The 'L' (left) and 'R' (right) markings on the earphone units indicate the correct orientation. Adjust them until they feel snug and comfortable.
4. **Cable Management:** Use the included cable clip to attach the cable to your clothing, reducing cable sway and microphonics (noise from cable movement). Use the Velcro belt to keep the cable tidy when not in use or for storage.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The AIWA ESTM-101 earphones are designed for straightforward operation:

Audio Playback:

- Once connected to your device, begin playing audio. Adjust the volume directly on your connected device.
- The earphones are compatible with both iOS and Android devices.

Using the In-line Remote (Call Control):

The in-line remote provides basic control for calls and media playback:

- **Answer/End Call:** Press the button once to answer an incoming call. Press it again to end an active call.
- **Play/Pause Music:** Press the button once to play or pause music playback.
- **Next Track:** Double-press the button to skip to the next song.
- **Previous Track:** Triple-press the button to go back to the previous song.

Microphone Usage:

- The integrated microphone allows for hands-free calling. Ensure the microphone is positioned clearly, ideally near your mouth, for optimal voice pickup, especially in noisy environments.

MAINTENANCE

Proper care will extend the life and performance of your earphones:

- **Cleaning Earphone Units and Ear-tips:** Regularly clean the earphone units and silicone ear-tips with a soft, dry, lint-free cloth. For ear-tips, you may gently remove them and wash with mild soap and water, ensuring they are completely dry before reattaching. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- **Cable Care:** The braided cable is designed to be tangle-free. Avoid excessive pulling, bending, or twisting of the cable, especially near the connectors. When storing, use the provided Velcro belt to keep the cable neatly coiled.
- **Storage:** When not in use, store your earphones in the provided cloth pouch to protect them from dust, dirt, and physical damage. Avoid storing them in extreme temperatures or high humidity.
- **Water Resistance:** The earphones are rated as 'Water Resistant'. This means they can withstand light splashes or sweat. They are not designed for submersion in water or exposure to heavy rain. Avoid

using them during swimming or showering.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your AIWA ESTM-101 earphones, refer to the following common solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No sound or low volume	- Loose connection - Device volume too low - Incorrect ear-tip size/fit - Audio source issue	- Ensure the 3.5mm jack is fully inserted into the device. - Increase the volume on your connected device. - Try different ear-tip sizes to achieve a better seal. - Test with another audio source or device.
Microphone not working	- Loose connection - Device settings - Microphone obstruction	- Ensure the 3.5mm jack is fully inserted. - Check your device's audio input settings to confirm the external microphone is selected. - Ensure the microphone on the in-line remote is not covered.
Sound imbalance (one side louder/softer)	- Partial connection - Debris in earphone unit - Device audio balance settings	- Reconnect the 3.5mm jack firmly. - Gently clean the earphone nozzle to remove any debris. - Check your device's audio settings for balance control. - Test with another device to rule out a device-specific issue.
Remote control not responding	- Incompatible device - Loose connection	- While compatible with most iOS/Android devices, some older or specific models may have limited remote functionality. - Ensure the 3.5mm jack is fully inserted.
