1. INTRODUCTION

The Coodoo Water Marbling Paint Kit offers a unique artistic experience, allowing users to create beautiful, one-of-a-kind patterns on water and transfer them to paper. This traditional marbling technique is engaging for all ages and requires no prior painting experience. It's a creative activity designed to stimulate imagination and provide a fun, educational art project.

2. KIT CONTENTS

Your Coodoo Water Marbling Paint Kit No. 728 includes all necessary components to begin your marbling journey:

- 6 bottles of 16 ml paint (various colors)
- 20 sheets of A5 paper
- 3 needles for swirling
- 1 pipette
- 1 spreader
- 1 measuring spoon
- 1 tray
- Carrageenan powder sachets
- Instruction manual

PAINTING FLUID PREPARATION

Introduction: 250ml water+1 spoon carrageenan mix until fully dissolved (6 hours)



- Note: Carrageenan takes about 6 hours to dissolve because we don't add any chemicals. It's all-natural and safer.

3. SETUP

3.1. Fluid Preparation

1. Pour 250ml of water into the provided tray.
2. Add one spoon of carrageenan powder to the water.
3. Stir the powder slowly into the water until there are no large clumps.
4. Allow the mixture to rest for 4 to 5 hours. This resting period is crucial for the powder to fully dissolve and create the proper marbling fluid consistency. Patience is key for successful fluid preparation.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once your marbling fluid is prepared, you can begin creating your art:

1. **Drip Paint:** Gently drip small amounts of different colored paints onto the surface of the marbling fluid using the paint bottles or pipette. Observe how the colors spread and interact.
2. **Swirl Designs:** Use the needles or spreader to gently swirl and drag the colors on the fluid's surface. Experiment with different motions to create unique patterns, such as flowers, waves, or abstract designs.
3. **Transfer Art:** Carefully place a sheet of paper onto the surface of your marbled design. Ensure the entire paper surface makes contact with the paint.
4. **Lift and Dry:** Gently lift the paper from one corner, allowing excess fluid to drip off. Place your newly marbled paper on a flat surface to dry completely.

5. MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning Tools:** After each use, rinse all tools (needles, spreader, pipette, tray) thoroughly with water to prevent paint from drying and hardening.
- **Paint Storage:** Ensure paint bottle caps are securely tightened after use to prevent drying. Store paints in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight.
- **Fluid Disposal:** The marbling fluid can be safely disposed of down the drain with running water.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Paint Sinks or Doesn't Spread:** This often indicates the marbling fluid is not properly prepared. Ensure the carrageenan powder has fully dissolved by allowing sufficient resting time (4-5 hours). The fluid should have a slightly viscous consistency.
- **Colors Mix Too Much:** If colors blend excessively instead of forming distinct patterns, you might be using too much paint or swirling too vigorously. Use smaller drops and gentle movements.
- **Paper Doesn't Pick Up Design:** Ensure the paper is placed flat onto the fluid's surface, making full contact with the paint. Lift the paper slowly and steadily.
- **Bubbles on Fluid Surface:** Gently skim the surface with a piece of paper or a clean tool to remove any air bubbles before dripping paint.

7. SAFETY INFORMATION

The pigments and carrageenan powder included in the Coodoo Water Marbling Paint Kit are safe, non-toxic, and environmentally friendly. This kit is recommended for children aged 3 years and older. Adult supervision is advised for younger children to ensure proper use and to assist with fluid preparation and cleanup.
