1. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Read all instructions carefully before operating the appliance. Failure to follow these instructions may result in electric shock, fire, and/or serious injury.

General Safety

- Always wear appropriate personal protective equipment, including safety glasses and hearing protection.
- Do not operate the pressure washer in explosive atmospheres, such as in the presence of flammable liquids, gases, or dust.
- Keep children and bystanders away while operating the pressure washer.
- Ensure the power cord and extension cords are in good condition and rated for outdoor use.
- Never direct the water jet at people, pets, or electrical equipment.
- Always disconnect the power supply before performing any maintenance or cleaning.

Electrical Safety

- This appliance is equipped with a corded electric power source. Ensure the voltage and frequency match the specifications on the product label.
- Use only a properly grounded outlet.
- Do not use the appliance if the power cord or plug is damaged.
- Avoid using extension cords unless absolutely necessary. If an extension cord is used, ensure it is rated for outdoor use and has a sufficient gauge to handle the power requirements of the machine.

Water Safety

- Connect the pressure washer only to a cold water supply.
- Do not use the pressure washer with contaminated water.
- Ensure all water connections are tight to prevent leaks.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Crown CT42022 is a high-pressure washer designed for various cleaning tasks. Familiarize yourself with its components before use.

Main Components:

1. **High-Pressure Hose:** Connects the machine to the spray gun.

2. **Spray Gun:** Controls the water flow and pressure.
3. **Nozzles:** Various nozzles for different spray patterns and intensities.
4. **Water Inlet:** Connection point for the garden hose.
5. **Detergent Tank (if applicable):** For applying cleaning solutions.
6. **Power Cord:** Connects to the electrical outlet.
7. **Wheels:** For easy portability.
8. **Handle:** For maneuvering the unit.

3. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Follow these steps to correctly set up your pressure washer before first use.

3.1 Initial Assembly

1. **Attach the Handle:** Secure the handle to the main unit using the provided screws or clips.
2. **Connect High-Pressure Hose:** Attach one end of the high-pressure hose to the outlet on the pressure washer and the other end to the spray gun. Ensure connections are hand-tight.
3. **Attach Nozzle:** Select the appropriate nozzle for your task and attach it to the spray gun.

3.2 Water Connection

1. **Connect Garden Hose:** Attach a standard garden hose (not supplied) to the water inlet on the pressure washer. Ensure the connection is secure and leak-free.
2. **Turn on Water Supply:** Fully open the water tap to allow water to flow through the garden hose to the pressure washer.
3. **Purge Air:** Before connecting power, squeeze the trigger on the spray gun for approximately 30 seconds to purge any air from the system. This helps prevent damage to the pump.

3.3 Electrical Connection

1. **Plug In:** Once water is connected and air is purged, plug the power cord into a grounded electrical outlet.
2. **Power On:** Switch the pressure washer to the "ON" position.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

This section details how to safely and effectively operate your Crown CT42022 High Pressure Washer.

4.1 Starting the Pressure Washer

1. Ensure all connections (water, power, hose, gun) are secure.

2. Turn on the water supply completely.
3. Turn the pressure washer's power switch to the "ON" position.
4. Squeeze the trigger on the spray gun to begin spraying. The motor will start when the trigger is pressed and stop when released.

4.2 Using Detergent (if applicable)

1. Fill the detergent tank with a pressure washer safe cleaning solution.
2. Attach the detergent nozzle (usually a black or low-pressure nozzle) to the spray gun.
3. The pressure washer will automatically draw detergent when operating at low pressure.
4. After applying detergent, switch to a high-pressure nozzle and rinse thoroughly.

4.3 Cleaning Techniques

- Always start with a wide spray pattern and low pressure, gradually increasing as needed.
- Keep the nozzle a safe distance from the surface to avoid damage.
- Work from top to bottom on vertical surfaces to allow detergent to work and rinse downwards.
- Overlap your spray passes slightly to ensure even cleaning.

4.4 Stopping the Pressure Washer

1. Release the trigger on the spray gun.
2. Turn the pressure washer's power switch to the "OFF" position.
3. Turn off the water supply.
4. Squeeze the trigger on the spray gun to release any remaining pressure in the system.
5. Disconnect the power cord from the outlet.
6. Disconnect the garden hose from the water inlet.

5. MAINTENANCE AND STORAGE

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and extends the lifespan of your pressure washer.

5.1 After Each Use

- **Rinse Detergent Tank:** If detergent was used, rinse the detergent tank thoroughly with clean water.
- **Flush System:** Run clean water through the system for a few minutes to remove any chemical residues.
- **Clean Nozzles:** Clear any blockages from the nozzles using the provided nozzle cleaning tool or a thin wire.
- **Wipe Down:** Wipe the exterior of the machine with a damp cloth to remove dirt and debris.

5.2 Storage

- **Drain Water:** Ensure all water is drained from the pump, hose, and spray gun to prevent freezing damage.
- **Winterization (for cold climates):** Use a pump protector or non-toxic antifreeze solution if storing in temperatures below freezing.
- **Store in a Dry Place:** Store the pressure washer in a dry, protected area where it will not be exposed to extreme temperatures.
- **Coil Hoses and Cords:** Neatly coil the high-pressure hose, garden hose, and power cord for organized storage.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Motor does not start.	No power supply; tripped circuit breaker; faulty switch.	Check power connection; reset circuit breaker; contact service.
Low pressure.	Insufficient water supply; clogged nozzle; air in pump; worn pump seals.	Ensure full water flow; clean nozzle; purge air from system; contact service.
Water leaks.	Loose connections; damaged O-rings or seals.	Tighten connections; replace O-rings/seals.
Detergent not dispensing.	Detergent tank empty; wrong nozzle selected; clogged detergent line.	Refill tank; use low-pressure/detergent nozzle; clear line.
