INTRODUCTION

The Jada Toys Pixar Cars 1:24 Lightning McQueen RC Remote Control Car brings the excitement of the Piston Cup to life. This full-function remote control vehicle features 2.4GHz technology for extended range and multi-player racing, along with convenient USB charging. Designed for racers aged 6 and up, this model offers precise control and durable construction for hours of fun.

SAFETY INFORMATION

- Always operate the RC car in a safe environment, away from people, pets, and obstacles.
- Do not operate near water or in wet conditions to prevent electrical damage.
- Keep fingers, hair, and loose clothing away from the wheels and moving parts.
- Adult supervision is recommended for children under 10 years old.
- Do not attempt to modify or disassemble the product, as this may cause damage or injury.
- Use only the specified batteries and charging methods.

WHAT'S IN THE BOX

- 1x Lightning McQueen RC Car
- 1x Pistol Grip Remote Control
- 2x AAA Batteries (for remote control)
- Built-in USB Charging Cable (for car)

SETUP

1. Car Charging

The Lightning McQueen RC car features a built-in USB charging cable for convenient recharging. Locate the charging port on the underside of the car. Connect the integrated USB cable to any standard USB power source (e.g., computer USB port, USB wall adapter). The car's indicator light will show charging status (e.g., solid red for charging, off when fully charged). A full charge typically takes approximately 60-90 minutes.

2. Remote Control Battery Installation

The remote control requires 2 AAA batteries (included). Open the battery compartment on the back of the remote control. Insert the batteries, ensuring correct polarity (+/-). Close the battery compartment securely.

3. Power On and Pairing

Turn on the RC car using the ON/OFF switch located on its underside. Turn on the remote control. The car and remote should automatically pair via 2.4 GHz frequency. A successful connection is usually indicated by a solid light on both the car and the remote. If pairing fails, turn both devices off and on again, ensuring they are close to each other.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Basic Controls

- **Forward/Backward:** Use the left control stick to move Lightning McQueen forward or backward.
- **Left/Right:** Use the right control stick to steer Lightning McQueen left or right.
- **Turbo Boost:** Press the "TURBO" button on the remote for an extra burst of speed.

2. Driving Tips

- Practice in an open area to get accustomed to the controls.
- The 2.4 GHz frequency allows for a control range of up to 100 feet.
- Avoid driving on rough terrain or thick carpets, as this may affect performance and battery life.
- For optimal performance, ensure the car is fully charged before each play session.

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the car and remote with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use harsh chemicals or immerse in water.
- **Storage:** Store the product in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures when not in use.
- **Battery Care:** Remove batteries from the remote control if storing for extended periods. Ensure the car's battery is fully charged before long-term storage to maintain battery health.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Car not responding to remote.	Low battery in car or remote; not paired; out of range.	Recharge car battery. Replace remote batteries. Turn both off and on to re-pair. Move closer to the car.
Car moves slowly or inconsistently.	Low car battery; interference; driving surface.	Fully recharge car battery. Move to an area with less interference. Drive on smooth, flat surfaces.
Remote indicator light not on.	Dead batteries; incorrect battery installation.	Replace AAA batteries. Check battery polarity.
