INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Outwell Sleepin Double Mat 7.5 CM. This self-inflating sleeping mat is designed to provide comfort and insulation for your outdoor adventures. Please read this manual carefully before first use to ensure proper setup, operation, and maintenance.

SAFETY INFORMATION

- Do not expose the mat to open flames or extreme heat sources.
- · Avoid sharp objects that could puncture the mat.
- · Keep out of reach of small children when not in use.
- · Do not use as a flotation device.
- Store in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight.

- 1 x Outwell Sleepin Double Mat 7.5 CM
- 1 x Carry Bag

SETUP AND INFLATION

The Outwell Sleepin Double Mat is a self-inflating mat. Follow these steps for initial setup and inflation:

- 1. Unroll the Mat: Remove the mat from its carry bag and unroll it completely on a flat, clean surface.
- 2. **Open the Valve:** Locate the valve(s) on the mat. Open the valve by turning it to the "Inflate" or "Open" position. You may hear air entering the mat.

- 3. **Allow Self-Inflation:** Allow the mat approximately 5-10 minutes to self-inflate. The foam inside will expand and draw air into the mat.
- 4. **Top-Up (Optional):** If you prefer a firmer mat, you can manually top up the air by blowing into the valve. Close the valve immediately after topping up to prevent air from escaping.

5. **Close the Valve:** Once the desired firmness is achieved, firmly close the valve by turning it to the "Airtight" or "Closed" position.

DEFLATION AND PACKING

To deflate and pack your Outwell Sleepin Double Mat:

1. **Open the Valve:** Open the valve by turning it to the "Deflate" or "Open" position.

- 2. **Roll the Mat:** Starting from the end opposite the valve, begin to tightly roll the mat, pushing the air out as you go. You can kneel on the mat as you roll to help expel air.
- 3. Close the Valve: Once rolled, close the valve to prevent air from re-entering.
- 4. Secure and Store: Use the integrated straps or the provided carry bag to secure the rolled mat.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- Cleaning: Clean the mat with a damp cloth and mild soap. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners. Allow to air dry completely before storing.
- **Storage:** For long-term storage, it is recommended to store the mat unrolled with the valve open in a cool, dry place. This helps the foam maintain its loft and self-inflating properties.
- Puncture Repair: In case of a small puncture, use a standard sleeping mat repair kit (not included) to patch the hole.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Mat not fully inflating:

- Ensure the valve is fully open.
- Allow more time for self-inflation, especially if the mat has been stored rolled up for a long period.
- Manually top up the air by blowing into the valve.

Air leaking from mat:

- Ensure the valve is securely closed and in the "Airtight" position.
- Check for punctures. Locate leaks by applying soapy water to the surface and looking for bubbles. Repair with a suitable patch kit.


