1. INTRODUCTION

The Uthfy Oscillating Tower Fan is designed to provide comfortable and healthy air circulation for your home or office. This ETL certified tower fan features a bladeless design for safety, powerful airflow, and multiple convenient functions including remote control, timer, and wide oscillation. Its slim, space-saving design makes it ideal for various indoor environments.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

For your safety and to prevent damage to the appliance, please read all instructions carefully before use. This fan is ETL certified, ensuring it meets safety standards. The bladeless design prevents accidental contact with moving parts, making it safe for households with children and pets. It is equipped with a fused safety plug to protect against power surges and voltage overload.

- Always unplug the fan before cleaning or performing any maintenance.
- Do not insert fingers or objects into the fan grille.
- Ensure the fan is placed on a stable, level surface to prevent tipping.
- Do not use the fan in wet or damp environments.
- Keep the power cord away from heated surfaces.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all items are present in the package:

- 1 x Tower Fan
- 1 x Front Fan Base
- 1 x Rear Fan Base
- Thumbs Screws (for base assembly)
- 1 x Remote Controller

4. SETUP

Follow these steps to assemble and set up your Uthfy Tower Fan:

1. Carefully remove all components from the packaging.
2. Connect the Front Fan Base and Rear Fan Base together to form a complete circular base.
3. Align the assembled base with the bottom of the tower fan unit. Ensure the fan's power cord passes through the designated opening in the base.
4. Secure the base to the fan unit using the provided thumbs screws. Tighten them firmly but do not overtighten.
5. Place the assembled fan on a stable, flat surface.
6. Plug the power cord into a standard 120V AC electrical outlet.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Your Uthfy Tower Fan can be operated using the control panel on top of the unit or the included remote control.

Control Panel & Remote Control

The control panel features intuitive buttons for easy operation. The remote control offers full functionality from a distance, up to 26 feet.

Convenient Remote Control

Effortlessly control all functions from the convenience of your cozy bed or sofa

- **On/Off Button:** Powers the fan on or off.
- **Speed Button:** Cycles through fan speeds: Low, Mid, High.
- **Mode Button:** Selects wind modes:
 - *Normal Mode:* Provides a steady, consistent airflow.
 - *Natural Mode:* Simulates natural breeze by varying wind intensity.
 - *Sleep Mode:* Offers a gentle, quiet breeze for undisturbed sleep.
- **Timer Button:** Sets the auto-off timer in 0.5-hour increments, up to 7.5 hours. The control panel screen will turn off after 30 seconds of inactivity in Sleep Mode to minimize light disturbance.
- **Swing Button (OSC):** Activates or deactivates the wide-angle oscillation feature (up to 90 degrees) to circulate air across a larger area.

6. MAINTENANCE

Regular cleaning and maintenance will ensure optimal performance and longevity of your fan.

- **Cleaning the Exterior:** Wipe the exterior surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Dust Removal:** Use a vacuum cleaner with a brush attachment to gently remove dust from the air intake and outlet grilles.
- **Storage:** If storing the fan for an extended period, unplug it, clean it thoroughly, and store it in a cool, dry place, preferably in its original packaging.
- Do not immerse the fan in water or any other liquid.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your fan, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Fan does not turn on.	No power supply; power cord not fully plugged in; power outlet malfunction.	Ensure the fan is properly plugged into a working electrical outlet. Check the circuit breaker.
Weak airflow.	Fan speed set too low; air intake/outlet blocked by dust or debris.	Increase the fan speed. Clean the air intake and outlet grilles.
Oscillation not working.	Oscillation feature is off; obstruction preventing rotation.	Press the Swing button on the control panel or remote. Check for any obstructions around the fan base.
Remote control not working.	Batteries are dead or incorrectly inserted; remote is too far or obstructed.	Replace the remote control batteries (1 CR2 battery included). Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote and the fan. Move closer to the fan.
