## INTRODUCTION

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Thank you for choosing the Himimi Ice Maker Machine. This portable countertop ice maker is designed to provide fresh ice cubes quickly and efficiently. With its compact design and user-friendly features, it is ideal for home use, parties, camping, RV trips, and office environments. This manual provides detailed instructions for the safe operation, setup, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your new ice maker.

## SAFETY INFORMATION

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Please read all instructions carefully before operating the appliance. Keep this manual for future reference.

- Ensure the ice maker is placed on a stable, level surface away from direct sunlight or heat sources.
- Do not immerse the appliance, power cord, or plug in water or other liquids.
- Always unplug the ice maker before cleaning or when not in use.

- Keep children away from the ice maker during operation.
- Do not operate the appliance with a damaged cord or plug.

## PRODUCT COMPONENTS

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The Himimi Ice Maker Machine comes with the following main components:

- Main Ice Maker Unit

- Removable Ice Basket
- Ice Scoop
- Drain Plug (located at the bottom)
- Large Viewing Window (on top lid)
- Control Panel with Indicator Lights

## SETUP

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove the ice maker from its packaging. Remove all packing materials, including any tape or protective film.
2. **Placement:** Place the ice maker on a flat, stable surface. Ensure there is adequate ventilation around the unit, leaving at least 4 inches of space from walls or other objects. Avoid placing it near heat sources or in direct sunlight.
3. **Initial Cleaning:** Before first use, clean the interior of the ice maker. Refer to the 'Maintenance and Cleaning' section for detailed instructions.

4. **Power Connection:** Plug the power cord into a grounded electrical outlet.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps to make ice with your Himimi Ice Maker:

1. **Add Water:** Open the top lid and pour clean, potable water into the water reservoir. Do not exceed the maximum water level indicator. The unit has a 2.2L water tank capacity.



# EASY TO OPERATE

- 1 ADD WATER**  
Up to 2L of water can be added at a time. Large water tank capacity avoids the interruption of ice making  

- 2 MAKE ICE**  
Switch on, select ice size (small or large). Fresh ice will be ready in 6-12 minutes  

- 3 GET FRESH ICE**  
Use ice scoop to remove the ice. Put it in your drink, enjoy iced drink with friends  

- 4 "ICE FULL" & "ADD WATER" indicator**

2. **Turn On and Select Ice Size:** Press the 'ON/OFF' button on the control panel to turn on the ice maker. Then, press the 'SELECT' button to choose your desired ice cube size: **S** (Small) or **L** (Large). The corresponding indicator light will illuminate.

# 2 Selectable Ice Cube Sizes

Popular hollowed-out bullet ice, chewable and cool down your drinks faster

- Ice Making Process:** The ice maker will begin the ice production cycle. The first batch of 9 bullet-shaped ice cubes will be ready in approximately 6-8 minutes. Subsequent cycles will continue automatically as long as there is water in the reservoir and the ice basket is not full.
- Retrieve Ice:** When the ice basket is full, the 'ICE FULL' indicator light will turn on, and the machine will pause operation. Use the provided ice scoop to remove the ice cubes from the basket.
- Add Water Indicator:** If the water level in the reservoir is too low, the 'ADD WATER' indicator light will turn on. Add more water to resume ice production.

## MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

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Regular cleaning ensures optimal performance and hygiene of your ice maker.

1. **Daily Cleaning:** After each use, remove the ice basket and wipe the interior with a soft, damp cloth.
2. **Draining Water:** To drain the water from the reservoir, place a container under the drain plug located at the bottom of the unit. Remove the drain plug to allow water to flow out. Once drained, replace the plug securely.
3. **Deep Cleaning (Weekly/Bi-weekly):** For a more thorough cleaning, mix a solution of water and a small amount of mild detergent. Clean the interior surfaces, including the ice basket and scoop. Rinse thoroughly with clean water.
4. **Exterior Cleaning:** Wipe the exterior of the ice maker with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
5. **Storage:** If storing the ice maker for an extended period, ensure it is completely dry before packing. Store in a cool, dry place.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Himimi Ice Maker, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

<b>Problem</b>	<b>Possible Cause</b>	<b>Solution</b>
Ice maker not turning on.	No power supply.	Check if the power cord is securely plugged into a working outlet.
