


Image 1.1: Front cover of the AK Book AK630 FAQ Scale Figures guide.

Brush Strokes Visible	Paint applied too thickly; insufficient blending.	Apply multiple thin coats instead of one thick coat. Practice blending techniques described in the guide.
Paint Rubbing Off	No primer used; insufficient curing time; no varnish.	Always prime your miniatures. Allow paint to fully dry between coats. Apply a protective varnish.
Poor Color Blending	Paint drying too fast; incorrect paint consistency.	Use a wet palette. Experiment with paint retarders or flow improvers. Ensure paint is thinned appropriately.
