## **INTRODUCTION**

The Revolo RE001 Electronic Keypad Deadbolt offers advanced security and convenience for your home. This keyless entry system provides multiple access options, including keypad codes and traditional keys, ensuring flexible and secure entry. Its robust design and smart features make it an ideal solution for modern households.

Key features include:

- Keyless Entry: Supports up to 20 access codes for family members and temporary codes for guests.
- Auto-Locking: Customizable auto-lock delay (10-99 seconds) or one-touch locking for enhanced security.
- Anti-Peeking Password: Allows entry of random digits before or after your code to prevent code exposure.
- Durable Construction: Made from sturdy zinc alloy with an IP65 weather-resistant rating.

# **SETUP AND INSTALLATION**

The Revolo RE001 is designed for easy installation with minimal tools. A Phillips head screwdriver is typically all that is required. Ensure your door meets the standard preparation requirements before beginning installation.

# **Pre-Installation Checks**

- Verify door thickness (1-3/8" to 2" / 35mm to 50mm).
- Confirm door hole diameter (2-1/8" / 54mm).
- Check backset (2-3/8" or 2-3/4" / 60mm or 70mm).




Figure 2: Door dimensions and lock component measurements for compatibility.

## **Installation Steps**

- 1. Adjust the latch length if necessary to fit your door's backset.
- 2. Install the latch into the door edge, ensuring the correct orientation for your door's swing.
- 3. Install the exterior keypad assembly, ensuring the lock cylinder is correctly aligned with the latch.
- 4. Install the mounting plate on the interior side, aligning its screw with the latch screw.
- 5. Connect the IC wire from the exterior assembly to the interior assembly.
- 6. Mount the interior assembly and secure it with screws.
- 7. Insert 4 AA batteries into the interior assembly.
- 8. Attach the battery cover.

# **OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS**

The Revolo RE001 offers various modes and programming options for personalized security.

## **Programming Master and User Codes**

The lock comes with a default master code. It is highly recommended to change this immediately after installation.

Video 2: RE001 Programming Instruction. This video demonstrates how to change the master code, add user codes, delete user codes, enable vacation mode, and adjust auto-lock settings.

## **Changing Master Code**

Follow the steps in Video 2 (0:03-0:24) to change the default master code to a new, secure code.

## **Adding User Codes**

You can add up to 20 unique user codes for family members or frequent visitors. Refer to Video 2 (0:25-0:46) for instructions.

# **Deleting User Codes**

To remove an existing user code, follow the procedure shown in Video 2 (0:47-1:02).

## **One-Time Codes**

Generate temporary codes that automatically delete after a single use, ideal for one-time guests or deliveries. See Video 2 (1:56-2:15) for details.




Figure 5: One-time code functionality for temporary access.

# **Locking Features**

## **Auto-Lock Function**

The lock can be set to automatically lock after a specified delay (10-99 seconds). This feature ensures your door is always secured. Enable/disable and set delay using Video 2 (1:15-1:41) and (1:42-1:55).




Figure 6: Auto-lock and one-touch locking for convenience and security.

## **Silent Mode**

Enable silent mode to disable keypad beeps for quiet operation. This is useful for not disturbing others. See Video 2 (2:16-2:45) for instructions.

## **Vacation Mode**

Activate vacation mode to temporarily disable all user codes, providing enhanced security when you are away for extended periods. Refer to Video 2 (1:03-1:14) for activation.

# **Weather Resistance**

With an IP65 rating, the deadbolt is designed to withstand various weather conditions, protecting your home in rain or shine.




Figure 8: IP65 waterproof and temperature resistance features.

# **Anti-Peeking Password**

Enhance your security by entering random digits before or after your actual code. This feature prevents others from guessing your code by observing your finger movements.

# **Wrong Code Entry Limit**

For added security, the lock will shut down for 3 minutes after 10 invalid entry codes are attempted.

# MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your Revolo RE001 Electronic Keypad Deadbolt, regular

maintenance is recommended.

- **Battery Replacement:** The lock uses 4 AA batteries. Replace them promptly when the low battery alert is indicated to avoid loss of function.
- **Cleaning:** Wipe the keypad and handle surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners or solvents that could damage the finish or electronic components.
- **Lubrication:** Periodically apply a silicone-based lubricant to the deadbolt mechanism to ensure smooth operation. Do not use oil-based lubricants.
- **Firmware Updates:** Check the Revolo website or app (if applicable) for any available firmware updates to ensure your lock has the latest features and security enhancements.

## **TROUBLESHOOTING**

If you encounter issues with your Revolo RE001, refer to the common troubleshooting tips below. For more complex problems, consult the official Troubleshooting Guide PDF.

### **Common Issues and Solutions**

- Lock not responding to keypad: Check battery levels and replace if necessary. Ensure the master code is correctly entered.
- **Deadbolt not extending/retracting fully:** Verify proper alignment of the lock cylinder and latch during installation. Ensure no obstructions in the door frame.
- Keypad lights not illuminating: This may indicate low battery. Replace batteries.
- Lock cycles back and forth but doesn't change direction: This could be a hardware issue related to the bolt mechanism. Refer to the troubleshooting guide for detailed steps on resetting the lock direction.
