## 1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation of your VIZIO 40-inch D-Series Full HD 1080p Smart TV, model D40f-J09. Please read these instructions thoroughly before using your television and retain them for future reference. This television features a 1080p Full HD display, SmartCast platform for streaming, AMD FreeSync for gaming, and compatibility with Apple AirPlay and Chromecast Built-in.

## 3. SETUP

### 3.1 Physical Installation

**Stand Installation:**

1. Place the TV screen-down on a soft, clean surface to prevent scratches.
2. Align each stand piece with the corresponding slots on the bottom of the TV.

3. Secure the stands using the provided screws.

### Wall Mounting (Optional):

This TV is VESA compliant. For wall mounting, use a VESA-compatible mount (sold separately) and follow the mount manufacturer's instructions. Ensure proper ventilation around the TV.

### Connecting Devices:

Connect your external devices such as cable boxes, gaming consoles, or Blu-ray players to the TV's input ports.

- **Antenna:** For connecting an over-the-air antenna.
- **Digital Audio Out (SPDIF):** For connecting to external audio systems.


## 3.2 Initial Power On & Network Connection

1. Connect the power cable to the TV and then to a power outlet.
2. Press the Power button on the remote control or on the TV.
3. Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the initial setup, including selecting your language, country, and connecting to your Wi-Fi network. A stable internet connection is required for Smart TV features.

- **WatchFree+:** Enjoy free access to live TV channels and on-demand content directly through the WatchFree+ app.


## 4.2 Remote Control


- **Power:** Turns the TV on or off.

- **Cleaning the Screen:** Gently wipe the screen with a soft, dry, lint-free cloth. For stubborn marks, lightly dampen the cloth with water or a screen cleaner specifically designed for electronics. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- **Cleaning the Frame:** Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe the TV frame and stand.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure the ventilation openings on the back of the TV are not blocked to prevent overheating.
- **Power Cord:** Regularly check the power cord for any damage. If damaged, discontinue use and contact

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your VIZIO TV, try the following basic troubleshooting steps:

- **No Power:** Ensure the power cable is securely connected to both the TV and the power outlet. Try a different outlet.
- **No Picture/Sound:** Verify the correct input source is selected. Check all cable connections to external devices.
- **No Internet Connection:** Restart your router and modem. Reconnect the TV to your Wi-Fi network through the TV's settings menu.
- **Remote Not Working:** Replace the batteries in the remote control. Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote and the TV's IR sensor.
- **Picture Quality Issues:** Adjust picture settings (brightness, contrast, color) in the TV's menu. Ensure the content source is high quality.
