SETUP

Connecting to Xbox Consoles (Xbox Series X|S, Xbox One)

1. Locate the 3.5mm audio jack on your Xbox controller.
2. Plug the 3.5mm connector from your LVL50 headset firmly into the controller's audio jack.
3. The headset should be automatically detected. You may need to adjust audio settings on your Xbox console for optimal sound and microphone levels.

Connecting to PC (Windows 10-11)

1. Locate the 3.5mm audio port on your PC. If your PC has separate ports for microphone and audio, you may need a PC splitter cable (not included).
2. Plug the 3.5mm connector from your LVL50 headset into the combined audio port or the appropriate audio/microphone ports using a splitter.
3. Navigate to your PC's sound settings to select the headset as your default playback and recording device.
4. For spatial sound, ensure Windows Sonic for Headphones is enabled in your sound settings.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Volume Control

The headset features an on-ear volume control dial, typically located on one of the earcups. Rotate the dial to increase or decrease the audio volume to your desired level.

Microphone Usage

The flexible boom microphone can be adjusted to your preferred position for clear voice pickup. For optimal performance, position the microphone approximately 1-2 inches from your mouth.

Flip-to-Mute Feature

To mute the microphone, simply flip the boom microphone upwards until it clicks into its vertical position. To unmute, flip the microphone back down to its active position.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning

- Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe down the headset's surfaces.
- For stubborn dirt, slightly dampen the cloth with water. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- Do not immerse the headset in water or any other liquids.
- Gently clean the earcup cushions and headband padding.

Storage

When not in use, store your headset in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Avoid placing heavy objects on top of the headset to prevent damage.

TROUBLESHOOTING

No Audio / Low Audio:

- Ensure the 3.5mm jack is fully inserted into the controller or device.
- Check the volume control dial on the headset and ensure it is turned up.
- Verify that the headset is selected as the default audio output device in your console or PC sound settings.
- Test the headset with another device to rule out a device-specific issue.

Microphone Not Working:

- Ensure the microphone is flipped down into the active (unmuted) position.
- Check your console or PC's microphone settings to ensure the headset microphone is selected and its input volume is adequate.
- Confirm that the 3.5mm jack is securely connected.
- Test the microphone in a different application or with another device.

Uncomfortable Fit:

- Adjust the headband to fit your head size. The earcups should sit comfortably over your ears.
- Take short breaks during long gaming sessions to alleviate pressure.
