INTRODUCTION

This device combines a versatile digital radio with a powerful Bluetooth speaker, offering multiple audio playback options and convenient alarm clock functionalities. This manual provides detailed instructions to help you set up, operate, and maintain your device for optimal performance.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW



Controls and Connections:

- Display: LCD screen for information and menu navigation.
- Memory Button: Save and recall preset stations.
- Select Button: Confirm selections.
- Info/Menu Button: Access information and menu settings.
- Scan/Pair Button: Scan for radio stations or initiate Bluetooth pairing.
- Source Button: Switch between DAB, FM, Bluetooth, USB, and AUX modes.
- Preset Buttons: Navigate through preset stations.
- Tuning Buttons: Manually tune radio frequencies.
- Volume/Navigate Dial: Adjust volume and navigate menus.
- USB Port: For MP3 playback from USB flash drives.
- 3.5mm Aux In: Connect external audio devices.

- 3.5mm Aux Out: Connect headphones or external speakers.
- DC 6.5V Power Input: Connect the power adapter.
- Telescopic Antenna: For optimal radio reception.

SETUP

1. Power Connection

- 1. Insert the DC plug of the power adapter into the "DC 6.5V Power" input on the back of the MB420K.
- 2. Plug the power adapter into a standard wall outlet.
- 3. The unit will power on automatically or enter standby mode.

2. Antenna Setup

Extend the telescopic antenna fully for best radio reception, especially for FM and DAB signals.

3. Initial Power On and Time Setting

Upon first power-on, the radio may automatically scan for DAB stations and set the time. If not, you can manually set the time and date via the menu.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Radio Modes (DAB/DAB+/FM)

Press the **Source** button to cycle through DAB, DAB+, and FM radio modes.

Scanning for Stations:

- In DAB mode, press Scan/Pair to perform a full scan for available DAB stations.
- In FM mode, press Scan/Pair to auto-scan and save stations.

Saving Presets:

- 1. Tune to your desired station.
- 2. Press and hold the **Memory** button until "Preset Store" appears.
- 3. Use the **Navigate** dial or **Preset** buttons to select a preset number (1-30).
- 4. Press Select to confirm.

Recalling Presets:

- Press the **Memory** button (short press) to enter preset recall mode.
- Use the Navigate dial or Preset buttons to select the desired preset.
- Press Select to tune to the station.

2. Bluetooth Speaker Mode

Connect your smartphone, tablet, or computer wirelessly to the MB420K.




Image: The August MB420K radio wirelessly connected to a smartphone, illustrating its function as a HiFi Bluetooth speaker for streaming music.

- 1. Press the **Source** button to select "Bluetooth" mode. The display will show "Bluetooth Pairing" or "Bluetooth Connected".
- 2. On your Bluetooth device, enable Bluetooth and search for "MB420K".
- 3. Select "MB420K" to pair. Once connected, you can play audio from your device through the speaker.

3. USB Playback

Play MP3 music files directly from a USB flash drive.

- 1. Insert a USB flash drive containing MP3 files into the USB port on the back of the MB420K.
- 2. Press the **Source** button to select "USB" mode.
- 3. The radio will automatically start playing the first compatible audio file. Use the Tuning buttons to skip tracks.

4. AUX Input

Connect external audio devices using a 3.5mm audio cable.

- 1. Connect one end of a 3.5mm audio cable to the "3.5mm Aux In" port on the back of the MB420K.
- 2. Connect the other end to the headphone jack or audio output of your external device (e.g., MP3 player, phone).
- 3. Press the **Source** button to select "AUX" mode.
- 4. Control playback from your external device.

5. Dual Alarm Clock Function

Set up to two independent alarms to wake you up.

- 1. Press the Info/Menu button, then use the Navigate dial to select "Alarm". Press Select.
- 2. Choose "Alarm 1" or "Alarm 2" and press Select.
- 3. Follow the on-screen prompts to set the alarm time, duration, source (Buzzer, DAB, FM, USB), frequency (Daily, Once, Weekdays, Weekends), and volume.
- 4. Press Select to confirm each setting.

Snooze Function:

When an alarm sounds, press any button (except Power) to activate snooze. The alarm will sound again after a set interval.

6. Sleep Timer

Set the radio to automatically turn off after a specified period.

- 1. Press the Info/Menu button, then use the Navigate dial to select "Sleep". Press Select.
- 2. Use the Navigate dial to select the desired sleep timer duration (e.g., 15, 30, 45, 60, 90 minutes).
- 3. Press **Select** to confirm. The radio will turn off after the selected time.

7. Display Settings (Backlight)

Adjust the backlight brightness of the LCD display.

- 1. Press the Info/Menu button, then use the Navigate dial to select "System Settings". Press Select.
- 2. Select "Backlight" and press Select.
- 3. Choose your desired brightness level (e.g., High, Medium, Low) and pressSelect.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning:

Wipe the surface of the unit with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.

Storage:

If not using the device for an extended period, unplug it from the power outlet and store it in a cool, dry place.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No power	Power adapter not connected or faulty outlet.	Ensure the power adapter is securely connected to the unit and a working power outlet.
Poor radio reception	Antenna not extended or weak signal.	Fully extend the telescopic antenna. Try repositioning the unit for better signal reception. Perform a full scan for stations.
Bluetooth not pairing	Device not in pairing mode or already connected to another device.	Ensure the MB420K is in Bluetooth mode and "Bluetooth Pairing" is displayed. Disconnect from any previously paired devices. Restart both devices.
USB playback not working	Unsupported file format or corrupted USB drive.	Ensure files are in MP3 format. Try a different USB drive or reformat the current one.
Alarm not sounding	Alarm not enabled or volume too low.	Check alarm settings to ensure it is enabled and the volume is set appropriately.


