USER MANUAL

Product Overview

The Browning Strike Force Pro XD Trail Camera is designed for capturing high-quality images and videos of wildlife and for security monitoring. It features advanced Dual Camera Lens Technology, providing optimized performance for both daytime and nighttime conditions. This manual provides detailed instructions for setting up, operating, maintaining, and troubleshooting your camera.

Key Features:

- **Dual Camera Lens Technology:** Dedicated lenses for razor-sharp daytime and clear nighttime images.
- **Fast Action:** 0.15-second trigger speed and 0.5-second picture recovery time.
- **Wide Detection Range:** 80 ft. motion detection range.
- **High-Quality Video:** 1080p Full HD videos with sound (5 seconds to 2 minutes in length).
- **Illuma-Smart Technology:** Automatically adjusts IR flash for optimal night photos.
- **Internal Color Screen:** 1.5-inch color view screen for easy setup and footage review.
- **Flexible Mounting:** All-steel adjustable tree mount bracket.
- **Memory Card Support:** Compatible with up to 512GB SDXC memory cards.
- **Timelapse Plus:** Camera mode with IR triggered images.

Setup

1. Battery Installation

The Strike Force Pro XD Trail Camera requires 6 AA batteries (not included). For optimal performance and battery life, it is recommended to use high-quality alkaline or lithium batteries. The battery tray is easily removed from the bottom of the camera. Insert the batteries according to the polarity indicators (+/-) inside the tray, ensuring they snap securely into place. Reinsert the tray firmly into the camera.



Opening the front panel of the camera reveals the 1.5-inch color view screen and intuitive control buttons for easy setup and footage review.

2. SD Card Installation

The camera supports SDXC memory cards up to 512GB. Locate the SD card slot on the bottom of the unit. Insert the SD card with the label facing up until it clicks into place. To remove, gently push the card in until it springs out. Ensure the camera is powered off before inserting or removing the SD card to prevent data corruption.



The included 32GB SDHC Class 10 memory card ensures fast data write speeds for high-resolution photos and HD video.

3. Mounting the Camera

The Strike Force Pro XD comes with an all-steel adjustable tree mount bracket. Attach the camera to a tree or post using the provided strap, ensuring the bracket is snug against the mounting surface. The bracket allows for angle adjustment, enabling you to point the camera precisely where needed, even downwards towards the ground. Secure the camera firmly to prevent movement from wind or wildlife.



The back of the camera features a robust, adjustable metal bracket designed for secure tree mounting.

4. Initial Settings

Once batteries and SD card are installed, power on the camera. Use the internal 1.5-inch color screen and the control buttons to navigate the menu. The menu system is straightforward: use the up and down arrow buttons to scroll through options, and the OK/Set button to select and confirm changes. Set the current time, date, and desired capture mode (photo, video, or Timelapse Plus).

Operating the Camera

Capture Modes

- **Photo Mode:** Captures still images. You can set the number of multi-shot images (up to 8) or rapid-fire images (up to 8) per trigger event.
- **Video Mode:** Records 1080p Full HD video clips with sound, adjustable from 5 seconds to 2 minutes in length.
- **Timelapse Plus Mode:** Captures images at set intervals throughout the day, with additional IR-triggered images at night. Compatible with Browning Buck Watch Timelapse Viewer Software.

Advanced Features

- **Dual Camera Lens Technology:** Automatically switches between a custom-tuned daytime lens and a dedicated night lens for superior image quality in all lighting conditions.
- **Illuma-Smart Technology:** Intelligently adjusts the infrared flash power to ensure perfectly exposed night photos.
- **Adjustable IR Flash Range:** Customize the flash power settings (Power Save, Long Range, Fast Motion) to suit your specific needs and environment. The flash range extends up to 120 ft.
- **Picture Info Bar:** Each captured image includes an information bar displaying the time, date, temperature, moon phase, and camera ID for easy tracking.

SD Card Management

The camera features an SD Card Management option in the settings menu. This allows you to manage storage space by overwriting older files when the card is full, or to stop recording once the card is full. Regularly check your SD card capacity and transfer data to a computer or external device to prevent loss of important footage.

Maintenance

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the camera body and lenses. Avoid abrasive cleaners or solvents. Ensure the lenses are free of dirt, dust, or smudges for clear images.
- **Battery Replacement:** Replace batteries when the low battery indicator appears on the screen or when performance degrades. Always replace all batteries at once with new ones of the same type.
- **SD Card Care:** Format your SD card periodically using the camera's format function to ensure optimal performance and prevent data corruption. Store SD cards in a protective case when not in use.
- **Environmental Protection:** While the camera is designed for outdoor use, avoid prolonged exposure to extreme temperatures or direct water submersion. Ensure the latch is securely closed to maintain water resistance.

Troubleshooting

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Camera not powering on	Dead or incorrectly installed batteries; faulty battery tray.	Replace batteries with new ones, ensuring correct polarity. Check battery tray for damage.
Poor image/video quality	Dirty lens; incorrect settings; low light conditions.	Clean the camera lens. Adjust image/video resolution settings. Ensure adequate IR flash range for night captures.
Camera not detecting motion	Detection range too short; obstruction in detection zone; incorrect sensitivity settings.	Adjust camera placement. Clear any obstructions. Increase motion sensitivity in settings.
SD card errors or not recognized	Incompatible SD card; corrupted card; card not inserted correctly.	Ensure using a compatible SDXC card (up to 512GB). Format the SD card using the camera's menu. Reinsert the card. Try a different SD card. Note: Some 64MB cards may not be fully compatible.
Short battery life	Frequent triggers; extreme temperatures; low-quality batteries.	Reduce trigger frequency if possible. Use high-quality alkaline or lithium batteries. Consider external 12V power source for prolonged use.


