Introduction

Operating Instructions

The ClimaTek replacement ice maker operates automatically. Once installed and powered, it will sense the temperature and water level to produce ice cubes. The first batch of ice may take several hours to form after installation and power restoration.

Ensure the water supply to your refrigerator is turned on and the water filter (if applicable) is not clogged to allow proper water flow to the ice maker.

Maintenance

- **Regular Cleaning:** Periodically remove the ice bucket and clean it with mild soap and warm water. Rinse thoroughly and dry before returning it to the freezer.
- **Preventing Freezing:** If your refrigerator model is known for ice maker freezing issues, ensure the ice maker compartment door seals properly. Consider checking for air leaks around the compartment.
- **Water Filter:** If your refrigerator has a water filter, replace it according to the manufacturer's recommendations to ensure clean water supply to the ice maker and prevent mineral buildup.

Troubleshooting

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Ice maker not producing ice.	No water supply; clogged water line/filter; ice maker arm stuck; power issue.	Check water supply valve; replace water filter; ensure ice maker arm is free; verify power connection.
Ice maker freezing up or clogging.	Warm air entering compartment; faulty defrost heater (original unit); insufficient insulation.	Ensure compartment door seals tightly; consider adding insulation (e.g., foil tape) to the housing; ensure proper air circulation.
Ice tastes bad or has odor.	Old water filter; stagnant water; food odors in freezer.	Replace water filter; discard old ice and allow new ice to form; clean ice bucket; use an open box of baking soda in the freezer.
