## 1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the assembly, operation, and maintenance of your vidaXL Solid Acacia Wood Folding Patio Table. Designed for outdoor use, this table offers a practical and elegant solution for dining and other activities in your garden, terrace, or patio. Its folding design allows for convenient storage when not in use.

## 2. SAFETY INFORMATION

---

Please read and understand all safety warnings before assembly and use. Failure to follow these instructions may result in injury or damage to the product.

- **Pinch Points:** Be aware of potential pinch points during assembly and when folding or unfolding the table. Keep hands and fingers clear of moving parts.
- **Assembly:** Always follow the assembly instructions carefully. Ensure all fasteners are securely tightened before use.
- **Stability:** Ensure the table is placed on a flat, stable surface. Properly anchor the table if necessary to prevent tipping or collapse, especially in windy conditions.
- **Weight Capacity:** Do not exceed the maximum weight recommendation of 75 kg (165 lbs).
- **Children:** Keep children away from the table during assembly. Supervise children when they are near the table during use.

## 3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

---

Before beginning assembly, verify that all components listed below are present and undamaged. If any parts are missing or damaged, contact vidaXL customer support.

- Tabletop sections (main and extension leaves)
- Leg frames (pre-assembled folding mechanism)
- Assembly hardware (screws, bolts, washers, nuts)
- Assembly Guide (this document)

**Tools Recommended for Assembly:** Screwdriver (not included).

## 4. SETUP & ASSEMBLY

---

Assembly requires two people. Please follow these general steps. Refer to the included assembly guide for detailed diagrams and specific fastener placement.

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully remove all parts from the packaging. Lay them out on a clean, soft surface to prevent scratches.
2. **Identify Parts:** Although parts may not be individually labeled, carefully compare each component to the diagrams in the assembly guide to ensure correct identification. Pay close attention to the orientation of the leg frames.
3. **Attach Leg Frames:** Connect the leg frames to the underside of the tabletop using the provided hardware. Ensure all bolts are aligned correctly before tightening. Do not overtighten initially.
4. **Secure Tabletop Sections:** If the tabletop comes in multiple sections, ensure they are properly aligned and secured according to the assembly guide.
5. **Final Tightening:** Once all components are in place and the table is upright, carefully tighten all screws and bolts. Do not overtighten, as this can damage the wood.
6. **Test Stability:** Gently shake the table to ensure it is stable and all connections are secure.

## 5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

### Folding and Unfolding the Table

The vidaXL patio table features a convenient folding mechanism for easy storage. Always perform these actions with care to avoid injury or damage.

#### 1. To Fold:

- Clear the tabletop of all items.
- Locate the locking mechanisms or hinges on the underside of the table or within the leg structure.
- Carefully disengage the locks (if present) and gently push the leg frames inward, allowing them to fold flat against the tabletop.
- Ensure the table is fully folded and stable before moving or storing.

#### 2. To Unfold:

- Place the folded table on a flat surface.
- Carefully extend the leg frames outward until they are fully open and locked into position.
- Ensure all locking mechanisms are engaged to secure the table in its open position before use.

## 6. MAINTENANCE

---

Proper care and maintenance will extend the life and appearance of your acacia wood patio table.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the table with a damp cloth to remove dirt and spills. For stubborn stains, use a mild soap solution and rinse thoroughly. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- **Oiled Finish:** The table has an oiled finish. To maintain its appearance and weather resistance, re-oil the wood periodically (e.g., annually or as needed) with a suitable outdoor wood oil.
- **Weather Protection:** While acacia wood is weather-resistant, prolonged exposure to extreme weather conditions (heavy rain, direct sunlight, snow) can affect its longevity. Consider using a protective cover or storing the table indoors during harsh weather seasons.
- **Hardware Check:** Periodically check all screws and bolts to ensure they remain tight. Retighten as necessary, but do not overtighten.

## 7. TROUBLESHOOTING

---

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your patio table.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
<b>Table is wobbly after assembly.</b>	Loose fasteners; uneven surface.	Ensure all screws and bolts are fully tightened. Move the table to a flat, level surface.
<b>Difficulty folding/unfolding.</b>	Hinges are stiff; locking mechanism not fully disengaged.	Apply a small amount of silicone lubricant to the hinges. Ensure all locking mechanisms are properly released before attempting to fold/unfold. Do not force the mechanism.
<b>Wood appears dry or faded.</b>	Natural weathering; need for re-oiling.	Clean the table and apply a suitable outdoor wood oil to restore its finish and protection.
<b>Wood splintering during assembly.</b>	Overtightening screws; misaligned parts.	Avoid overtightening fasteners. Ensure parts are correctly aligned before inserting screws. If minor splintering occurs, it can often be repaired with wood glue and clamps.
