# **HOMCOM Rolling Kitchen Island Cart Model 801-172 Instruction Manual**

Your guide to assembly, operation, and maintenance.

## **1. INTRODUCTION**

---

Thank you for choosing the HOMCOM Rolling Kitchen Island Cart Model 801-172. This versatile kitchen cart is designed to enhance your kitchen space with additional storage and a functional work surface. It features a durable bamboo countertop, two easy-glide drawers, two concealed cabinets with adjustable shelves, and a convenient towel/spice rack. The cart is equipped with smooth-rolling casters for easy mobility and two locking brakes for stability.

## 2. SAFETY INFORMATION

---

Please read and understand all safety instructions before assembling or using this product. Failure to follow these instructions may result in injury or damage to the product.

- Do not exceed the maximum weight capacity of 110 lbs (50 kg).
- Use caution when moving the cart on uneven surfaces to prevent tipping.
- Be careful around sharp edges during assembly and use.
- Keep liquids and heat sources away from the bamboo countertop to prevent damage.
- Ensure all parts are properly secured before use. Regularly check and tighten all fasteners.
- Do not allow children to play on, with, or around the cart.

## 3. PARTS LIST

---

Before beginning assembly, please ensure all components are present and undamaged. Refer to the detailed parts list and hardware pack included with your product packaging. If any parts are missing or damaged, do not proceed with assembly. Contact customer support for assistance.

Typical components include:

- Bamboo Countertop
- Side Panels, Back Panels, Base Panel
- Drawer Components (front, sides, back, bottom)
- Cabinet Doors and Hinges
- Adjustable Shelves and Shelf Pins
- Casters (wheels) with Locking Brakes
- Drawer Pulls and Cabinet Handles
- Towel/Spice Rack components
- Various Screws, Dowels, and Connectors

## 4. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

---

Assembly is required for this kitchen island cart. It is recommended to have two people for assembly. Please follow the step-by-step instructions and diagrams provided in your product packaging. Ensure you have a clear, spacious area for assembly.

### General Assembly Steps:

1. **Unpack and Identify Parts:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Lay them out and compare them against the parts list to ensure everything is present.
2. **Assemble the Main Frame:** Connect the side panels, back panels, and base panel using the provided hardware. Ensure all connections are secure.
3. **Install Drawer Slides:** Attach the drawer slides to the interior of the frame according to the instructions.
4. **Assemble Drawers:** Construct the two drawers, ensuring they glide smoothly on the installed slides. Attach the drawer pulls.
5. **Install Cabinet Doors:** Attach the hinges to the cabinet doors and then to the main frame. Adjust hinges as needed for proper door alignment. Attach cabinet handles.
6. **Insert Adjustable Shelves:** Place the shelf pins at your desired height within the cabinets and then rest the adjustable shelves on top.
7. **Attach Towel/Spice Rack:** Secure the towel/spice rack to the side of the cart.
8. **Secure the Countertop:** Carefully place the bamboo countertop on top of the assembled frame and secure it with the designated fasteners.
9. **Attach Casters:** Screw the four smooth-rolling casters to the bottom of the cart. Ensure the two locking casters are positioned at the front for easy access.

## 5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

### 5.1 Using Drawers and Cabinets

The cart features two easy-glide drawers and two cabinets with doors. Pull the handles to open drawers and cabinet doors. The cabinet interiors include adjustable shelves for flexible storage.

### 5.2 Adjusting Shelves

To adjust the height of the shelves, remove any items from the shelf. Lift the shelf and reposition the shelf pins into the desired holes on the cabinet sides. Ensure all four pins are securely in place before resting the shelf back down.

### 5.3 Mobility and Stability

The cart is equipped with four smooth-rolling casters for easy movement. Two of these casters have locking brakes. To move the cart, ensure both brakes are disengaged (unlocked). To secure the cart in place, press down on the levers of the locking casters until they click into the locked position.

#### 5.4 Towel/Spice Rack

Utilize the integrated rack on the side of the cart for hanging kitchen towels or storing frequently used spices and small bottles.

### 6. MAINTENANCE

---

Proper care will extend the life and appearance of your kitchen island cart.

- **Cleaning the Bamboo Countertop:** Wipe the varnished bamboo countertop with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals that could damage the finish. Dry immediately after cleaning.
- **Cleaning Other Surfaces:** For the white MDF surfaces, use a soft, damp cloth and mild soap if necessary. Wipe dry.
- **Hardware Check:** Periodically check all screws and fasteners to ensure they remain tight. Tighten as needed to maintain stability.
- **Caster Maintenance:** Keep casters free of hair, dust, and debris to ensure smooth rolling.

## 7. TROUBLESHOOTING

---

If you encounter any issues with your kitchen island cart, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

- **Cart is Wobbly:**

*Solution:* Ensure all assembly screws and fasteners are securely tightened. Verify that the cart is placed on a flat, even surface. Adjust the casters if necessary to compensate for uneven flooring.

- **Drawers or Cabinet Doors Do Not Align/Close Properly:**

*Solution:* Recheck the assembly of the drawer slides and cabinet hinges. Ensure they are installed correctly and tightened. Hinges often have adjustment screws that can be used to fine-tune door alignment.

- **Cart is Difficult to Move:**

*Solution:* Check that the locking brakes on the casters are fully disengaged. Inspect the casters for any debris (e.g., hair, lint) that might be obstructing their movement. Clean if necessary.

- **Missing or Damaged Parts:**

*Solution:* Do not attempt to force assembly with incorrect or damaged parts. Contact HOMCOM customer support immediately for replacement parts.
