ARREGUI CI10RC Remote Control for Invisible Security Lock

Model: CI10RC | Brand: Arregui

1. INTRODUCTION

This instruction manual provides essential information for the proper use and maintenance of your ARREGUI CI10RC remote control. This remote is designed exclusively for use with ARREGUI invisible security locks, specifically models CI10B-E, CI10P, CI10N, and CI10D. It serves as an additional or replacement unit for your existing lock system.

Please read this manual carefully before attempting to set up or operate the remote control.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The ARREGUI CI10RC is a compact and ergonomic remote control designed for seamless interaction with compatible ARREGUI invisible security locks. It allows for convenient locking and unlocking of your security system.

Compatibility

- This remote control is valid only for use with ARREGUI invisible security locks: CI10P (silver), CI10D (gold), CI10N (black), and CI10B-E (white).
- It is **not** compatible with models CI10P-AL, CI10D-AL, CI20B, CI20N, and CI20P.

Purpose

- **Replacement:** Suitable for replacing a faulty or lost remote control.
- **Additional:** Can be added to an existing ARREGUI Invisible Security Lock system. While the lock typically comes with 4 remote controls, up to 16 remote controls can be paired per lock.

3. SETUP

The ARREGUI CI10RC remote control comes with a CR2032 3V lithium coin cell battery already installed and ready for use. To pair this remote with your ARREGUI invisible security lock, follow the instructions provided with your specific lock model for adding new remote controls. Generally, this involves activating a pairing mode on the lock and then pressing a button on the new remote.

Pairing Process (General Steps)

1. Ensure your ARREGUI invisible security lock is powered on and accessible.
2. Locate the programming button on your ARREGUI lock (refer to your lock's manual for exact location).
3. Activate the pairing mode on the lock by pressing the programming button as instructed by your lock's manual (e.g., press twice and hold). The lock may emit a beep or light indicator.
4. While the lock is in pairing mode, press the desired button (e.g., 'A' or 'B') on the new CI10RC remote control.
5. The lock should confirm successful pairing with an audible signal or light change.
6. Test the remote control to ensure it operates the lock correctly.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once paired, the ARREGUI CI10RC remote control allows you to lock and unlock your invisible security lock from a distance. The remote typically features buttons for locking and unlocking functions.

Basic Functions

- **Lock Button:** Press this button to engage the lock mechanism. The lock will typically emit a confirmation sound.
- **Unlock Button:** Press this button to disengage the lock mechanism. The lock will typically emit a confirmation sound.
- **Emergency Open Button:** Some remotes may feature an emergency open button (e.g., button 'B' as mentioned in some lock manuals). Consult your lock's manual for specific emergency procedures.

Ensure you are within the operational range of the lock for the remote control to function effectively. Obstructions and battery level can affect range.

5. MAINTENANCE

The ARREGUI C110RC remote control requires minimal maintenance, primarily focusing on battery replacement.

Battery Replacement

The remote control uses a standard CR2032 3V lithium coin cell battery. When the remote's range decreases or it becomes unresponsive, it is likely time to replace the battery.

1. Carefully open the remote control casing. This may require a small screwdriver or a prying tool.
2. Remove the old CR2032 battery. Note its orientation (+/-).
3. Insert a new CR2032 3V lithium coin cell battery with the correct polarity.
4. Close the remote control casing securely.
5. Test the remote control with your lock.

Dispose of old batteries responsibly according to local regulations.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your ARREGUI CI10RC remote control, consider the following troubleshooting steps:

- **Remote not responding:**
 - Check the battery: Replace the CR2032 battery in the remote control.
 - Check proximity: Ensure you are within the operational range of the lock.
 - Obstructions: Remove any physical obstructions between the remote and the lock.
 - Re-pair the remote: Follow the pairing instructions in Section 3 to re-establish the connection with the lock.
- **Lock not responding to any remote:**
 - Check the lock's power supply: Ensure the main batteries in the invisible security lock are not depleted.
 - Consult the lock's manual: Refer to the specific troubleshooting section for your ARREGUI invisible security lock model.
- **Reduced range:**
 - Replace the remote control battery.
 - Ensure there are no new sources of interference (e.g., other wireless devices) near the lock or remote.
