SETUP

1. Battery Installation

- 1. Locate the battery compartment on the back of the clock.
- 2. Insert one (1) AA battery, ensuring the positive (+) and negative (-) terminals align correctly with the markings inside the compartment.
- 3. Close the battery compartment cover.

2. Mounting the Clock

The clock is designed for wall mounting. Choose a suitable location on a stable wall.

- 1. Identify a secure spot on the wall where you wish to hang the clock.
- 2. Use a nail or screw (not included) appropriate for your wall type. Ensure it is strong enough to support the clock's weight (approximately 450g).

Setting the Time

- 1. Locate the time-setting knob on the back of the clock, usually near the battery compartment.
- 2. Gently rotate the knob in either direction until the hour and minute hands display the correct time.
- 3. The quartz movement ensures accurate timekeeping once set.

MAINTENANCE

- Cleaning: Wipe the clock surface gently with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Clock not working / Hands not moving	Battery is dead or incorrectly installed.	Replace the AA battery with a new one, ensuring correct polarity (+/-).
Clock losing time	Battery is low.	Replace the AA battery.
Loud ticking sound	Not applicable. The clock features a silent movement.	No action required. This clock is designed for silent operation.
