1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for purchasing the Dxyiitoo Native 1080P Projector. This projector is designed to provide a high-quality visual experience for home theater, gaming, and various multimedia applications. It features native 1080P resolution, WiFi and two-way Bluetooth connectivity, and a large display capability of up to 300 inches. Please read this manual carefully before operating the device to ensure proper usage and longevity.

2. WHAT'S IN THE BOX

Verify that all items are present in the package:

- Dxyiitoo Native 1080P Projector
- Carrying Bag
- Remote Control
- Tripod
- Power Cord
- HDMI Cable
- AV Cable

3. SETUP

3.1 Placement

Place the projector on a stable, flat surface. Ensure there is adequate ventilation around the projector to prevent overheating. For optimal viewing, position the projector perpendicular to the projection surface (screen or wall).

3.2 Power Connection

Connect the power cord to the projector's power input and then plug it into a standard electrical outlet.

3.3 Input Connections

The projector supports multiple input sources. Identify the appropriate port for your device:

- **HDMI:** For connecting devices like TV boxes, DVD players, laptops, gaming consoles (PS4, Xbox), and TV sticks.
- **USB:** For connecting USB drives to play media files.
- **AV:** For connecting older devices using the included AV cable.
- **3.5mm Audio Jack:** For connecting wired headphones or external speakers.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Power On/Off

Press the power button on the projector or the remote control to turn the unit on or off.

4.2 Focus and Keystone Correction

Adjust the focus ring on the projector lens until the image appears clear. Use the keystone correction dial to correct trapezoidal distortion if the projector is not perfectly aligned with the screen. Note that this projector does not feature optical zoom; image size is determined by projection distance.

4.3 Connectivity Options

4.3.1 WiFi and Screen Mirroring

The projector supports wireless screen mirroring for both iOS and Android devices. This allows you to project content from your smartphone or tablet.

- **iOS Devices (Airplay/Screen Mirroring):** Connect your iOS device and the projector to the same WiFi network. Select the 'Airplay' or 'Screen Mirroring' function on your device and choose the projector from the list. You can project app videos using Airplay or mirror your entire screen.
- **Android Devices (Miracast/DLNA):** Connect your Android device and the projector to the same WiFi network. Enable 'Miracast' or 'Screen Mirroring' on your Android device and select the projector.

4.3.2 Data Cable Connection (iOS/Android)

For a direct wired connection, you can use a Lightning cable for iOS devices or an original data cable for Android devices to project content.

4.3.3 Bluetooth Connection

The projector features Bluetooth 5.0, allowing connection to external Bluetooth speakers for enhanced audio. It also supports two-way Bluetooth, meaning your phone or tablet can connect to the projector as an independent speaker.

4.4 Display Quality

The projector offers native 1080P resolution and is compatible with 4K content. With 12000 lumens brightness and a 10000:1 contrast ratio, it delivers clear, bright, and vibrant images. The maximum display size is 300 inches.

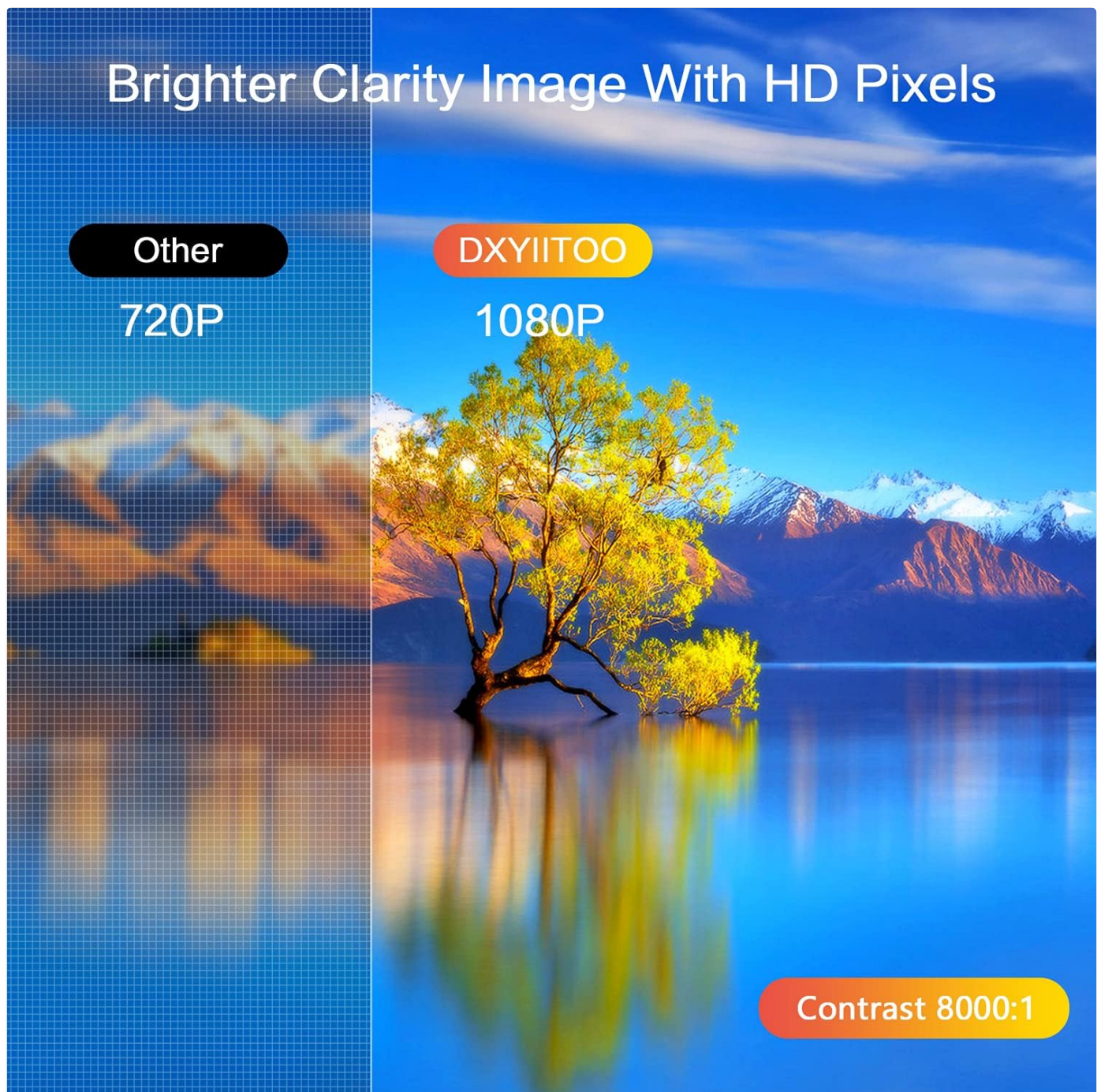


Image 4.5: Visual comparison demonstrating the enhanced clarity of 1080P resolution.

4.5 Usage Scenarios

This projector is versatile and suitable for various entertainment and presentation needs:

- **Home Theater:** Enjoy movies and TV shows on a large screen.
- **Gaming:** Connect your gaming console for an immersive gaming experience.
- **Outdoor Movies:** Perfect for backyard movie nights.
- **Presentations:** Suitable for small meetings or educational purposes.

5. MAINTENANCE

5.1 Cleaning the Lens

Use a soft, lint-free cloth specifically designed for optical lenses to gently wipe the projector lens. Avoid using abrasive cleaners or excessive force.

5.2 Cleaning the Projector Body

Wipe the exterior of the projector with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use liquid cleaners or solvents.

5.3 Ventilation

Ensure that the ventilation vents are not blocked. Regularly check for dust accumulation and gently clean with a soft brush or compressed air if necessary.

5.4 Storage

When not in use for extended periods, store the projector in its carrying bag in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

6.1 No Image or "No Signal" Message

- Check if the power cord is securely connected and the projector is turned on.
- Ensure the input source (HDMI, USB, AV) is correctly selected on the projector.
- Verify that the source device (laptop, TV stick, etc.) is powered on and outputting a signal.
- Try a different HDMI or AV cable.

6.2 Blurry Image

- Adjust the focus ring on the projector lens.
- Ensure the projection distance is within the recommended range.
- Adjust the keystone correction if the image is distorted at the edges.

6.3 No Sound or Low Sound

- Increase the volume on both the projector and the source device.
- If using external speakers, ensure they are properly connected and powered on.
- If using Bluetooth, ensure the Bluetooth device is paired correctly and within range.
- Check if the audio output setting on your source device is set correctly.

6.4 Remote Control Not Working

- Check and replace the batteries in the remote control.
- Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote and the projector's IR receiver.
