INTRODUCTION

This versatile bunk bed features a solid rubberwood frame, a wide ladder, and high guardrails for safety. It can be used as a traditional twin-over-twin bunk bed or easily converted into two separate twin beds to suit your needs.



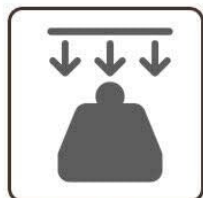

SAFETY INFORMATION AND WARNINGS

WARNING: Failure to follow these warnings and instructions could result in serious injury or death.

- Always use the recommended mattress size for both upper and lower bunks.
- The top bunk is not suitable for children under six years of age.
- Ensure all connections are tight before use and check periodically.
- Do not allow more than one person on the top bunk.
- Prohibit horseplay on or under the bed.
- Always use the ladder for entering and leaving the top bunk.
- Do not attach or hang items to any part of the bunk bed that are not designed for use with the bed; for example, but not limited to, hooks, belts, and jump ropes.
- The guardrails are designed to prevent falls. Ensure they are always properly installed and secured.

- Periodically check and ensure that the guardrail, ladder, and other components are in their proper position, free from damage, and that all connectors are tight.

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

The DORTALA Twin Over Twin Bunk Bed is designed for straightforward assembly. It is recommended that two adults assemble the bed. Please follow the detailed instructions provided in your package for step-by-step guidance.

1. **Unpack and Identify Parts:** Carefully unpack all components and lay them out. Compare them with the parts list in your instruction manual to ensure everything is present and undamaged.
2. **Prepare the Area:** Choose a clear, flat area for assembly.
3. **Assemble Frame Components:** Follow the numerical or alphabetical sequence in your manual to connect the main frame pieces using the provided hardware. Do not fully tighten bolts until the entire frame is assembled.
4. **Install Slats:** Secure the wooden slats onto the bed frames.
5. **Attach Ladder and Guardrails:** Install the ladder and guardrails securely to the top bunk as per the instructions.
6. **Final Tightening:** Once all components are in place, carefully tighten all bolts and screws. Do not overtighten.

This bunk bed can also be assembled as two individual twin beds. Refer to the specific section in your included manual for conversion instructions.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Using as a Bunk Bed:

Once assembled, ensure the bed is placed on a level surface. The wide ladder provides easy access to the top bunk. Always use the ladder for climbing up and down. The high guardrails on the top bunk are designed for safety and should never be removed or altered.

Converting to Two Individual Twin Beds:

The DORTALA Twin Over Twin Bunk Bed offers the flexibility to convert into two separate twin beds. To do this, carefully

disassemble the bunk bed structure by reversing the assembly steps that connect the upper and lower bunks. Ensure you have all necessary hardware to reassemble the headboards and footboards for two standalone twin beds. Refer to your included assembly manual for specific conversion steps.

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the bed frame with a dry cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners, as these can damage the wood finish.
- **Hardware Check:** Periodically (e.g., every 3-6 months) check all bolts, screws, and connections to ensure they remain tight. Re-tighten if necessary to maintain stability and safety.
- **Structural Integrity:** Inspect the wooden frame, slats, ladder, and guardrails for any signs of wear, cracks, or damage. If any damage is found, discontinue use and contact customer support for replacement parts or advice.
- **Environment:** Keep the bed in a dry environment to prevent wood warping or damage from humidity.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Bed feels unstable or noisy:

- **Check Assembly:** Ensure all components are correctly assembled according to the instruction manual.
- **Tighten Hardware:** Re-tighten all bolts and screws. Loose connections are a common cause of instability and noise. Do not overtighten.
- **Level Surface:** Ensure the bed is placed on a flat, level surface. Uneven flooring can cause wobbling.
- **Inspect Slats:** Verify that all wooden slats are properly seated and secured.
