PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Delta Children Tribeca 4-in-1 Convertible Crib is designed to adapt to your child's growth, transitioning from a crib to a toddler bed, daybed, and ultimately a full-size bed. This versatile piece of nursery furniture features a contemporary design with a sleek X-shaped base and airy slats, crafted from durable wood. It offers three adjustable mattress height positions to ensure safety and convenience as your baby develops.

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Assembly of the Tribeca 4-in-1 Convertible Crib is required. It is recommended to follow the detailed instructions provided in the included user manual (PDF link available in the support section) for proper and safe assembly. Ensure all components are present and undamaged before beginning assembly.

- **Unpacking:** Carefully remove all parts from the packaging. Keep small parts away from children.
- **Tools:** Basic household tools may be required for assembly.
- **Mattress Support:** The crib features an adjustable height mattress support with three positions. Select the appropriate height based on your child's age and developmental stage. A standard size crib mattress is required and sold separately.

OPERATING THE 4-IN-1 CONVERTIBLE CRIB

The Tribeca crib offers four conversion options to accommodate your child's growth:

1. **Crib:** Use as a standard crib for infants. The adjustable mattress support allows you to lower the mattress as your child grows and becomes more mobile.
2. **Toddler Bed:** Convert the crib into a toddler bed by removing the front rail and adding a Toddler Guardrail (Model #0080, sold separately). This provides easier access for toddlers while maintaining a sense of security.

3. **Daybed:** Transform the crib into a daybed by removing the front rail entirely. This creates an open seating area suitable for older children or as a small sofa.

4. **Full-Size Bed:** For the final conversion, the crib can be transformed into a full-size bed using the headboard and footboard, or just the headboard. Full Size Wood Bed Rails (Model #0050) or Full Size Metal Bed Frame (Model #0040) are required and sold separately.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Proper care ensures the longevity and safety of your Delta Children Tribeca Crib.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe clean with a damp cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners or strong chemicals that could damage the finish or materials.
- **Materials:** The crib is constructed from sustainable woods like New Zealand Pine and Poplar, with metal components.
- **Safety Standards:** This crib is JPMA certified and tested to meet or exceed all safety standards set by the CPSC & ASTM. It features a non-toxic multi-step painting process that is lead and phthalate safe.
- **Hardware:** Periodically check all screws and bolts to ensure they are tight and secure. Do not overtighten.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your Tribeca Convertible Crib, consider the following common solutions:

- **Wobbling/Instability:** Ensure all assembly hardware is securely tightened. If the crib still feels unstable, especially on uneven surfaces or thick carpets, consider using wall-securing mounts (sold separately) to prevent tipping, particularly as your child grows and becomes more active.
- **Missing Parts:** If any parts are missing upon unpacking, contact Delta Children customer support immediately.
- **Conversion Issues:** Double-check that you are using the correct conversion kits (Toddler Guardrail #0080, Full Size Wood Bed Rails #0050, or Full Size Metal Bed Frame #0040) for the desired configuration. Ensure all parts are aligned correctly during conversion.
