- **Battery:** 7480mAh large-capacity battery for extended usage.
- **Cameras:** 13MP Sony IMX258 rear camera and 5MP front camera.
- **Connectivity:** Supports 4G phone calls, Bluetooth, and Wi-Fi.
- **Operating System:** Android 10.0.

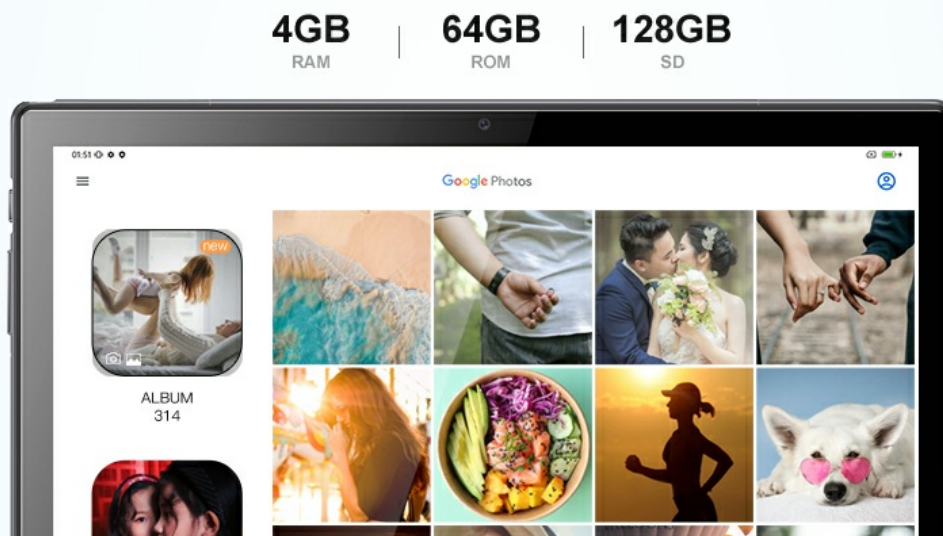


Figure 2.2.3: Visual representation of the Blackview Tab 9's memory and storage capabilities: 4GB RAM for smooth multitasking, 64GB internal ROM, and support for up to 128GB expandable storage via SD card.

3. SETUP

3.1 Initial Power On

1. Ensure the tablet is sufficiently charged. Connect the provided charger to the tablet and a power outlet if the battery is low.
2. Press and hold the Power button (located on the side) until the Blackview logo appears on the screen.
3. Follow the on-screen prompts to select your language, connect to a Wi-Fi network, and set up your Google account.

3.2 SIM Card and TF Card Installation

The Blackview Tab 9 supports dual SIM cards for 4G phone calls and a TF (microSD) card for expandable storage.

1. Locate the SIM/TF card tray on the side of the tablet.
2. Insert the SIM ejector tool into the small hole next to the tray to open it.
3. Carefully place your Nano-SIM cards and/or TF card into the designated slots on the tray, ensuring correct orientation.
4. Gently push the tray back into the tablet until it clicks into place.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Basic Navigation

- **Touch:** Tap an icon or option to select it.
- **Swipe:** Drag your finger across the screen to scroll or navigate between screens.
- **Pinch-to-Zoom:** Use two fingers to zoom in or out on images or web pages.
- **Long Press:** Press and hold an item for more options.

4.2 Connecting Peripherals

The Blackview Tab 9 supports various external devices, including keyboards.

- **Bluetooth Devices:** Go to Settings > Connected devices > Bluetooth to pair Bluetooth keyboards, headphones, or other accessories.
- **Wired Keyboards:** Connect a wired keyboard using an OTG (On-The-Go) cable to the tablet's USB-C port.

4.3 Camera Usage

The tablet features a 13MP rear camera and a 5MP front camera for photos and video calls.



Exquisite App Icons

The app icons feature gradient color, a level of transparency, and enhanced with mildly stereoscopic effect for exceptional aesthetics and consistency.



Gaussian Blur

Highlight the main task window by blurring the background so the user can focus on what they are up to. Gaussian Blur applies to the dropdown menu, folder, drawer.



Customized Color & Temperature

Support full color temperature management which allows the system to adapt in the overall visual quality. This opens up more ways for you to personalize your device.



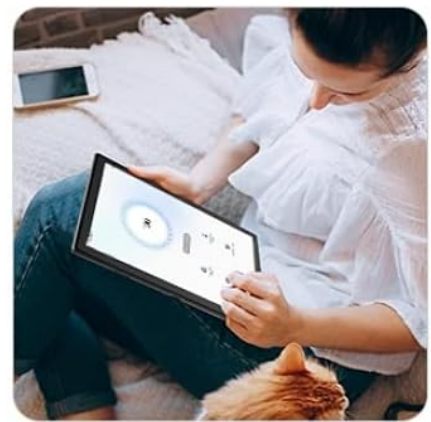
Classy Overall Visual

System Manager

Ensures efficient system performance with System Manager to control over trash cleaning, battery performance, gaming boosting, and how apps run in the background.

1. Open the Camera application from the home screen or app drawer.
2. Select between photo or video mode.
3. Tap the shutter button to capture an image or start/stop video recording.
4. Use the camera switch icon to toggle between the front and rear cameras.

The Android 10 operating system on the Blackview Tab 9 includes several features to enhance user experience.



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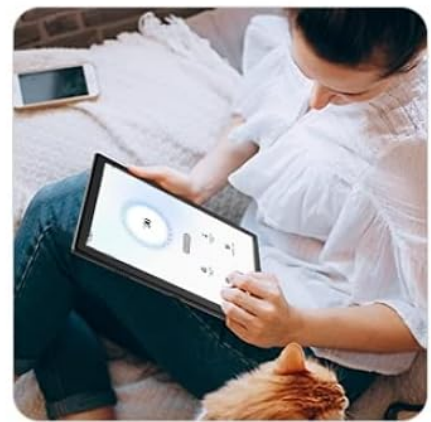

- **Exquisite App Icons:** Enjoy a visually appealing interface with refined app icons.
- **Gaussian Blur:** The system utilizes Gaussian blur to highlight the main task window, improving focus.
- **Customized Color & Temperature:** Adjust display color and temperature settings to personalize your viewing experience.
- **Enhanced Productivity with Notes:** The Notes application supports image and voice recording, text entry, handwriting, and to-do lists.
- **System Manager:** Utilize the built-in System Manager for tasks such as trash cleaning, battery performance monitoring, gaming boosting, and managing app background activity.

5. MAINTENANCE

5.1 Cleaning the Device

- Use a soft, lint-free cloth to clean the screen and body of the tablet.
- For stubborn smudges, slightly dampen the cloth with water or a screen cleaner designed for electronics.
- Avoid using harsh chemicals, abrasive materials, or excessive moisture.

5.2 Battery Care

- Avoid exposing the tablet to extreme temperatures (hot or cold).
- Do not fully discharge the battery frequently. Charge it before it drops below 20%.
- Use only the original charger or a certified compatible charger.

5.3 Software Updates

Regularly check for and install software updates to ensure optimal performance and security.

- Go to Settings > System > System update.
- Follow the on-screen instructions to download and install any available updates.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

6.1 Common Issues and Solutions

Problem	Solution
Tablet does not turn on.	Ensure the battery is charged. Connect the charger and wait a few minutes before attempting to power on again. If unresponsive, perform a forced restart by holding the Power button for 10-15 seconds.
Wi-Fi connection issues.	Restart the tablet and your Wi-Fi router. Forget the network in Wi-Fi settings and reconnect. Ensure you are within range of the Wi-Fi signal.
Apps are crashing or freezing.	Clear the cache and data for the problematic app (Settings > Apps & notifications > [App Name] > Storage & cache). Update the app from the Google Play Store. If the issue persists, uninstall and reinstall the app.
Slow performance.	Close unnecessary background apps. Clear cached data regularly (Settings > Storage). Consider uninstalling unused apps. If performance remains slow, a factory reset might be necessary (back up your data first).

6.2 Factory Reset

A factory reset will erase all data on your tablet and restore it to its original factory settings. Back up all important data before proceeding.

1. Go to Settings > System > Reset options.
2. Select "Erase all data (factory reset)".
3. Confirm your decision and enter your PIN/pattern if prompted.
4. The tablet will restart and begin the reset process.
