1. Introduction

Thank you for purchasing the AT&T GH10 Bluetooth Gaming Headphones. These headphones are designed to provide an immersive audio experience for gaming, featuring 7.1 virtual surround sound, a 50mm driver, and up to 12 hours of play time. This manual provides detailed instructions for setup, operation, and maintenance to ensure optimal performance and longevity of your device.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- Do not expose the headphones to extreme temperatures, humidity, or corrosive environments.
- Avoid dropping or subjecting the headphones to strong impacts.
- Do not attempt to disassemble or modify the headphones. This may void the warranty and cause damage.
- Clean the headphones with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use liquid cleaners.
- Prolonged listening at high volume levels may cause hearing damage. Adjust volume to a safe level.
- Keep out of reach of children.

4. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Familiarize yourself with the various components and controls of your AT&T GH10 headphones.

4.1 Controls and Ports

• Power Button: Press and hold to power on/off. Short press to play/pause audio.

- Mode Button (M): Cycles through different lighting modes on the ear cups.
- Volume Up (+): Increases audio volume.
- Volume Down (-): Decreases audio volume.
- 3.5mm Audio Jack: For wired connection to devices.
- USB-C Charging Port: For charging the headphones.
- **Microphone Port:** For attaching the detachable boom microphone.

5. SETUP

5.1 Charging the Headphones

- 1. Connect the USB charging cable to the USB-C port on the headphones.
- 2. Connect the other end of the cable to a USB power source (e.g., computer USB port, wall adapter).
- 3. The LED indicator will show charging status. A full charge provides up to 12 hours of play time.

5.2 Attaching the Microphone

The boom microphone is detachable for convenience.

- 1. Locate the microphone port on the left ear cup.
- 2. Align the microphone's connector with the port and gently push until it clicks into place.
- 3. To detach, pull the microphone gently from the port.

5.3 Adjusting for Comfort

The AT&T GH10 headphones feature an adjustable headband and premium ear cups for extended comfort.

- Gently extend or retract the headband until the ear cups sit comfortably over your ears.
- Ensure the ear cups fully enclose your ears for optimal sound isolation and comfort.

6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1 Power On/Off

- To power on, press and hold the Power Button until the LED indicator lights up.
- To power off, press and hold the Power Button until the LED indicator turns off.

6.2 Bluetooth Pairing

- 1. Ensure the headphones are powered off.
- 2. Press and hold the Power Button for approximately 5-7 seconds until the LED indicator flashes rapidly (usually blue and red), indicating pairing mode.
- 3. On your device (e.g., PS4, smartphone, PC), go to Bluetooth settings and search for "AT&T GH10".
- 4. Select "AT&T GH10" to connect. The LED indicator will turn solid blue once connected.

6.3 Wired Connection (3.5mm Jack)

For devices without Bluetooth or when battery is low, use the 3.5mm audio cable.

- 1. Connect one end of the 3.5mm audio cable to the 3.5mm jack on the headphones.
- 2. Connect the other end to the 3.5mm audio output of your gaming console (e.g., PS4 controller), PC, or other audio device.
- 3. The headphones will automatically switch to wired mode.

6.4 USB Transmitter (Plug and Play)

For an authentic plug-and-play experience, use the included USB transmitter.

- 1. Plug the USB transmitter into an available USB port on your gaming console or PC.
- 2. Ensure the headphones are powered on and in Bluetooth pairing mode (if not already paired).
- 3. The headphones should automatically connect to the USB transmitter.

6.5 Audio and Microphone Control

- Volume Adjustment: Use the + and buttons on the ear cup to adjust the volume.
- Play/Pause: Short press the Power Button to play or pause audio.
- Microphone Mute: (If applicable, check product for dedicated mute button or function) If no dedicated button, mute
 via connected device settings.

6.6 LED Lighting Modes

The headphones feature 7 varying color alternates on each ear cup.

• Press the M (Mode) button to cycle through the available lighting effects and colors.

7. MAINTENANCE

7.1 Cleaning

- Use a soft, dry, lint-free cloth to clean the surfaces of the headphones.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners, solvents, or chemical sprays.
- For ear cups, gently wipe with a slightly damp cloth if necessary, then dry immediately.

7.2 Storage

- Store the headphones in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- · Avoid placing heavy objects on the headphones.
- If storing for an extended period, ensure the headphones are fully charged to preserve battery health.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No power	Battery is depleted.	Charge the headphones using the provided USB cable.
Cannot pair via Bluetooth	Headphones not in pairing mode; device Bluetooth off; too far from device.	Ensure headphones are in pairing mode (flashing LED). Turn on device Bluetooth. Move headphones closer to device (within 10 meters).
No sound	Volume too low; incorrect audio source selected; headphones not connected.	Increase volume on headphones and connected device. Verify headphones are properly connected (Bluetooth, 3.5mm, or USB transmitter). Check device's audio output settings.
Microphone not working	Microphone not attached correctly; muted; incorrect input device selected.	Ensure the detachable boom microphone is securely attached. Check if the microphone is muted on the headphones or the connected device. Verify the correct microphone input is selected in your device's audio settings.
Poor sound quality	Weak Bluetooth signal; interference; low battery.	Move closer to the connected device. Avoid sources of strong electromagnetic interference. Charge the headphones.
