# WORX WA4301 Extension Pole

## USER MANUAL FOR WG324E MINI CHAINSAW

### 1. Introduction

The WORX WA4301 Extension Pole is designed to extend the reach of your WORX WG324E portable pruning saw or mini chainsaw, allowing you to prune high branches safely and efficiently without the need for a ladder. This manual provides essential information for the safe and effective use of your extension pole.

### 2. Important Safety Instructions

Always observe basic safety precautions when using this product to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and personal injury. Read all instructions carefully before use.

- **Read the Chainsaw Manual:** Before using the extension pole, thoroughly read and understand the user manual for your WORX WG324E mini chainsaw.
- **Wear Personal Protective Equipment (PPE):** Always wear safety glasses, gloves, and appropriate protective clothing when operating the tool.
- **Inspect Before Use:** Check the extension pole and chainsaw for any damage or loose parts before each use. Do not use if damaged.
- **Secure Connection:** Ensure the chainsaw is securely attached to the extension pole before operation.
- **Maintain Balance:** Always maintain proper footing and balance, especially when working at height. Avoid overreaching.
- **Clear Work Area:** Keep the work area clear of bystanders, children, and pets. Be aware of falling branches.
- **Avoid Power Lines:** Never operate near electrical power lines. Contact with power lines can cause serious injury or death.
- **Proper Handling:** Hold the extension pole firmly with both hands during operation.
- **Storage:** Store the extension pole in a dry, secure place out of reach of children.

## 4. Setup and Assembly

---

The WA4301 extension pole is designed for simple and quick installation with your compatible WORX mini chainsaw (WG324E or WG325E) without the need for additional tools.

1. **Prepare the Chainsaw:** Ensure your WORX WG324E mini chainsaw is turned off and the battery is removed before attempting to attach it to the extension pole.
2. **Align the Pole and Chainsaw:** Locate the connection point on the extension pole and the corresponding slot on your mini chainsaw. Align them carefully.
3. **Connect the Chainsaw:** Slide the mini chainsaw onto the extension pole until it clicks securely into place. Ensure there is no wobble or looseness.
4. **Secure the Connection:** If applicable, tighten any locking mechanisms or screws by hand to ensure a stable and secure attachment.
5. **Insert Battery:** Once the chainsaw is securely attached, insert the battery into the designated slot on the extension pole handle. The connection to the chainsaw should be immediate.

The extension pole provides a stable and secure hold for confident work, improving cutting precision even in hard-to-reach areas.

## 5. Operation

---

Once assembled, the extension pole allows you to operate your WORX mini chainsaw for high-altitude pruning tasks.

1. **Grip:** Hold the extension pole firmly with both hands. The lightweight design ensures comfortable and effortless handling.
2. **Positioning:** Position yourself in a stable stance. Extend the pole to reach the desired branch, ensuring you have a clear view of the cutting area.
3. **Cutting:** Activate the chainsaw using the controls on the extension pole handle. Make smooth, controlled cuts. Avoid forcing the saw.
4. **Branch Removal:** Be aware of the direction a cut branch will fall. Ensure the area below is clear.

5. **Post-Operation:** After completing your task, turn off the chainsaw, remove the battery, and disconnect the chainsaw from the extension pole for cleaning and storage.

## 6. Maintenance

---



Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and safe operation of your extension pole.

- **Cleaning:** After each use, wipe down the extension pole with a clean, damp cloth to remove any sap, dirt, or debris. Do not use harsh chemicals.
- **Inspection:** Regularly inspect the pole for any signs of damage, bends, or cracks. Check the connection points for wear.
- **Storage:** Store the extension pole in a dry, cool place, away from direct sunlight and moisture. Ensure it is stored in a way that prevents bending or damage.
- **Lubrication:** No specific lubrication is required for the extension pole itself, but always follow the lubrication guidelines for your mini chainsaw.

## 7. Troubleshooting

If you encounter issues with your WORX WA4301 Extension Pole, refer to the following table:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Chainsaw not connecting securely	Improper alignment; debris in connection; damaged connection point.	Ensure correct alignment. Clean connection points. Inspect for damage; contact support if damaged.
Chainsaw not operating when attached	Battery not inserted correctly; poor electrical contact; chainsaw issue.	Ensure battery is fully inserted. Check for clean contacts. Refer to your chainsaw's manual for troubleshooting.
Pole feels wobbly during use	Chainsaw not fully secured; locking mechanism loose.	Re-check chainsaw attachment. Tighten any locking mechanisms.
