Bagtecs Saddlebags + Plate Compatible with Side Bags XA32

INSTRUCTION MANUAL

Product Overview

The Bagtecs Saddlebag set, model XA32, provides a robust and waterproof storage solution for motorcycles. This set includes two side bags and two mounting plates, designed for installation on existing pannier racks. Each bag offers a generous capacity of 32 liters, totaling 64 liters for the pair. Constructed from durable Tarpaulin material, these saddlebags are waterproof, UV resistant, and easy to clean, ensuring your belongings remain protected in various weather conditions.

The unique design allows the saddlebags to be mounted directly onto the included plates, enabling independent attachment and removal. This universal article is compatible with pannier racks from most manufacturers, including Bagtecs, Givi, SHAD, SW-Motech, Touratech, and Hepco-Becker. When not in use, the bags can be folded flat for convenient storage.

Setup and Installation

Installation of the Bagtacs saddlebags requires an existing pannier rack on your motorcycle. The included mounting plates serve as the interface between the saddlebags and your motorcycle's rack.

1. **Prepare Your Motorcycle:** Ensure your motorcycle's pannier rack is securely installed and free from obstructions. The pannier rack is not included with this product and must be acquired separately or be pre-existing.
2. **Attach Mounting Plates:** Secure the two mounting plates (one for each side) to your motorcycle's pannier rack. The plates feature multiple attachment points to accommodate various rack designs. Use appropriate hardware (not included) to ensure a rigid and stable connection.

3. **Mount Saddlebags:** Once the plates are securely attached, align the saddlebags with the corresponding mounting plates. The saddlebags are designed to clip or strap directly onto the plates. Ensure all straps and buckles are fastened tightly to prevent movement during transit.

4. **Verify Security:** Before riding, gently pull on each saddlebag to confirm it is firmly attached to the mounting plate and the plate to the pannier rack. Loose bags can pose a safety hazard.

Important Note: This is a universal product. While designed for broad compatibility, minor adjustments may be required for optimal fit on certain motorcycle models. Always refer to the dimensions provided in the specifications section to ensure suitability for your specific motorcycle and pannier rack.

Operation

Using your Bagtects saddlebags is straightforward.

- **Loading:** Open the roll-top closure of each bag. Distribute weight evenly within the bags to maintain motorcycle balance. Avoid overloading beyond the stated capacity of 32 liters per bag.
- **Securing Contents:** After loading, roll down the top closure tightly and secure it with the integrated buckles. This creates a waterproof seal. Use the external compression straps to cinch down the bags and prevent contents from shifting.

- **Removing Bags:** The saddlebags can be quickly detached from the mounting plates when you reach your destination or need to carry them off the motorcycle. Simply unfasten the attachment points from the plates.
- **Folding for Storage:** When empty, the saddlebags can be folded flat. This feature makes them convenient for storage in small spaces or when not in use on the motorcycle.

Care and Maintenance

Proper care will extend the lifespan of your Bagtecs saddlebags.

- **Cleaning:** The Tarpaulin material is designed for easy cleaning. Wipe down the exterior with a damp cloth and mild soap if necessary. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners, which can damage the material.
- **Drying:** After cleaning or exposure to rain, ensure the bags are thoroughly dry before folding and storing to prevent mildew or odor.
- **Storage:** Store the saddlebags in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight when not in use. Folding them flat helps save space.
- **Inspection:** Periodically inspect all straps, buckles, and seams for signs of wear or damage. Address any issues promptly to maintain the integrity and waterproof properties of the bags.

Troubleshooting

If you encounter issues with your Bagtecs saddlebags, consider the following:







- **Bags do not fit my motorcycle:** Verify the dimensions of the saddlebags and mounting plates against your motorcycle's pannier rack. As a universal article, some adjustments or specific rack types may be required for optimal fit. Consult your motorcycle's manual or a professional if unsure.
- **Water leakage:** Ensure the roll-top closure is rolled down at least three times and all buckles are securely fastened. Check for any punctures or tears in the Tarpaulin material.
- **Bags are unstable during riding:** Confirm that the mounting plates are rigidly attached to the pannier rack and that the saddlebags are securely fastened to the plates. Ensure weight is distributed evenly within the bags.
