1. INTRODUCTION AND OVERVIEW

The Baby Jogger City Select 2 Stroller is a versatile modular stroller designed to adapt to your growing family. It can be configured as a single stroller, or expanded to accommodate two or even three children with additional accessories (sold separately). This manual provides essential information for the safe and effective use of your stroller.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

WARNING: Failure to follow these instructions could result in serious injury or death.

- Always use the 5-point harness system to secure your child in the stroller.
- Never leave your child unattended in the stroller.
- Ensure the stroller is fully unfolded and locked before placing a child inside.
- Do not exceed the maximum weight recommendation of 45 pounds per seat.
- Do not hang bags or other items on the handle, as this can cause the stroller to tip over.
- Engage the parking brake when the stroller is stationary.
- Keep children clear of moving parts when folding or unfolding the stroller.
- This product meets ASTM and REACH safety standards.

3. COMPONENTS (WHAT'S IN THE BOX)

Upon unpacking, please ensure all components are present:

- Stroller frame
- 1 seat with canopy
- Belly bar

Additional accessories such as a second seat, infant car seat, or glider board are sold separately.

4. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

4.1 Unfolding the Stroller

1. Place the folded stroller on a flat surface.
2. Release the folding latch.
3. Lift the handlebar until the frame locks into place. You should hear an audible click.

4.2 Attaching the Seat

1. Align the seat mounts with the corresponding slots on the stroller frame.
2. Push down firmly until the seat clicks securely into place. Verify the seat is locked by pulling upwards.

4.3 Adjusting the Handlebar

The telescoping handlebar can be adjusted to multiple heights for comfortable pushing. Press the buttons on either side of the handlebar and extend or retract to your desired position, then release the buttons to lock.

5. OPERATING THE STROLLER

5.1 Securing Your Child

Always use the 5-point harness system. Adjust the shoulder straps and waist straps to fit snugly around your child. Ensure the buckle is securely fastened.

5.2 Adjusting Seat Recline

The seat offers multiple recline positions. Locate the recline lever or strap mechanism behind the seat and adjust to your child's comfort. Ensure the seat is securely locked in the desired position.

5.3 Engaging the Brake

The parking brake is located near the rear wheels. Push down on the brake pedal to engage and lift up to release. Always engage the brake when the stroller is stationary.

5.4 Folding the Stroller

The City Select 2 features a one-step compact fold. Follow these steps:

1. Ensure the seat is facing forward and in an upright position.
2. Locate the folding straps or handles on the seat.
3. Pull the straps upwards firmly until the stroller frame collapses.
4. Secure the folding latch to keep the stroller in its compact state.

5.5 Storage Basket Usage

The large under-seat storage basket provides ample space for essentials. Do not exceed the recommended weight limit for the basket to maintain stroller stability.

5.6 Travel System Compatibility

The stroller can be converted into a travel system by adding a compatible infant car seat with appropriate adapters (sold separately). Refer to the car seat and adapter manuals for specific installation instructions.

6. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

6.1 Cleaning Instructions

The fabric components, including the canopy and seat, are made with soft, breathable TENCEL fabric. They can be machine washed or hand washed. Always refer to the care label on the fabric for specific instructions. The frame and plastic parts can be wiped clean with a damp cloth and mild soap.

6.2 Wheel Maintenance

The stroller is equipped with never-flat wheels and all-terrain tires, requiring minimal maintenance. Periodically check wheels for debris and ensure they spin freely. Lubricate axles if necessary with a silicone-based lubricant.

6.3 General Care

Store the stroller in a dry, cool place away from direct sunlight to prevent fabric fading and material degradation. Regularly inspect all parts for wear and tear, loose fasteners, or damaged components. Do not use if any part is damaged.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Stroller difficult to fold:** Ensure the seat is in the correct position and all accessories are removed. Check for any obstructions in the folding mechanism.

- **Wheels not turning smoothly:** Inspect wheels for debris (e.g., hair, dirt) and remove. Ensure axles are clean and lubricated.
- **Stroller pulls to one side:** Check tire pressure (if applicable, though these are never-flat) and ensure wheels are properly aligned and free of obstructions.
- **Harness difficult to buckle/unbuckle:** Ensure no fabric is caught in the buckle. Clean the buckle if necessary.
