This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the safe and effective use and maintenance of your Zippo Windproof Lighter, model Taurus #Z506. Please read all instructions carefully before initial use.



Important Safety Information

- **WARNING: Keep out of the reach of children.**
- The lighter is not child resistant.
- Ignite lighter away from face and clothing.
- All new Zippo Windproof Lighters are empty and must be filled before use.
- When filled, it will contain flammable fluid.
- Never expose to heat above 122°F (50°C) or to prolonged sunlight.
- Never puncture or put in fire.
- Be sure flame is out after use. This lighter does not self-extinguish; close the cover to put it out.
- Fuel is a skin irritant; avoid overfilling.

SETUP: FILLING YOUR ZIPPO LIGHTER

Your Zippo lighter is shipped without fuel for safety reasons. It must be filled with Zippo lighter fluid before use. Always use genuine Zippo fluid, flints, and wicks for optimal performance and safety.

1. Hold the lighter in one hand. Use the other hand to remove the lighter insert (the inner unit).
2. Lift the felt pad on the bottom of the insert to reveal the packing material in the fuel chamber.
3. Slowly saturate the packing material with Zippo lighter fluid. Stop filling when the fuel reaches the top of the packing material. Do not overfill.
4. Wipe any spilled fluid from the lighter and your hands before igniting. Return the lighter insert into the case.

5. Ensure the fuel can is closed and there is no spilled fuel in the vicinity before igniting.

If fuel gets on skin, wash the affected area. If irritation persists or worsens, consult a doctor.

**NOTE :Zippo Lighter doesnt come pre filled with fluid.Lighter fluid sold separately.

To fill your Zippo lighter

- Fill only with Zippo fluid.
- Hold lighter in one hand. Use the other hand to remove lighter insert (1).
- Fill slowly, never overfill. Lift felt pad to reveal the packing material in the fuel chamber (2). Saturate the packing with Zippo lighter fluid. Stop filling when fuel reaches top of packing. If overfilled it can leak fuel. Fuel is a skin irritant.
- Wipe lighter and hands dry before igniting. Return lighter insert into case. If overfilled, do not put in pocket or next to skin. If fuel gets on skin, wash the affected area. If irritation persists or worsens, see a Doctor.
- Be sure fuel can is closed and there is no spilled fuel in vicinity before igniting. This is flammable fluid.

To re-flint your Zippo lighter




Remove screw (3) and attached spring at end of fuel chamber. Be sure old flint is removed from tube. Place new flint in tube and replace spring, screw lightly. Be sure screw is turned as far as it will go; if not, cover will not close properly. If wheel binds after new flint is inserted, turn wheel backwards a few times.

Wick Maintenance

When wick becomes black from carbon, pull it up with tweezers until clean wick appears (approx. 1 cm), then trim the end making it even with the chimney height. Perform this maintenance 1 or 2 times a year. It will be necessary to replace the wick after it has been trimmed more than 2 or 3 times. For more information visit the website listed.

Always use genuine Zippo fluid, flints and wicks.

Zippo lighter fluid is specially formulated for Zippo windproof lighters. It is clean burning, quick lighting, and long lasting.

OPERATING YOUR ZIPPO LIGHTER

Once your Zippo lighter is properly fueled, it is ready for use.

1. Open the lighter's lid.
2. With your thumb, firmly strike the flint wheel downwards to create a spark.
3. The spark will ignite the wick, producing a flame.
4. To extinguish the flame, simply close the lid. The Zippo lighter does not self-extinguish.

Always ensure the flame is completely extinguished before storing the lighter.

MAINTENANCE

Wick Maintenance

When the wick becomes black from carbon, pull it up with tweezers until clean wick appears (approximately 1 cm). Trim the end, making sure it is even with the chimney height. Perform this maintenance once or twice a year. It will be necessary to replace the wick after it has been trimmed two or three times.

Flint Replacement

1. Remove the lighter insert from the case.
2. Unscrew the flint spring from the bottom of the insert.
3. Remove the old flint and insert a new Zippo flint.
4. Replace the flint spring and screw. Ensure the screw is turned as far as it will go; if not, the cover will not close properly. If the wheel binds after the new flint is inserted, turn the wheel backwards a few times to free it.

ANATOMY




Image: An exploded view diagram illustrating the various components of a Zippo Windproof Lighter, including the wick, flint wheel, fuel chamber, and flint spring.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Lighter not igniting:** Ensure the lighter is filled with Zippo lighter fluid and that the flint is not worn down. Replace flint if necessary.
- **Weak flame:** Check the wick. If it's black or too short, trim or replace it. Ensure the lighter is adequately fueled.
- **Lid not closing properly:** Check for any obstructions or ensure the flint spring is fully screwed in.


