INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the safe assembly, operation, and maintenance of your Inter Link Bunk Bed. Designed for durability and safety, this solid wood bunk bed is a versatile sleeping solution for children and teenagers. Please read these instructions carefully before assembly and retain them for future reference. The Inter Link Bunk Bed is certified according to **EN 747-1 and EN 747-2:2007** safety standards, ensuring a high level of safety and quality.

SAFETY INFORMATION

- The intended age group for the upper bed is **from 6 years and older**.
- When using the upper bed, be aware of the danger of falling, especially for toddlers under 6 years of age.
- To prevent strangulation hazards, ensure that no knitting, cords, ropes, or similar items are attached to the bed that could pose a risk to your child.
- Regularly check all bolts and connections to ensure they remain tight and secure.
- Do not allow jumping on the bed.
- Ensure the room is well-lit when using the ladder.
- The maximum recommended weight for the bed is **275 pounds (approximately 125 kg)**.

PACKAGE CONTENTS

Your Inter Link Bunk Bed is delivered disassembled in two boxes. Please verify that all components listed below are present before beginning assembly.

- 1 x Bunk Bed Frame (disassembled components)
- 2 x Slatted Bed Bases

- 1 x Ladder
- Assembly Accessories (screws, dowels, etc.)
- Illustrated Assembly Instructions Manual

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Assembly of the Inter Link Bunk Bed requires two people for optimal ease and safety. Follow the detailed, illustrated steps provided in the separate assembly instructions manual included in your package.

General Assembly Tips:

- Clear a spacious area for assembly to avoid damaging components or other furniture.
- Lay out all components and hardware before starting to ensure everything is present.
- Use a soft cloth or carpet to protect parts from scratches during assembly.
- While a screwdriver can be used, a power drill with appropriate bits will significantly speed up the assembly process.
- Do not fully tighten all screws until the entire frame is assembled and aligned. Then, tighten all connections securely.

OPERATING AND USAGE

- **Bunk Bed Configuration:** Use as a traditional bunk bed with one bed positioned above the other, ideal for saving space.
- **Convertible Design:** This bunk bed can also be separated and used as two individual single beds, offering flexibility as needs change.
- **Ladder Use:** Always use the provided ladder for safe access to the upper bunk. Ensure the ladder is securely attached before use.
- **Mattress Compatibility:** The bed is designed for mattresses of size 90x200 cm. Ensure the mattress thickness for the upper bunk allows for sufficient safety rail height.

MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance will ensure the longevity and continued safety of your Inter Link Bunk Bed.

- **Cleaning:** The bed features a water-repellent, lacquered surface that is easy to clean. Wipe down surfaces with a **damp cloth**, then immediately dry with a **dry cloth** to prevent water marks or damage. Avoid abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals.
- **Regular Checks:** Periodically inspect all screws, bolts, and connections to ensure they are tight. Re-tighten if necessary to maintain stability and safety.
- **Wood Care:** As solid wood is a natural product, minor variations in grain, color, and natural knots may occur. These are characteristics of authentic wood and not defects. Avoid placing the bed in direct sunlight or near heat sources to prevent warping or cracking.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your Inter Link Bunk Bed, please refer to the following common solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Bed feels wobbly or unstable.	Loose connections or incorrect assembly.	Ensure all bolts and screws are fully tightened. Refer to the assembly manual to confirm all steps were followed correctly.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Missing or damaged parts upon delivery.	Shipping damage or packing error.	Do not proceed with assembly. Contact Inter Link customer support immediately with details of the missing/damaged parts.
Difficulty assembling components.	Misalignment or incorrect orientation of parts.	Double-check the illustrated assembly instructions. Ensure parts are oriented correctly before attempting to force them together. Loosen previously tightened screws if necessary to allow for adjustment.
