INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the operation and maintenance of your Dxyiitoo Full HD WiFi Bluetooth Projector with Built-in DVD Player. Designed for versatile home entertainment, this projector supports a wide range of input sources and offers advanced connectivity features for an immersive viewing experience. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the product to ensure proper setup and optimal performance.

WHAT'S IN THE BOX

Upon opening the package, please verify that all the following components are included:

- Dxyiitoo Projector
- HDMI cable
- Remote control
- AV cable
- Power adapter
- Tripod

SETUP

1. Physical Placement

Place the projector on a stable, flat surface. For optimal viewing, position the projector perpendicular to a flat, light-colored wall or projection screen. The projector can display an image size ranging from 39 inches to a maximum of 250 inches diagonally. Adjust the distance from the screen to achieve your desired image size.

2. Power Connection

Connect the provided power adapter to the projector's power input port and then plug it into a standard electrical outlet. The power indicator light will illuminate.

3. Focus Adjustment

After powering on the projector, rotate the focus ring located near the lens until the projected image appears sharp and clear. If the image appears trapezoidal, adjust the keystone correction to square the image.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Basic Operation

Press the power button on the projector or remote control to turn the unit on or off. Use the navigation buttons on the projector or remote to access and select options within the on-screen menu.

2. Input Sources

The projector supports multiple input sources. Connect your devices to the corresponding ports:

- **HDMI:** For connecting laptops, gaming consoles (PS4, Switch, Xbox), TV sticks, and other HDMI-enabled devices.
- **USB:** For playing media files directly from USB drives.
- **AV:** For connecting older devices using the included AV cable.
- **Micro SD:** For playing media files from Micro SD cards.
- **VGA:** For connecting desktop PCs.

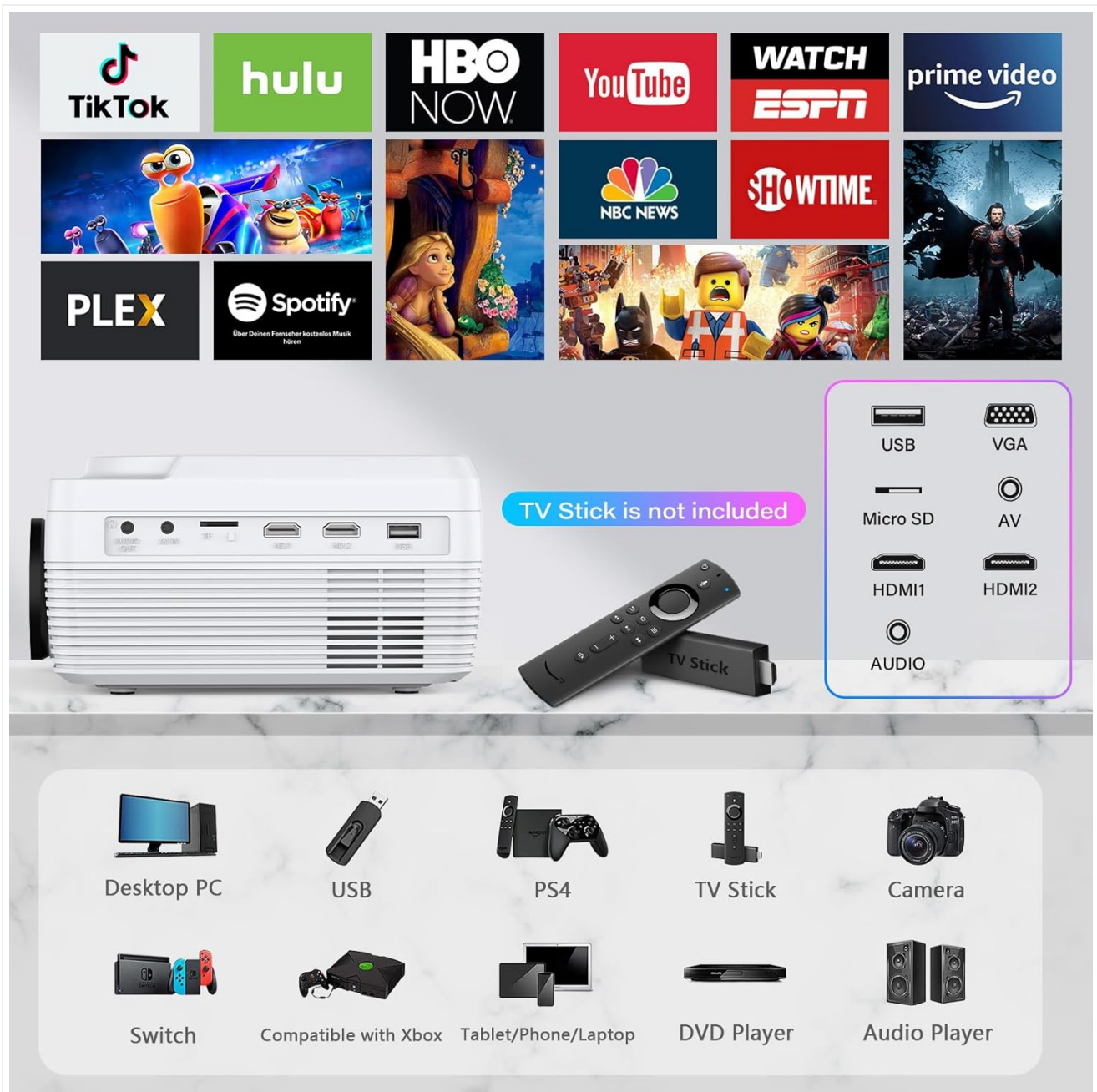

3. Built-in DVD Player

The projector features an integrated DVD player. Simply insert your disc into the slot on top of the projector. It supports CD, DVD, CD-R/RW, DVD -R/+R, DVD+RW/-RW, VCD, and SVCD formats. **Note: Blu-ray discs are not supported.**

4. WiFi & Screen Mirroring

Connect your smartphone or tablet wirelessly using the WiFi function. The projector supports "Airplay" for iOS devices and "Screen Mirroring" (Miracast/DLNA) for Android devices. This allows you to project content from your mobile device.

- **Airplay (iOS):** Use this function to stream video content from apps on your iPhone or iPad while still being able to use your phone for other tasks.
- **Screen Mirroring (Android/iOS):** This function duplicates your device's screen onto the projection, showing all operations in real-time.

Important Note: Due to copyright protection (HDCP), some streaming services like Netflix, Amazon Prime Video, Hulu, and Disney+ may not allow screen mirroring directly from your phone or tablet. For these services, it is recommended to use an HDMI-connected TV stick (e.g., Fire TV Stick, Roku) or a laptop.

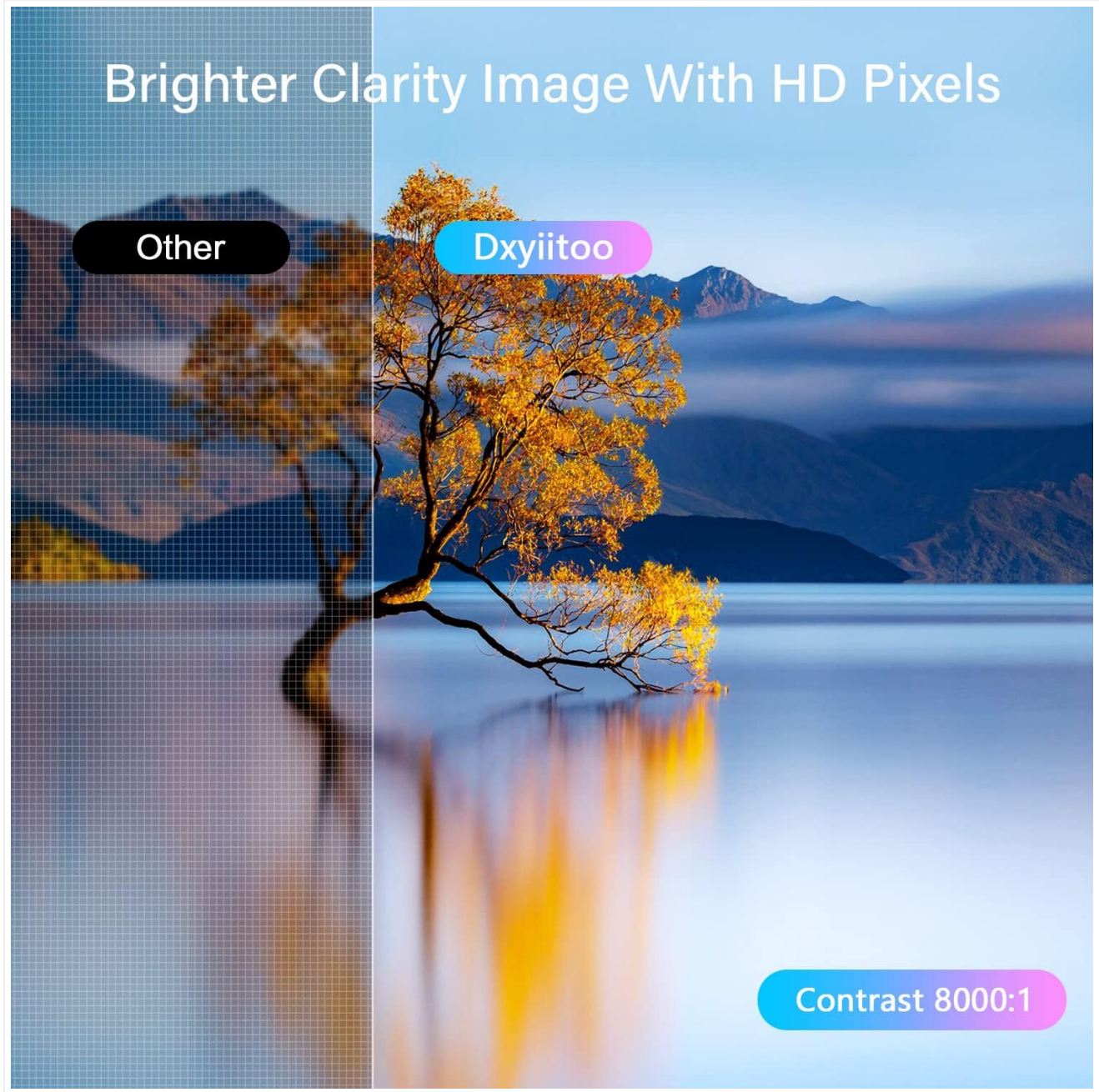


Image: A visual comparison illustrating the superior brightness and clarity of the Dxyiitoo projector's image quality, emphasizing its high contrast ratio.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause / Solution
No Power	Ensure the power adapter is securely connected to both the projector and a working electrical outlet. Check the power indicator light.
No Image / Blank Screen	Verify the correct input source is selected. Check all cable connections (HDMI, AV, USB). Ensure the lens cap is removed.
Blurry Image	Adjust the focus ring until the image is sharp. If the image is distorted (trapezoidal), use the keystone correction feature. Ensure the projector is at an appropriate distance from the screen.

Problem	Possible Cause / Solution
No Audio / Low Volume	Increase the volume on the projector and the connected device. If using external speakers, ensure they are properly connected via Bluetooth or 3.5mm jack and are powered on.
Screen Mirroring Issues	Ensure both the projector and your mobile device are connected to the same WiFi network. Some streaming apps (Netflix, Hulu, Disney+) may block mirroring due to copyright protection; use an HDMI streaming stick instead.
DVD Not Playing	Ensure the disc is clean and free of scratches. Verify the disc format is supported (Blu-ray discs are not supported). Reinsert the disc.

- **Disc Care:** Keep DVDs and CDs clean and free of scratches to ensure smooth playback and prevent damage to the built-in DVD player.
