1. OVERVIEW

The UGREEN USB to Ethernet Adapter is a versatile 5-in-1 USB hub designed to expand connectivity for your devices. It provides a stable wired network connection via its Gigabit Ethernet port and adds three high-speed USB 3.0 ports for connecting various peripherals. An additional USB-C power port ensures stable performance for high-power devices.

2. PRODUCT FEATURES

- **5-in-1 USB Ethernet Hub:** Equipped with a Gigabit Ethernet port and 3 x USB 3.0 ports for expanded connectivity.
- **1000Mbps High-Speed Network:** Provides up to 1000Mbps network speed for stable uploads, downloads, online gaming, and HD video streaming.
- **Plug and Play:** No driver installation required for Windows 11/10/8.1, macOS, and Chrome OS. Drivers may be required for Windows XP/7/8/Vista and Linux.
- **Up to 5Gbps Data Transfer:** USB 3.0 ports offer data sync speeds up to 5Gbps, 10x faster than USB 2.0, for connecting mice, keyboards, hard drives, and more.
- **USB-C Power Supply for Peripherals:** An extra Type-C power supply port provides stable power for high-power devices like external hard drives (does not charge host devices).

3. SETUP

1. **Connect to Computer:** Connect the USB-A connector of the UGREEN hub to an available USB port on your computer (laptop, desktop, MacBook, XPS, etc.).
2. **Connect Ethernet Cable:** For wired network access, connect an Ethernet cable from your router or modem to the Gigabit RJ45 port on the UGREEN hub.
3. **Connect USB Peripherals:** Connect your USB peripherals (mouse, keyboard, flash drives, external hard drives) to the available USB 3.0 ports.
4. **Optional Power Supply:** If connecting high-power devices, connect a USB-C power adapter (not included) to the USB-C power port on the hub to ensure stable operation.
5. **Driver Installation:** For Windows 11/10/8.1, macOS, and Chrome OS, the device is plug and play and no

drivers are typically needed. For Windows XP/7/8/Vista and Linux, driver installation may be required. Refer to the included user instruction leaflet for detailed driver installation steps if necessary.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once connected, the UGREEN USB to Ethernet Adapter functions automatically. The Gigabit Ethernet port will provide a stable wired internet connection. The USB 3.0 ports are ready for data transfer and connecting various USB devices. The USB-C power port is solely for providing additional power to the hub for connected high-power peripherals, not for charging your host device.

5. MAINTENANCE

Keep the adapter clean and free from dust. Use a soft, dry cloth for cleaning. Avoid exposing the device to extreme temperatures, humidity, or direct sunlight. Disconnect the adapter when not in use, especially when transporting your laptop, to prevent damage to the ports.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

No Internet Connection:

- Ensure the Ethernet cable is securely connected to both the hub and your router/modem.
- Check your computer's network settings to confirm the wired connection is active.
- Restart your computer and network equipment (router/modem).
- If using Windows XP/7/8/Vista or Linux, ensure the correct drivers are installed.

USB Devices Not Recognized/Unstable:

- Ensure the USB devices are properly inserted into the USB 3.0 ports.
- If connecting high-power devices (e.g., external hard drives), ensure a USB-C power adapter is connected to the hub's power port.
- Try connecting the USB device directly to your computer to rule out device issues.
- Restart your computer.
