1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The MediaCom MCI SB01 is a versatile Bluetooth soundbar designed to enhance your audio experience. It features an elegant wooden casing and comes equipped with dual microphone inputs, making it suitable for various entertainment and communication needs. With multiple connectivity options, it seamlessly integrates with a wide range of devices.

Key Features:

- Elegant wooden casing for enhanced aesthetics and sound quality.
- Two dedicated microphone inputs for karaoke or public speaking.
- 30W RMS output power for clear and robust audio.
- Bluetooth connectivity for wireless streaming from smartphones, tablets, and laptops.
- Multiple input options: Bluetooth, Optical, SD card, and AUX (RCA/3.5mm).
- Universal compatibility with various television models.

4. SETUP

4.1 Connecting the Soundbar

Choose one of the following methods to connect your soundbar to a TV or other audio source:

- 1. **Optical Connection:** For the best audio quality, connect an optical cable (not always included) from your TV's Optical Out port to the soundbar's Optical In port. Select 'Optical' input on the soundbar.
- 2. **AUX (RCA/3.5mm) Connection:** Use an AUX cable to connect your TV's Audio Out (RCA L/R or 3.5mm headphone jack) to the soundbar's AUX In port. Select 'AUX' input on the soundbar.
- 3. **Bluetooth Connection:** Power on the soundbar and switch to Bluetooth mode. On your device (smartphone, tablet, laptop), enable Bluetooth and search for 'MCI SB01'. Pair with the soundbar.
- 4. **SD Card:** Insert an SD card with audio files into the designated slot on the soundbar. The soundbar will automatically switch to SD card mode and begin playback.

4.2 Powering On

Connect the power adapter to the soundbar's DC input and then to a wall outlet. Press the Power button on the soundbar or remote control to turn it on.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Basic Controls

- Power Button: Turns the soundbar on or off.
- Input/Mode Button: Cycles through available input modes (Bluetooth, Optical, AUX, SD).
- Volume Up/Down: Adjusts the master volume level.
- Play/Pause: Controls playback in Bluetooth or SD card mode.
- Previous/Next Track: Skips to the previous or next track in Bluetooth or SD card mode.

5.2 Using Microphones

Connect the wired microphones to the designated microphone input jacks on the soundbar. Adjust the microphone volume using the dedicated controls on the soundbar or remote (if available). Ensure the soundbar's main volume is set to a comfortable listening level before using the microphones.

6. MAINTENANCE

Proper care ensures the longevity of your soundbar:

- Cleaning: Wipe the soundbar with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use liquid cleaners or aerosol sprays.
- Storage: If storing for an extended period, disconnect from power and store in a cool, dry place.
- Avoid Obstructions: Do not place objects on top of the soundbar that could block the speakers or ventilation.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No power	Power cable not connected; outlet not working	Ensure power cable is securely connected. Try a different power outlet.
No sound	Incorrect input mode; volume too low; cable issues	Select the correct input mode. Increase volume. Check audio cables for secure connection.
Bluetooth pairing failed	Soundbar not in pairing mode; device too far	Ensure soundbar is in Bluetooth mode and discoverable. Move device closer to soundbar.
Microphone not working	Microphone not connected; microphone volume low	Ensure microphone is fully plugged in. Increase microphone volume.
