1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation of your ZOKOP 18-Bottle Compressor Wine Cooler Refrigerator. Please read these instructions thoroughly before installation and use, and retain them for future reference. This appliance is designed to store wine at optimal temperatures, ensuring its quality and flavor are preserved.

The ZOKOP wine cooler features compressor technology for stable temperature control, a digital touchscreen for easy adjustments, and soft LED interior lighting. It is designed to hold up to 18 standard Bordeaux bottles.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

To reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, or injury when using your appliance, follow these basic precautions:

- Read all instructions before using the appliance.
- Do not touch cold surfaces immediately after the unit has been plugged in.
- Ensure the appliance is properly grounded.
- Do not use mechanical devices or other means to accelerate the defrosting process, other than those recommended by the manufacturer.
- Do not damage the refrigerant circuit.
- Do not use electrical appliances inside the food storage compartments of the appliance, unless they are of the type recommended by the manufacturer.

- Unplug the appliance before cleaning or performing any maintenance.
- Keep ventilation openings, in the appliance enclosure or in the built-in structure, clear of obstruction.
- This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.

4. PRODUCT FEATURES

Your ZOKOP wine cooler incorporates several features designed for optimal wine preservation:

- **Compressor Refrigeration:** Provides rapid and stable cooling, maintaining consistent temperatures.
- **Circulation Air System:** Ensures cold air is distributed evenly throughout the cabinet for balanced cooling.
- **Digital Temperature Control:** An easy-to-use external touchscreen allows precise temperature adjustments without opening the door.
- **Temperature Range:** Adjustable from 41°F to 64°F (5°C to 18°C).
- **Low Noise Operation:** Designed for quiet performance.
- **Chrome Plated Metal Shelves:** Durable and aesthetically pleasing shelves securely hold bottles.
- **LED Soft Light:** Energy-efficient interior lighting illuminates your collection without affecting wine quality.
- **Adjustable Feet:** Allows for easy leveling and balancing of the unit.
- **220° Large Opening Angle:** The door hinge design provides wide access to your wine collection.
- **Air-Tight Seal:** Ensures constant temperature and humidity for maintaining wine freshness.

5. SETUP

5.1 Placement

This appliance is designed for freestanding installation only. Do not recess or build it into a cabinet. Allow at least 5 inches (12.7 cm) of space between the back and sides of the cooler and any adjacent walls to ensure proper air circulation. Place the unit on a flat, solid surface strong enough to support it when fully loaded.

5.2 Leveling the Appliance

It is important for the appliance to be level to function correctly. You can adjust the leveling feet located at the bottom of the unit. Turn the leveling feet clockwise to raise the unit or counter-clockwise to lower it.

5.3 Initial Cleaning

Before first use, clean the interior and exterior of the wine cooler with a soft cloth and mild detergent. Rinse thoroughly and wipe dry.

5.4 Power Connection

Plug the appliance into a dedicated, grounded 115V / 60Hz electrical outlet. Do not use extension cords or adapters.

6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1 Powering On/Off

Once plugged in, the unit will power on. Use the power button on the external touch panel to turn the unit on or off.

6.2 Temperature Adjustment

The temperature can be adjusted using the digital touchscreen controls located on the exterior of the glass door. Press the 'Up' or 'Down' arrows to set your desired temperature within the range of 41°F to 64°F (5°C to 18°C). The LED display will show the current internal temperature.

6.3 Internal Lighting

Press the light button on the control panel to turn the interior LED light on or off. This allows you to view your wine collection without disturbing the internal temperature.

6.4 Loading Bottles

Carefully place wine bottles onto the chrome-plated shelves. Ensure bottles are stable and do not obstruct the door from closing completely. The unit is designed to hold up to 18 standard Bordeaux-sized bottles.

7. TEMPERATURE CONTROL FOR WINE TYPES

Different types of wine benefit from specific storage temperatures. The ZOKOP wine cooler allows you to customize the temperature to suit your collection:

- **Champagne & Sparkling Wine:** 41-48°F (5-9°C)
- **White Wine:** 48-57°F (9-14°C)
- **Semi-Sweet & Sweet Red Wine:** 57-61°F (14-16°C)
- **Beers & Sodas:** 41-64°F (5-18°C)

8. MAINTENANCE

8.1 Cleaning the Interior

Unplug the unit before cleaning. Wash the interior with a mild detergent and warm water solution. Use a soft cloth or sponge. Do not use abrasive cleaners. Rinse thoroughly and dry completely before plugging the unit back in.

8.2 Cleaning the Exterior

Clean the exterior with a soft cloth and mild detergent. For the glass door, use a glass cleaner. Avoid getting water on the control panel or electrical components.

8.3 Defrosting

This appliance features a frost-free defrost system, minimizing the need for manual defrosting. If ice buildup occurs, unplug the unit and allow the ice to melt naturally. Wipe away excess water.

8.4 Power Outage

In case of a power outage, the wine cooler will generally maintain its temperature for several hours if the door

remains closed. Avoid opening the door unnecessarily during an outage.

8.5 Moving the Appliance

Before moving, remove all bottles and secure the shelves. Turn off and unplug the unit. Transport the appliance in an upright position if possible. After moving, allow the unit to stand upright for at least 2-4 hours before plugging it back in to allow the refrigerant to settle.

9. TROUBLESHOOTING

Review the following common issues and solutions before contacting customer support:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Appliance does not operate	Not plugged in; Circuit breaker tripped; Temperature set too high.	Ensure plug is secure; Reset circuit breaker; Lower the set temperature.
Temperature is not cold enough	Door not closed properly; Frequent door openings; Poor ventilation; Excessive items inside.	Check door seal; Reduce door openings; Ensure adequate space around unit; Do not overfill.
Vibrations	Appliance not level.	Adjust the leveling feet.
Noise	Normal compressor operation; Loose parts.	Some noise is normal; Check for loose items inside or around the unit.
Moisture buildup on glass door	High humidity; Frequent door openings.	This is normal in humid conditions; Reduce door openings.


