

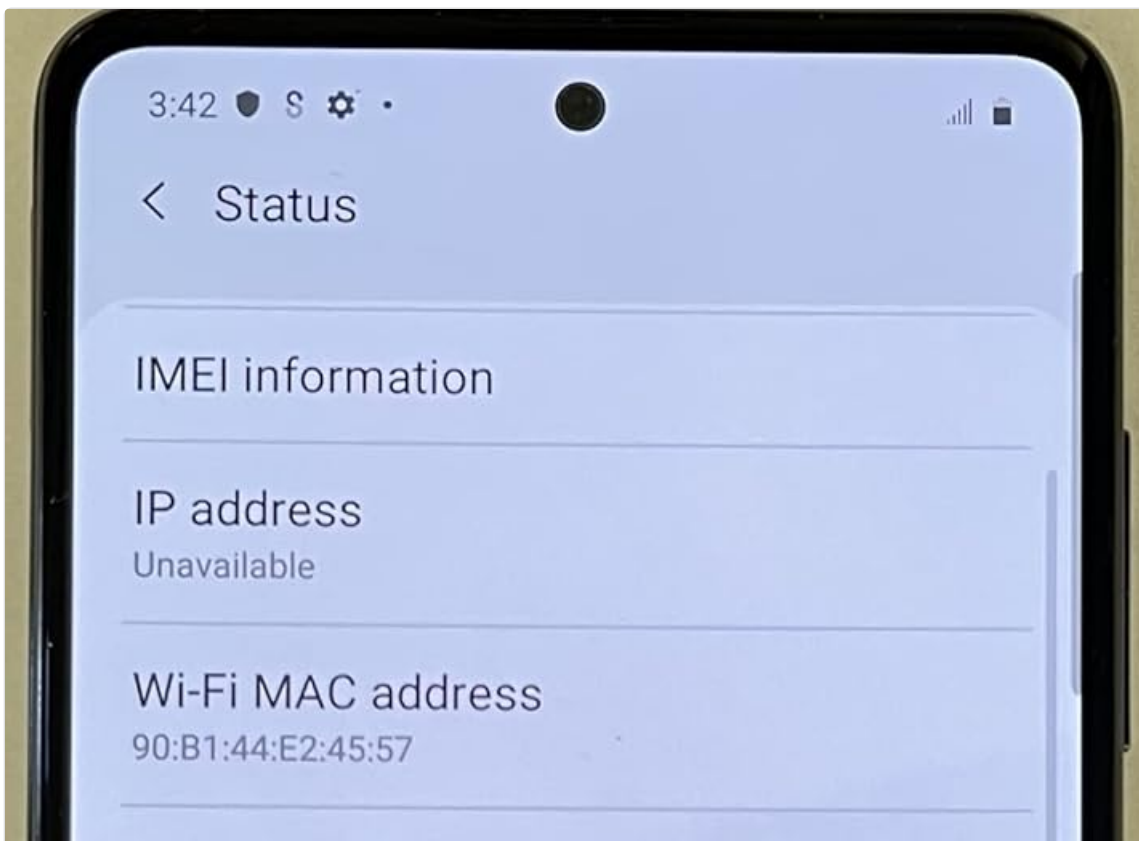

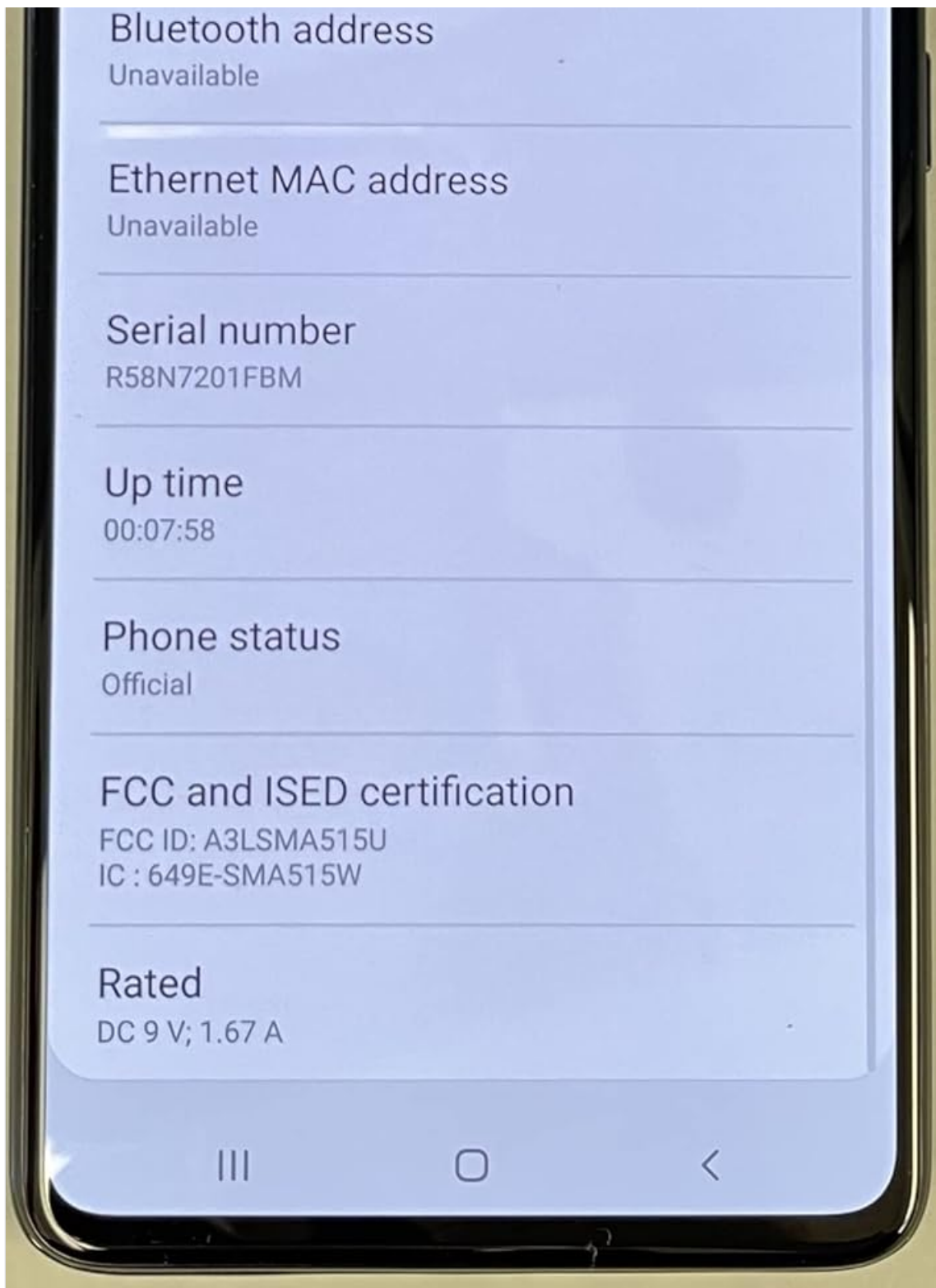


Image: Samsung Galaxy A51 smartphone on a wooden desk.

## 3. SETUP

### 3.1 What's in the Box

Your Samsung Galaxy A51 package typically includes:

- Samsung Galaxy A51 Smartphone
- Charger

### 3.2 SIM Card Installation

To install your Nano SIM card(s) and/or microSD card:

1. Locate the SIM tray on the side of the device.
2. Insert the SIM ejection tool into the small hole next to the tray to open it.
3. Place your Nano SIM card(s) and/or microSD card into the designated slots on the tray.
4. Carefully reinsert the tray into the device.

- **More Modes:** Explore additional modes like Pro, Single Take, Night, Food, Panorama, Macro, Super Slow-Mo, Slow Motion, and Hyperlapse for various creative effects.

## 5. MAINTENANCE

### 5.1 Battery Management

The Galaxy A51 is equipped with a 4000 mAh Lithium-Ion battery. To maximize battery life:

- Avoid extreme temperatures.

- Manage background app usage and screen brightness.

The 6.5-inch Super AMOLED display is durable, but using a screen protector and a protective case is recommended to prevent scratches and damage.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Samsung Galaxy A51, consider the following common solutions:

- **Performance Issues:** Close unused apps, clear cache, or restart the device.
  - **Battery Drain:** Check battery usage in settings to identify power-hungry apps. Reduce screen brightness and disable unnecessary features like GPS or Bluetooth when not in use.
  - **Connectivity Problems (Wi-Fi/4G):** Toggle Wi-Fi or mobile data off and on. Restart your device or reset network settings.
  - **Screen Freezing/Unresponsive:** Force restart the device by holding the Power and Volume Down buttons simultaneously for about 10 seconds.
