# Lalaloom TOWER Montessori Learning Tower Instruction Manual

Model: B095L9PSVT

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## 1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Lalaloom TOWER Montessori Learning Tower. This product is designed to safely involve children aged 18 months and older in daily activities, promoting independence and learning. Made from natural wood, it features adjustable height and a safety bar to ensure your child's security and comfort. Please read this manual carefully before assembly and use to ensure proper operation and safety.

## 2. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

**WARNING:** Failure to follow these instructions could result in serious injury or death.

- Always supervise your child when they are using the learning tower. Never leave a child unattended.
- Ensure all screws and fasteners are securely tightened before each use. Regularly check for loose parts.
- Do not allow children to climb on the outside of the tower or stand on the safety bar.
- Place the tower on a flat, stable, and non-slip surface.
- Keep the tower away from heat sources, open flames, and electrical appliances.
- Do not use the tower if any part is broken, torn, or missing. Contact customer support for replacement parts.
- The maximum weight capacity for the platform is 50 kg (110 lbs).
- This product is intended for children aged 18 months and older.
- Ensure the child's feet are fully on the platform and they are within the safety bar enclosure.

## 3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

## 4. ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS (SETUP)

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Assembly requires a Phillips head screwdriver (not included) and the provided Allen key. It is recommended that two adults assemble the tower.

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully remove all parts from the packaging and lay them out on a clean, soft surface to prevent scratching. Verify all parts are present as per the "Package Contents" list.
2. **Attach Support Rods to Side Panels:** Identify the two side panels. Attach the two support rods between the side panels using the provided screws. Ensure the pre-drilled holes align. Do not overtighten yet.
3. **Install Front and Back Panels:** Secure the front and back panels to the assembled side panels using the remaining screws. Ensure the wider opening is at the front for child entry.
4. **Insert Adjustable Standing Platform:** Slide the adjustable standing platform into the desired height slot on the side panels. Ensure it is level and securely seated in the grooves.
5. **Attach Safety Bar:** Position the safety bar at the top front opening. Secure it to the side panels using the designated screws. This bar prevents the child from falling forward.
6. **Final Tightening:** Once all components are in place, carefully tighten all screws with the Allen key and Phillips head screwdriver. Do not overtighten to avoid damaging the wood.
7. **Stability Check:** Gently shake the assembled tower to ensure it is stable and all connections are secure.

*Note: For visual guidance, refer to the assembly diagrams typically found in the product packaging.*

## 5. USAGE (OPERATING)

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The Lalaloom TOWER is designed to bring your child to counter height safely, allowing them to participate in kitchen activities, wash hands at the sink, or engage in other elevated tasks.

### 5.1 Adjusting the Platform Height

1. **Empty the Tower:** Ensure no child or objects are on the standing platform.
2. **Loosen Fasteners (if applicable):** Some models may have additional fasteners securing the platform. Loosen or remove these if present.
3. **Remove Platform:** Carefully lift the standing platform out of its current grooves.
4. **Re-insert at Desired Height:** Align the platform with the desired height grooves on the side panels. Ensure both sides are inserted evenly and securely.
5. **Secure Platform (if applicable):** Re-fasten any additional securing mechanisms.
6. **Test Stability:** Before allowing your child to use it, gently press down on the platform to ensure it is stable and locked into place.

### 5.2 Placing and Removing Your Child

- Always guide your child into and out of the tower from the front opening.
- Ensure the child steps onto the platform securely.
- Never allow the child to climb over the safety bar or side panels.

## 6. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the tower with a damp cloth and mild soap. Dry immediately with a clean, soft cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals, as they may damage the wood finish.
- **Inspection:** Regularly inspect all parts for wear, damage, or loose fasteners. Tighten screws as needed.
- **Storage:** Store the tower in a dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures, to prevent warping or cracking of the wood.
- **Wood Care:** As this product is made of natural wood, minor variations in grain and color are normal. Periodically, you may apply a child-safe wood conditioner or oil to maintain the wood's integrity and appearance.

## 7. TROUBLESHOOTING

| Problem                                      | Possible Cause                                                          | Solution                                                                                                      |

| Tower feels wobbly after assembly.           | Screws are not fully tightened.                                         | Check and tighten all screws securely. Ensure the tower is on a flat surface.                                 |
| Standing platform does not fit into grooves. | Platform is misaligned or inserted incorrectly.                         | Ensure the platform is oriented correctly and both sides are aligned with the grooves before pushing it down. |
| Child is able to climb out easily.           | Child is too tall for the current platform height or is not supervised. | Adjust the platform to a lower height if necessary. Always supervise your child.                              |
