## 1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the safe and effective use of your Cellet Worldwide Universal Power Adapter. This adapter is designed to facilitate power connections for your electronic devices, such as the Fuji FinePix F20, in various international regions. Please read this manual thoroughly before use to ensure proper operation and safety.

## 2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

- This device is a travel adapter, not a voltage converter. It does not convert voltage from 110V to 220V or vice versa. Ensure your electronic device (e.g., charger for Fuji FinePix F20) is compatible with the local voltage supply (100V-240V) before plugging it into this adapter. Failure to do so may damage your device.
- Do not use this adapter with high-power appliances that exceed its maximum rated power.
- Keep out of reach of children.
- Do not expose to liquids or extreme temperatures.
- Always ensure the adapter is securely plugged into the wall outlet and your device is securely plugged into the adapter.
- Use the safety lock mechanism to secure the prongs in position.

### 3. SETUP AND OPERATION

#### 3.1 Extending the Prongs

1. Identify the required plug type for your destination (US, EU, UK, AUS/NZ).
2. Locate the corresponding slider or button on the adapter.
3. Slide or press the button to extend the correct prongs. For example, slide the 'US' button for US-style prongs.
4. Ensure the prongs are fully extended and locked into place using the safety switch (if applicable).

#### 3.2 Connecting Your Device

1. Plug your device's power cord or charger into the universal outlet on the front of the adapter.
2. Ensure your device's charger supports the local voltage.
3. Insert the adapter into the wall outlet.

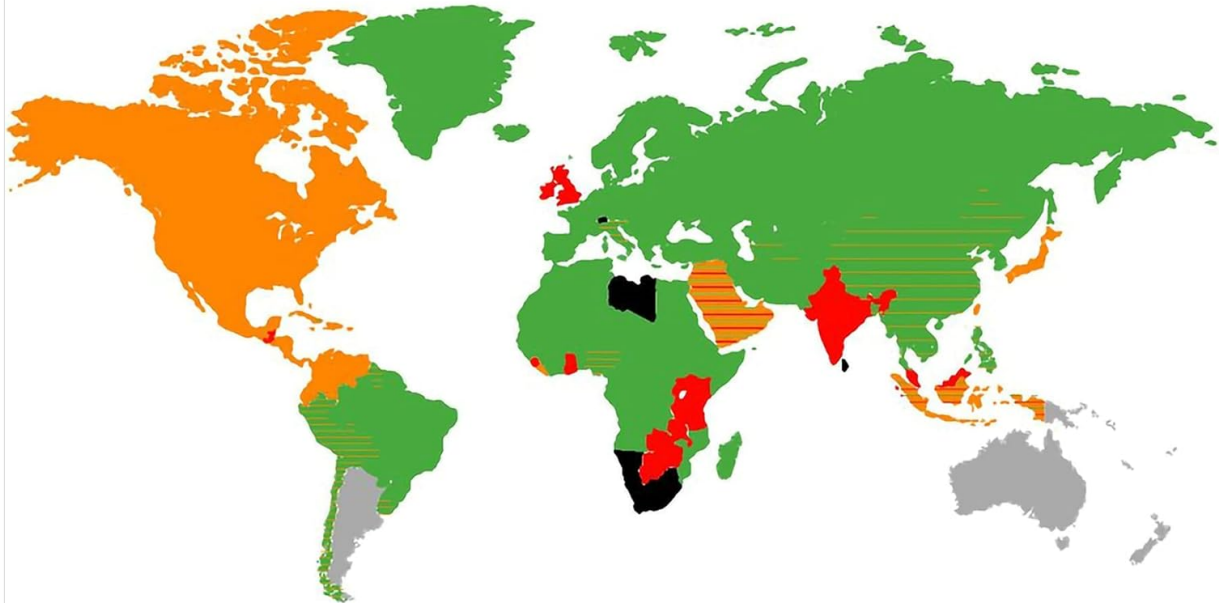

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

### 6.1 Device Not Charging

- Ensure the adapter is fully plugged into the wall outlet.
- Verify that your device's charger is securely plugged into the adapter.
- Check if the local voltage is compatible with your device's charger. This adapter does not convert voltage.

- Confirm that the safety lock on the adapter is engaged, holding the prongs firmly in place.

## 6.2 Adapter Feels Loose in Outlet

- Ensure the correct prongs for the region are fully extended and locked.
- Some older or worn outlets may not provide a snug fit. Exercise caution.

## 6.3 Adapter Overheating

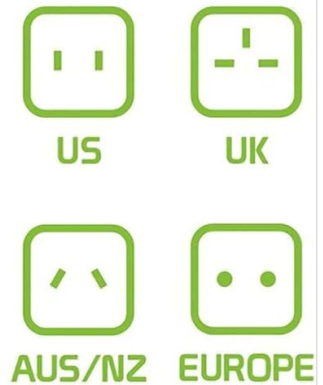
- Immediately unplug the adapter and the connected device.
- Ensure the connected device's power requirements do not exceed the adapter's maximum rating.
- Allow the adapter to cool down before attempting to use it again. If overheating persists, discontinue use.
