1. INTRODUCTION

This compact adapter features dual USB ports and multiple retractable plugs to accommodate various international outlets. It is an ideal solution for travelers needing to charge their electronic devices.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION AND IMPORTANT WARNINGS

WARNING: This device is a travel adapter, NOT a power converter. It does NOT convert voltage. Ensure your electronic devices (chargers, phones, laptops, etc.) are compatible with the local voltage (100V-240V) before use. Failure to do so may damage your devices or cause injury.

- Do not use with high-power appliances such as hair dryers, electric kettles, or vacuum cleaners. Refer to the wattage rating of your appliance and the adapter's specifications.
- Keep out of reach of children.
- Do not expose to liquids or extreme temperatures.
- Do not disassemble or modify the adapter.
- Ensure the adapter is fully inserted into the wall outlet before connecting devices.
- Unplug the adapter from the wall outlet when not in use.

4. SETUP AND OPERATION

4.1 Extending and Retracting Plugs

To use the adapter, select the appropriate plug type for your destination and extend it as follows:

1. **US/China/Japan Standard:** Press the 'PUSH' button and slide the US plug out.
2. **British Standard (UK/HK/Singapore/Malaysia):** Press the 'PRESS' button, then pull out the UK plug.
3. **European Standard (EU/France/Germany/Netherlands):** Press the 'PUSH' button and slide the EU plug out.
4. **Australian/New Zealand Standard:** Rotate the AUS/NZ plug pins into position.

To retract a plug, reverse the process or press the corresponding release button and push the plug back into the adapter until it locks.




Image 4.1: Step-by-step visual instructions for deploying the American, British, European, and Australian standard plugs.

4.2 Charging Devices

1. Extend the correct plug for your wall outlet.
2. Plug the adapter firmly into the wall outlet.
3. Connect your device's USB charging cable (not included) into one of the adapter's USB ports.
4. Connect the other end of the USB cable to your device (e.g., Motorola W175).
5. The device should begin charging. You can charge two USB devices simultaneously.

Remember to verify your device's voltage compatibility (100V-240V) before connecting.




Image 4.2: The universal adapter plugged into a power strip, charging a smartphone, demonstrating its practical use.



7. MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Disconnect the adapter from the power outlet and all devices before cleaning. Use a dry, soft cloth to wipe the surface. Do not use liquid cleaners or solvents.
- **Storage:** Store the adapter in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and moisture when not in use. Ensure all plugs are fully retracted for compact storage.
- **Inspection:** Periodically inspect the adapter for any signs of damage, such as cracks, frayed wires, or loose connections. Do not use if damaged.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Device not charging:**
 - Ensure the adapter is firmly plugged into the wall outlet.
 - Verify that the correct plug type is fully extended and locked.
 - Check if your device's USB cable is properly connected to both the adapter and the device.
 - Test with a different USB cable or device to rule out cable or device issues.
 - Confirm that your device is compatible with the local voltage (100V-240V).
- **Plug not extending/retracting:**
 - Ensure you are pressing the correct release button or sliding mechanism for the specific plug type.
 - Avoid forcing the plugs. If stuck, gently wiggle while pressing the release.
- **Adapter feels hot:**
 - A slight warmth during operation is normal. If the adapter becomes excessively hot, immediately unplug it from the wall and disconnect all devices. This may indicate an overload or malfunction.
 - Ensure you are not using high-power appliances with the adapter.
