1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the safe and proper use of your Toomies E73264 Bubble & Bake Bathtime Kitchen Toy. Please read these instructions carefully before assembly and use, and retain them for future reference.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- To prevent injury from slips and falls, all toys should be removed from the bath before the bath is empty.
- To prevent drowning, never leave a child unattended whilst playing in or around water.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

The Toomies Bubble & Bake Bathtime Kitchen Toy includes the following components:

- Oven/Hob Unit (purple)
- Sink Unit with working tap (blue)
- Ladle (pink)
- Pie Dish (yellow)
- Saucepan (blue)

4. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Attach Units:** The oven/hob unit and the sink unit can be attached together or used separately. Use the integrated suction pads to securely attach the units to the bath surface or tiled walls. Ensure the surface is clean and dry for optimal suction.

2. **Connect Units (Optional):** To connect the two units, align the side connectors and press firmly until they click into place. This allows for a combined play experience.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Bubble Making Function

1. Place the saucepan on the hob of the oven unit.
2. Add a few drops of bubble bath (not included) into the saucepan.
3. Fill the saucepan with water.
4. Press the yellow button on the hob repeatedly to create bubbles.

5.2 Oven Spinning Function

1. Open the oven door and place the pie dish inside.
2. Ensure the saucepan is on the hob and filled with water.
3. Twist the pot on top of the hob unit a quarter turn. Water will flow from the saucepan into the oven, causing the pie dish to spin.

5.3 Working Sink and Tap

1. Fill the sink unit with water.
2. Pump the handle of the tap to make water flow.
3. To empty the sink, turn the plug at the bottom, and the water will drain into the bath.

5.4 Accessory Use

- Use the ladle for scooping and stirring water or bubbles.
- The saucepan can be used on the hob or for general water play.

6. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

- After each use, rinse all components thoroughly with clean water to remove any soap residue.
- Allow all parts to air dry completely to prevent mold and mildew. The oven unit features hooks to hang the ladle and saucepan for drip drying.
- Store the toy in a dry, well-ventilated area when not in use.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Bubbles not forming:** Ensure sufficient bubble bath is used and the water level in the saucepan is appropriate. Repeated pumping may be required.
- **Pie dish not spinning:** Verify that the pot on the hob is twisted correctly to allow water to flow into the oven mechanism.
- **Sink not holding water:** Check that the drain plug is fully closed and sealed.
- **Suction pads not holding:** Clean both the suction pads and the bath/tile surface thoroughly. Ensure the surface is smooth and free of soap scum or residue. Press firmly to create a strong seal.
