1. Introduction

Thank you for choosing the Aigostar 1000W Panini Press Sandwich Maker. This versatile appliance is designed for quick and efficient preparation of various grilled foods, including paninis, sandwiches, steaks, and vegetables. Its non-stick coated plates, adjustable floating hinge, and compact design ensure ease of use, excellent cooking results, and simple storage. Please read this manual thoroughly before first use to ensure safe and optimal operation.

2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

When using electrical appliances, basic safety precautions should always be followed, including the following:

- Read all instructions before operating the appliance.
- Do not touch hot surfaces. Use handles or knobs.
- To protect against electrical hazards, do not immerse cord, plugs, or the appliance in water or other liquid.
- Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.
- Unplug from outlet when not in use and before cleaning. Allow to cool before putting on or taking off parts, and before cleaning the appliance.

- To disconnect, turn any control to "off," then remove plug from wall outlet.
- Do not use appliance for other than intended use.

3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

4. SETUP

Before using your panini press for the first time, follow these steps:

- 1. **Unpack:** Carefully remove the appliance and all accessories from the packaging. Retain packaging for future storage or disposal.
- 2. Clean Plates: Wipe the non-stick cooking plates with a damp cloth or sponge. Dry thoroughly.
- 3. **Position:** Place the panini press on a stable, heat-resistant, and dry surface. Ensure there is adequate ventilation around the appliance.
- 4. **Drip Tray:** Ensure the removable drip tray is correctly inserted at the back of the unit to collect any excess grease or liquids during cooking.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Preheating

- 1. Plug the appliance into a standard electrical outlet. The red indicator light will illuminate, signaling that the unit is preheating.
- 2. Allow the panini press to preheat for approximately 2-3 minutes. The green indicator light will turn off when the appliance has reached its optimal cooking temperature (356°F-400°F) and is ready for use.

5.2 Cooking Your Meal

The floating hinge design allows the top plate to adjust to the thickness of your food, ensuring even cooking and perfect grill marks.

- 1. Once preheated, carefully open the lid using the cool-touch handle.
- 2. Place your food (e.g., sandwich, steak, vegetables) onto the bottom non-stick plate. For best results, you may lightly brush the food with oil or butter.
- 3. Gently close the top lid, allowing the floating hinge to adapt to the food's thickness. Do not force the lid down.
- 4. Cook for the desired amount of time, typically 3-5 minutes for sandwiches, or until golden brown and heated through. Cooking times will vary based on food type and thickness.
- 5. When cooking is complete, carefully open the lid and remove the food using heat-resistant utensils.
- 6. Unplug the appliance from the power outlet after use.

6. MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Proper cleaning ensures the longevity and performance of your panini press.

- 1. Cool Down: Always unplug the appliance and allow it to cool completely before cleaning.
- 2. **Clean Plates:** The non-stick coated plates are easy to clean. Simply wipe them down with a damp cloth or sponge. For stubborn residue, a small amount of mild dish soap can be used, followed by wiping with a clean damp cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners or metal scouring pads, as these can damage the non-stick coating.
- 3. **Drip Tray:** Remove the drip tray and empty any collected grease. Wash the drip tray with warm, soapy water, rinse, and dry thoroughly before reinserting.
- 4. Exterior: Wipe the exterior of the appliance with a soft, damp cloth. Do not immerse the appliance in water.

7. STORAGE

The Aigostar Panini Press is designed for compact storage.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your panini press, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

- **Appliance not heating:** Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into a working electrical outlet. Check if the red indicator light is on. If not, try a different outlet.
- Food sticking to plates: Ensure the plates are clean and lightly brushed with oil or butter before adding food. The non-stick coating should prevent most sticking.
- **Uneven cooking:** Ensure the food is placed centrally on the cooking plate. The floating hinge is designed to accommodate varying thicknesses, but very unevenly shaped items may cook differently.
- **Indicator lights not working:** If the lights are not functioning as described, unplug the unit and contact customer support.
