1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the PawHut Dog Stroller. This manual provides essential information for the safe and proper assembly, operation, and maintenance of your new pet stroller. Designed for small dogs and cats, this stroller offers a comfortable and secure way to transport your pet, featuring a one-click fold mechanism, swivel wheels, a reliable brake system, and ample storage. Please read this manual thoroughly before first use and retain it for future reference.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

To ensure the safety of your pet and yourself, please adhere to the following guidelines:

- Always ensure your pet is securely fastened inside the stroller using the provided safety leashes.
- Do not exceed the maximum recommended weight of 22 lbs (10 kg) for the pet compartment. This stroller is suitable for small and miniature dogs less than 17 inches (43 cm) in length.
- Never leave your pet unattended in the stroller, especially on inclines or near traffic.
- Engage the brake when the stroller is stationary to prevent accidental movement.
- Regularly inspect all parts for wear, damage, or loose connections. Do not use the stroller if any part is damaged.
- Keep fingers and hands clear of moving parts, especially during folding and unfolding.
- This product is designed for pets only. Do not use it for human infants or children.

- **WARNING:** This product may contain chemicals known to the State of California to cause cancer and birth defects or other reproductive harm.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Please verify that all components are present before assembly:

- PawHut Dog Stroller Frame with Fabric Compartment
- Wheels (4 total)
- Safety Belt (pre-installed)
- Soft Cushion (pre-installed)

4. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

The PawHut Dog Stroller features a quick foldable design and comes mostly pre-assembled. Follow these steps to prepare it for use:

1. **Unfold the Stroller:** Release the folding latch (if engaged) and carefully unfold the stroller frame until it locks into the open position. Ensure the frame is fully extended and stable.
2. **Attach the Wheels:** Insert the front and rear wheels into their respective slots on the stroller frame. Push firmly until they click into place. Verify that all wheels are securely attached and rotate freely.
3. **Adjust Canopy:** Position the adjustable canopy as desired to provide shade and ventilation for your pet.
4. **Check Safety Features:** Confirm that the safety leashes inside the pet compartment are accessible and in good condition. Test the rear wheel brakes to ensure they engage and disengage properly.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Placing Your Pet in the Stroller

Open the zippered front or back door of the pet compartment. Gently guide your pet inside. Secure your pet using the internal safety leashes by attaching them to your pet's harness or collar. Close the zipper securely.

5.2 Using the Adjustable Canopy and Mesh Window

The canopy can be adjusted to provide optimal shade or ventilation. The mesh window allows your pet to see outside and ensures proper airflow. For maximum ventilation, the mesh window can be fully opened.

5.3 Reversible Push Handle

The stroller features a reversible push handle, allowing you to push the stroller with your pet facing forward or facing you. To reverse the handle, locate the release mechanisms on either side of the handle and pivot the handle to the desired direction until it locks into place.

5.4 Engaging the Brake

To engage the brake, press down on the lever located near the rear wheels. Ensure the brake is fully engaged before leaving the stroller stationary. To release, lift the lever.

5.5 Storage Basket and Bag

The stroller includes a basket located at the bottom for carrying pet supplies or personal belongings. A small storage bag is also located on the back for additional convenience.

6. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance will extend the life of your PawHut Dog Stroller:

- **Cleaning:** The oxford fabric and polyester components can be machine washed. For spot cleaning, use a mild detergent and warm water. Allow to air dry completely before folding or storing.
- **Wheels:** Periodically check the wheels for debris and ensure they rotate smoothly. Clean any dirt or hair from the axles.
- **Frame:** Wipe the steel frame with a damp cloth to remove dirt. Dry thoroughly to prevent rust.
- **Storage:** When not in use, store the stroller in a clean, dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your stroller, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Stroller does not stay open/latch disengages.	Latch not fully engaged; frame not fully extended; worn latch mechanism.	Ensure the frame is fully unfolded and the latch clicks securely into place. If the issue persists, inspect the latch for damage and contact customer support.
Front wheels wobble or oscillate excessively.	Loose wheel attachment; debris in wheel mechanism; uneven ground.	Verify wheels are securely attached. Clean any debris from the wheel axles. Ensure you are on a relatively smooth surface.
Zipper is difficult to operate or gets stuck.	Fabric caught in zipper; zipper teeth misaligned; zipper slider damage.	Ensure fabric is clear of the zipper path. Gently try to realign teeth. If damaged, avoid forcing and contact customer support.
Stroller feels unstable side-to-side.	Loose frame connections; uneven weight distribution; rear wheel laxity.	Check all frame connections for tightness. Ensure pet's weight is centered. If instability persists, contact customer support.
Plastic snaps holding fabric come loose.	Improper attachment; excessive force; worn snaps.	Re-attach snaps firmly. Avoid overloading the stroller. If snaps are damaged, contact customer support.
