INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for setting up, operating, maintaining, and troubleshooting your Blackview Tab 10 Android Tablet. The Blackview Tab 10 features a 10.1-inch FHD+ display, an MTK8768 Octa-Core processor, 4GB RAM, 64GB internal storage, and runs on Android 11 (Doke OS_P 1.0). It supports dual SIM cards for 4G phone calls and data, Wi-Fi, and Bluetooth 5.0 connectivity. Please read this manual thoroughly to ensure proper use and to maximize your tablet's performance and longevity.

SETUP

Package Contents

Ensure all items are present in the package:

- Blackview Tab 10 Tablet PC
- USB Cable (Type-C)
- Power Adapter (9V 2A)
- User Manual

Charging the Battery

Before first use, fully charge the tablet. Connect the USB Type-C cable to the tablet's Type-C port and the other end to the provided power adapter. Plug the adapter into a power outlet. The charging indicator will show the charging status. The tablet supports 18W fast charging.

Inserting SIM and TF Cards

The Blackview Tab 10 supports dual Nano SIM cards or one Nano SIM card and one TF (microSD) card

for expandable storage up to 128GB.

1. Locate the SIM/TF card tray on the side of the tablet.
2. Use the provided SIM ejector tool to open the tray.
3. Carefully place the Nano SIM card(s) and/or TF card into the designated slots on the tray. Ensure the cards are correctly oriented.
4. Gently push the tray back into the tablet until it clicks into place.




Image: A detailed view of the Blackview Tab 10's SIM card tray, showing how two Nano SIM cards are inserted, illustrating the dual SIM support.

Powering On/Off

- **To Power On:** Press and hold the Power button until the Blackview logo appears.
- **To Power Off:** Press and hold the Power button until the power options menu appears, then select "Power off".
- **To Restart:** Press and hold the Power button until the power options menu appears, then select "Restart".

Initial Setup

Upon first power-on, follow the on-screen prompts to complete the initial setup:

- Select your language.
- Connect to a Wi-Fi network.
- Sign in with your Google account or create a new one.
- Set up screen lock (PIN, pattern, password).
- Review and accept terms and conditions.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Basic Navigation

- **Tap:** Touch the screen once to open an app, select an item, or press a button.
- **Touch and Hold:** Press and hold an item to access more options or move it.
- **Swipe:** Drag your finger across the screen to scroll through pages or content.
- **Pinch:** Use two fingers to zoom in or out on images and web pages.

Connecting to Networks

- **Wi-Fi:** Go to **Settings > Network & internet > Wi-Fi**. Turn Wi-Fi on, select your desired network, and enter the password if required.
- **Bluetooth:** Go to **Settings > Connected devices > Bluetooth**. Turn Bluetooth on, then select a device from the list to pair.
- **Mobile Data (4G):** If a SIM card is inserted, go to **Settings > Network & internet > Mobile network** to enable mobile data and configure settings.

Using the Camera

The Blackview Tab 10 features a 13.0MP rear camera and a 5.0MP front camera.

1. Open the **Camera** app.
2. Tap the camera icon to switch between front and rear cameras.
3. Tap the shutter button to take a photo or start/stop video recording.
4. Explore various camera modes and settings within the app.




Image: The Blackview Tab 10 displaying its camera features, including an 8MP front camera and a 13MP rear camera, emphasizing its photographic capabilities.

Android 11 and Doke OS_P 1.0

Your tablet runs on Android 11 with Blackview's Doke OS_P 1.0 interface, offering enhanced privacy controls, improved notification management, and a more intuitive user experience. Explore the **Settings** menu to customize your device, manage apps, and optimize performance.

Tab 10 runs the latest Android 11 to give you powerful device controls. From first glance to full immersion, excellence is embodied in every detail.





Image: The Blackview Tab 10 screen showing the Doke OS_P 1.0 interface based on Android 11, with various settings and app screens visible.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning the Device

- Use a soft, lint-free cloth to clean the screen and body of the tablet.
- For stubborn smudges, slightly dampen the cloth with water or a screen cleaner designed for electronics.
- Avoid using harsh chemicals, abrasive materials, or aerosol sprays directly on the tablet.

Battery Care

- Avoid exposing the tablet to extreme temperatures (hot or cold), as this can affect battery life.
- Do not leave the tablet charging for extended periods after it is fully charged.
- Use only the original charger and cable provided with the tablet.

Software Updates

Regularly check for and install software updates to ensure your tablet has the latest features, security patches, and performance improvements. Go to **Settings > System > System update**.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Device Not Turning On

- Ensure the battery is charged. Connect the tablet to the charger for at least 30 minutes.
- Press and hold the Power button for 10-15 seconds to force a restart.

Wi-Fi Connection Issues

- Restart your Wi-Fi router and the tablet.
- Forget the network in Wi-Fi settings and reconnect.
- Ensure you are within range of the Wi-Fi signal.

Slow Performance

- Close unused applications running in the background.
- Clear cache data for apps that are frequently used.
- Ensure sufficient storage space is available. Delete unnecessary files or apps.
- Consider a factory reset as a last resort (back up your data first).

App Crashes or Freezes

- Force close the app: Go to **Settings > Apps & notifications**, select the app, then tap **Force stop**.
- Clear the app's cache and data (this will reset the app).
- Uninstall and reinstall the app.
