PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Razer Wolverine V2 is a wired gaming controller engineered for competitive play on Xbox Series X|S, Xbox One, and PC. It features advanced customization options designed to provide greater precision and control, enabling users to enhance their gaming performance.

This controller is built with an ergonomic design for a natural and comfortable grip, ensuring agile and precise interaction during extended gaming sessions. Its contoured shape and non-slip rubber grips contribute to maximum performance and comfort.

SETUP GUIDE

1. Connecting the Controller

The Razer Wolverine V2 is a wired controller. To connect it to your gaming system:

1. Ensure your Xbox console (Xbox Series X|S or Xbox One) or PC is powered on.
2. Locate an available USB port on your console or PC.
3. Plug the USB connector of the Razer Wolverine V2 controller into the USB port. The controller will automatically be recognized by your system.

2. Installing Razer Controller Setup for Xbox App

For advanced customization and button remapping, it is recommended to install the Razer Controller Setup for Xbox application.

- On Xbox, search for "Razer Controller Setup for Xbox" in the Microsoft Store and install the application.
- On PC, download the application from the official Razer website or the Microsoft Store.
- Launch the application and follow the on-screen instructions to configure your controller settings, including

button remapping and profile storage.

Hair Trigger Mode with Trigger Stop-Switches

For a competitive edge, activate the Hair Trigger Mode using the two sliding lock switches located on the underside of the controller. This mode significantly reduces the travel distance of the main triggers, allowing for ultra-fast firing action in games.

3.5mm Analog Audio Port

The controller includes a convenient 3.5mm analog audio port, allowing you to directly plug in your preferred headphones or headset. This feature provides easy access to audio without needing to connect to the console, enhancing your gaming experience with clear communication and immersive sound.

MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your Razer Wolverine V2 controller.

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe down the controller regularly. For stubborn dirt, slightly dampen the cloth with water. Avoid using harsh chemicals, abrasive cleaners, or solvents, as these can damage the controller's finish and internal components.
- **Storage:** When not in use, store the controller in a clean, dry place away from direct sunlight, extreme temperatures, and excessive dust. Avoid coiling the cable too tightly to prevent damage.
- **Handling:** Handle the controller with care. Avoid dropping it or subjecting it to strong impacts, which can cause internal damage.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Razer Wolverine V2 controller, refer to the following common troubleshooting

steps:

Problem	Possible Cause / Solution
Controller not recognized by console/PC	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Ensure the USB cable is securely plugged into both the controller and the console/PC.Try a different USB port.Restart your console or PC.Ensure your system's drivers are up to date.
Buttons or D-Pad unresponsive/incorrect input	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Check for any physical obstructions or debris around the buttons.Open the Razer Controller Setup for Xbox app to verify button mappings. Reset to default if necessary.Ensure the controller's firmware is up to date via the Razer Controller Setup app.
Audio issues (no sound/mic not working)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Ensure your headset is fully plugged into the 3.5mm audio port on the controller.Check your console/PC audio settings to ensure the controller is selected as the audio output/input device.Test your headset with another device to rule out headset issues.
Hair Trigger Mode not working	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Ensure the trigger stop-switches on the underside of the controller are correctly engaged.Verify settings within the Razer Controller Setup for Xbox app.
